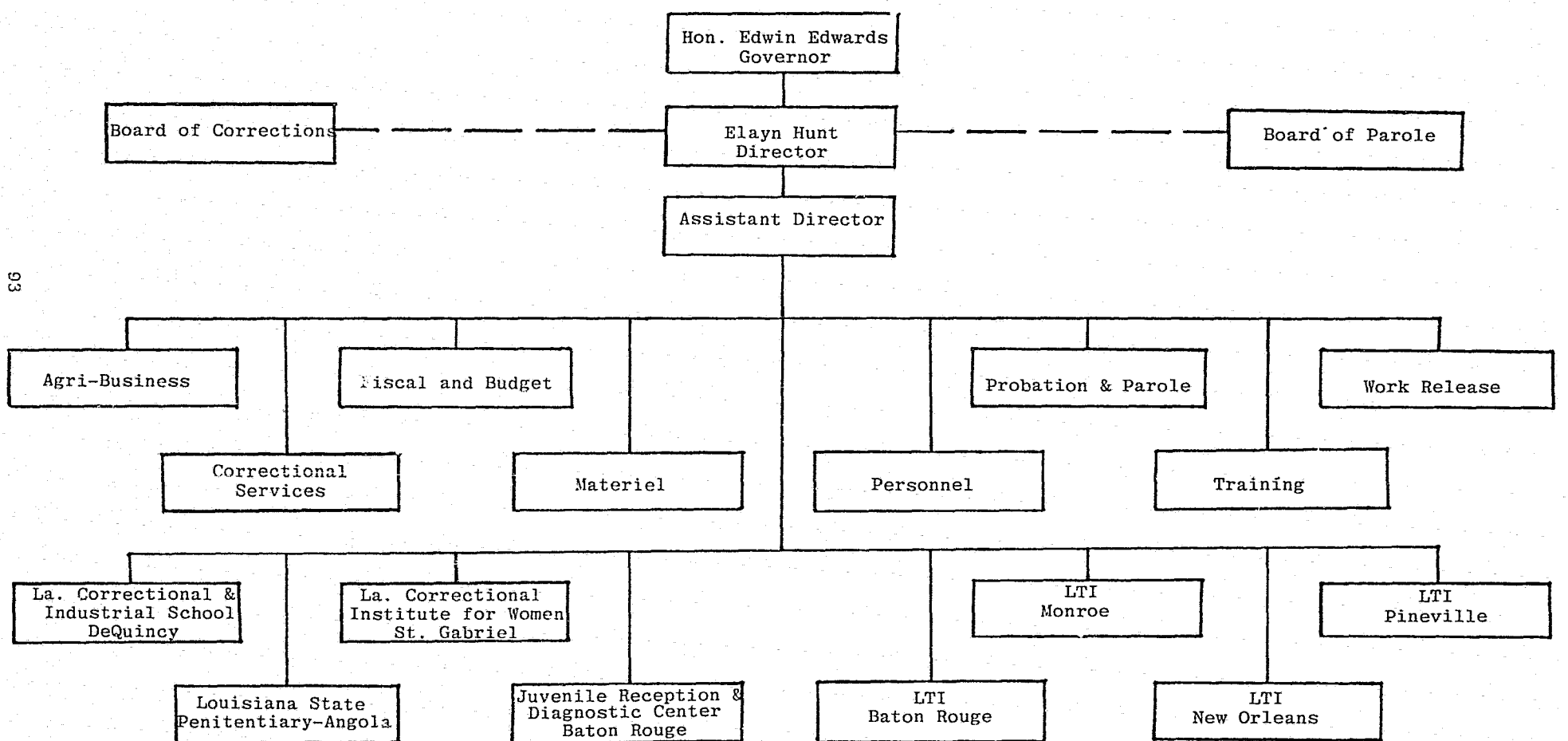

Organizational Chart



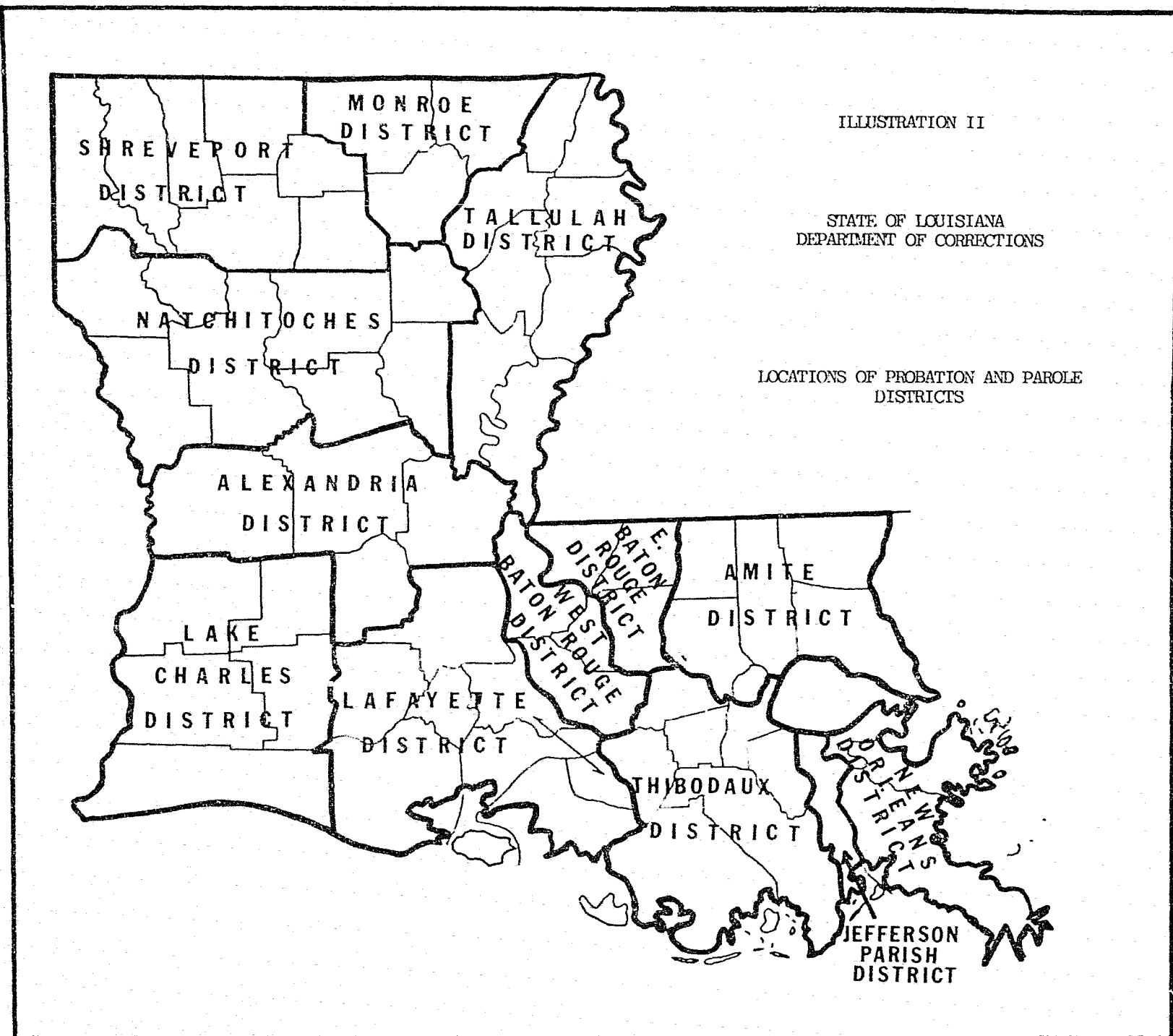
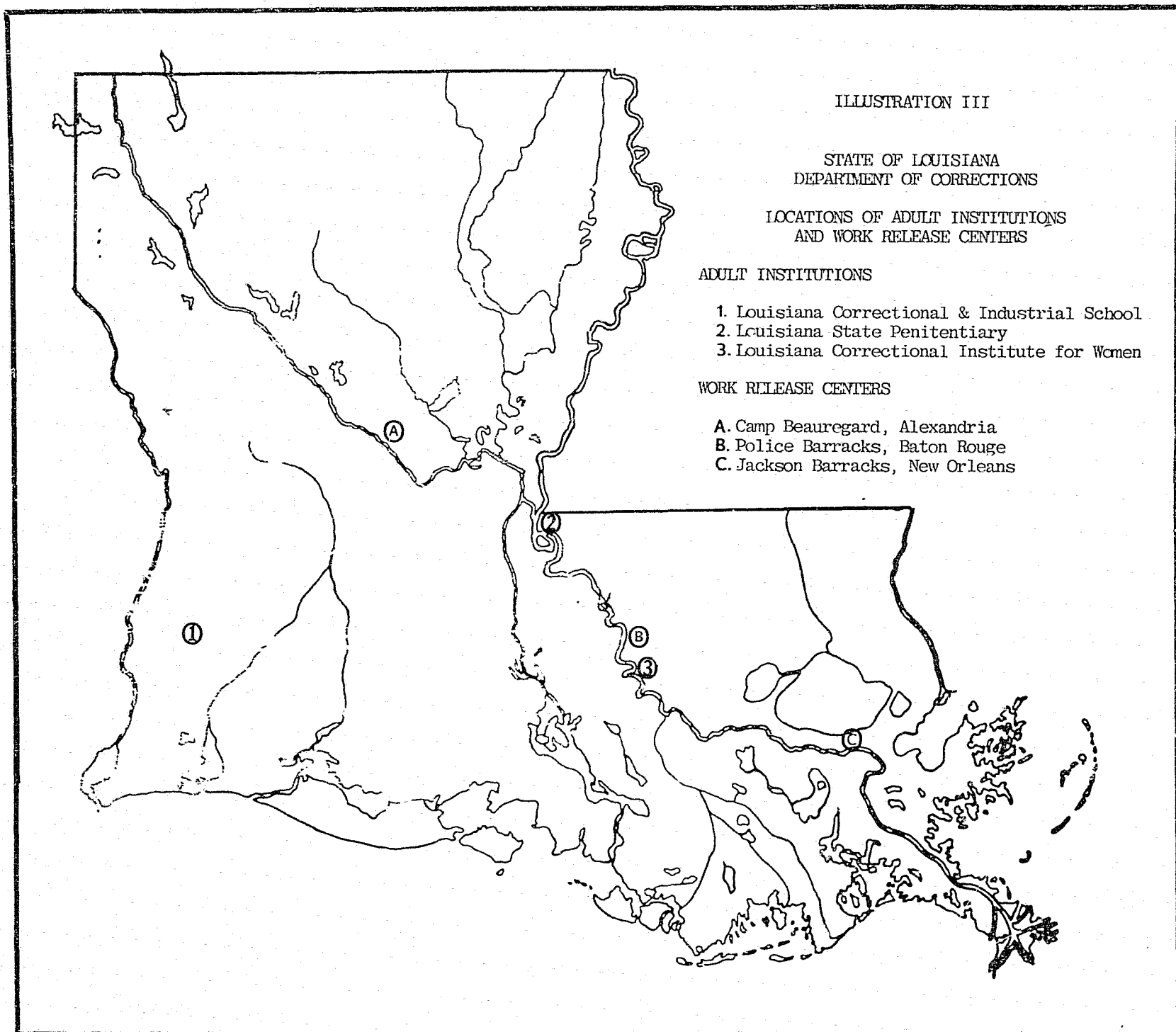


ILLUSTRATION II

DISTRICTS



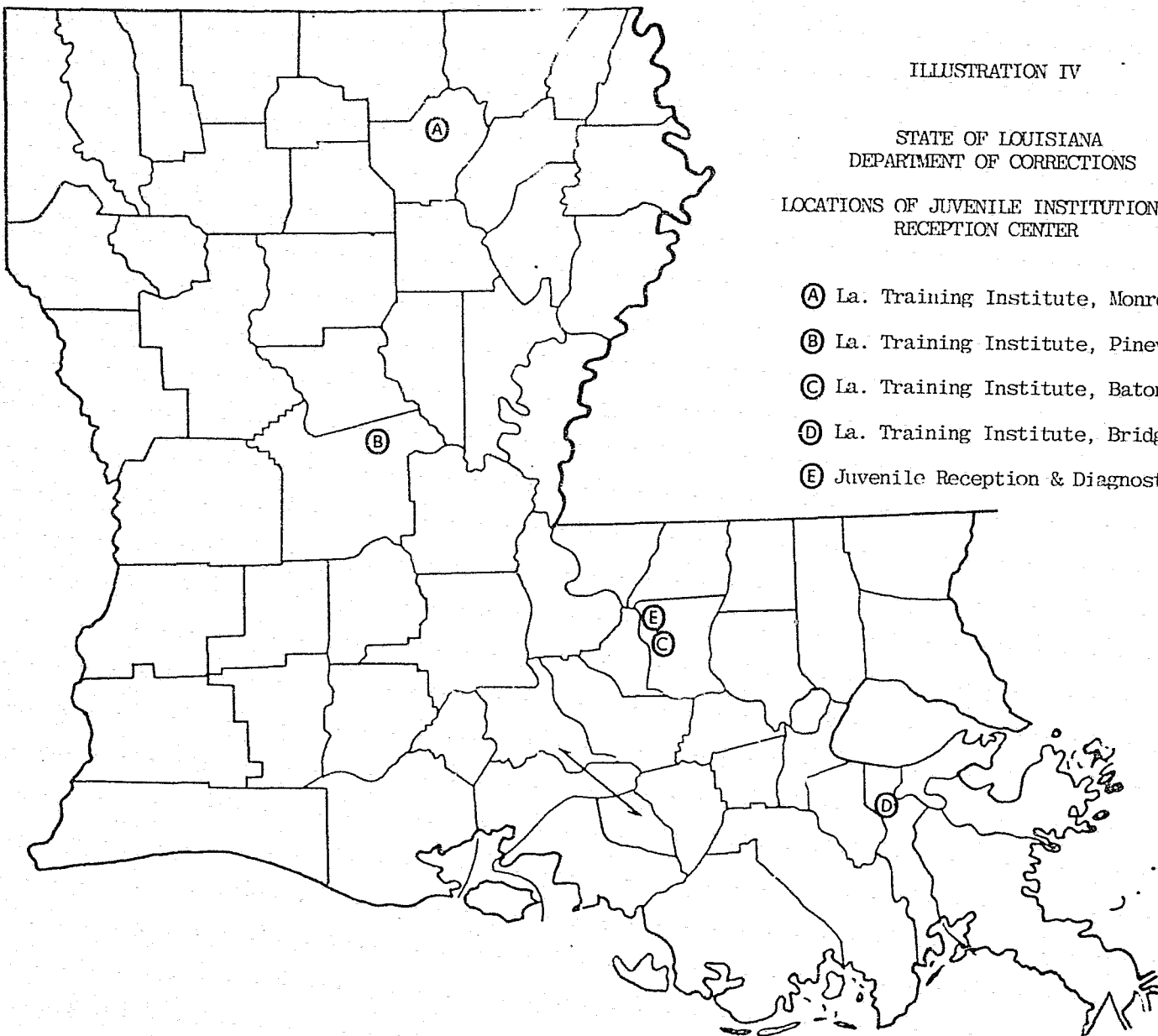

Fiscal Year 1973-1974

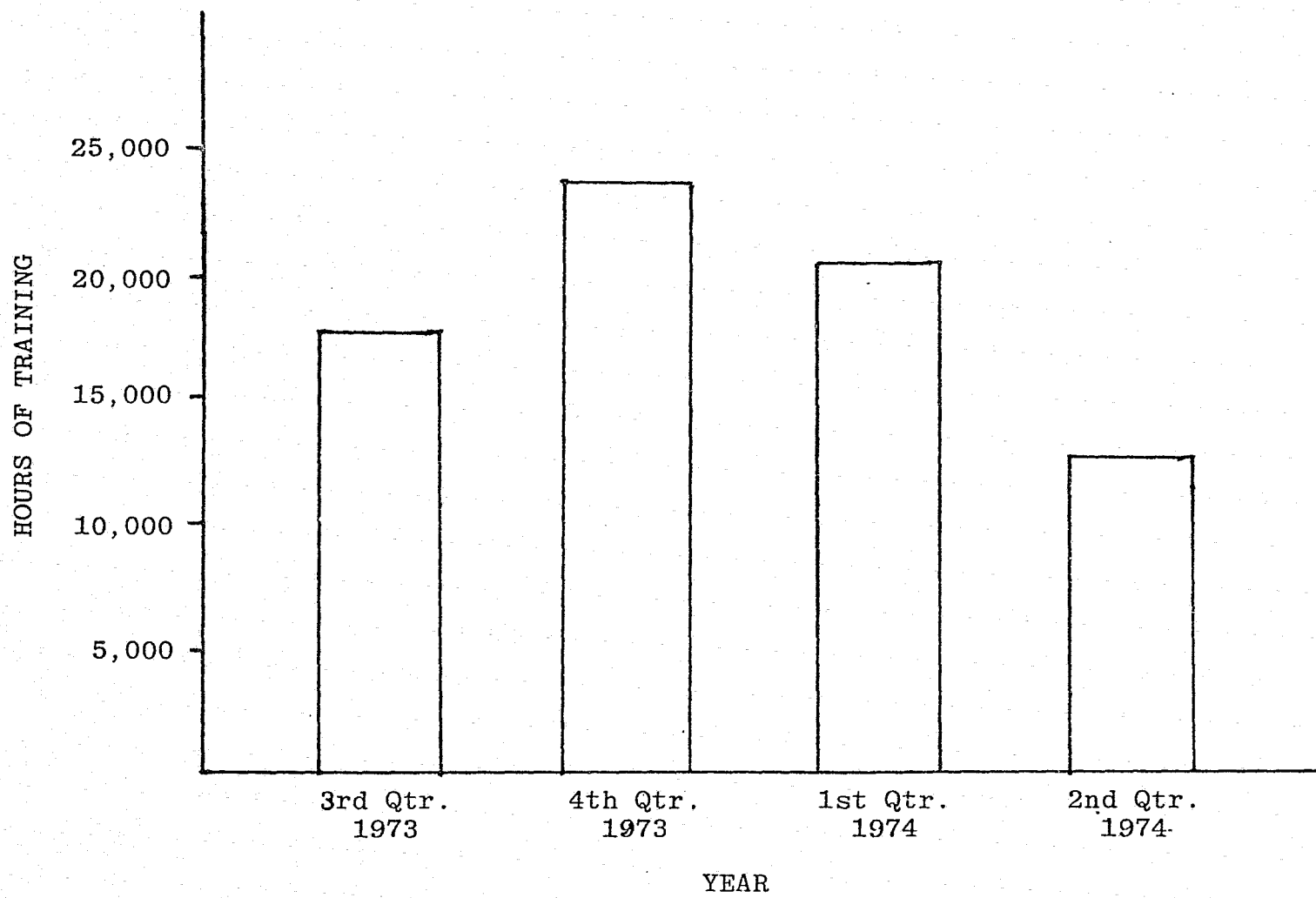
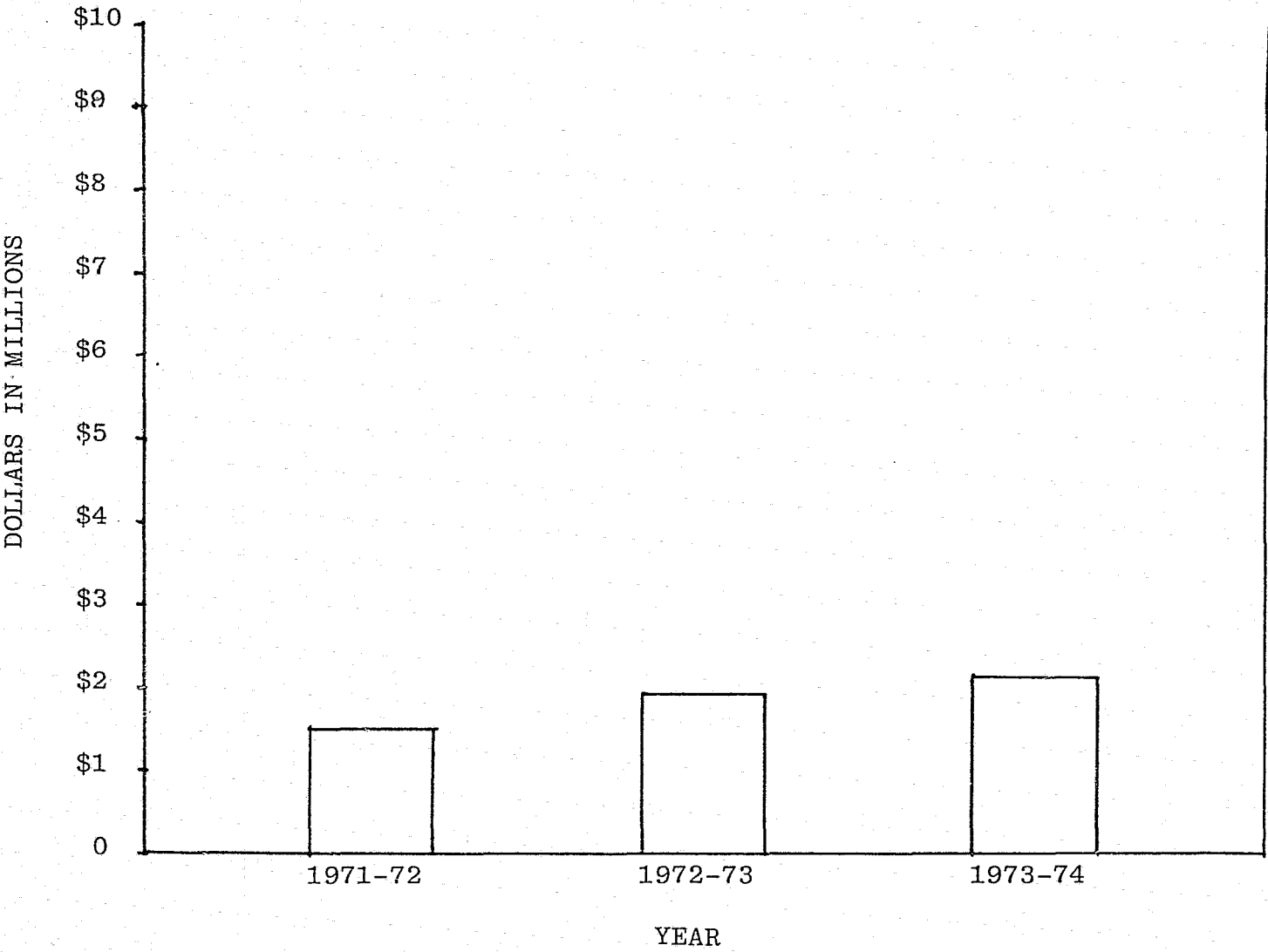


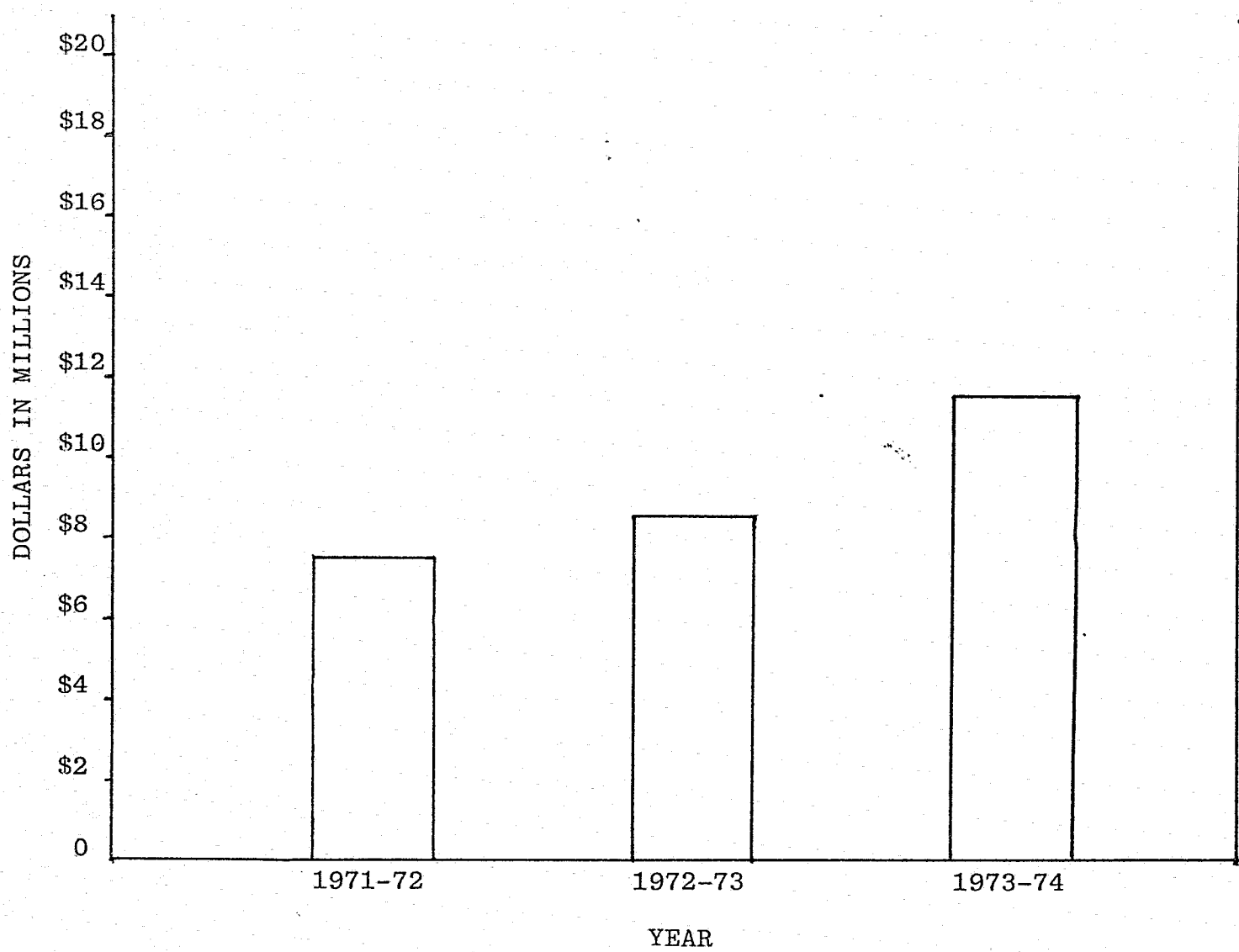

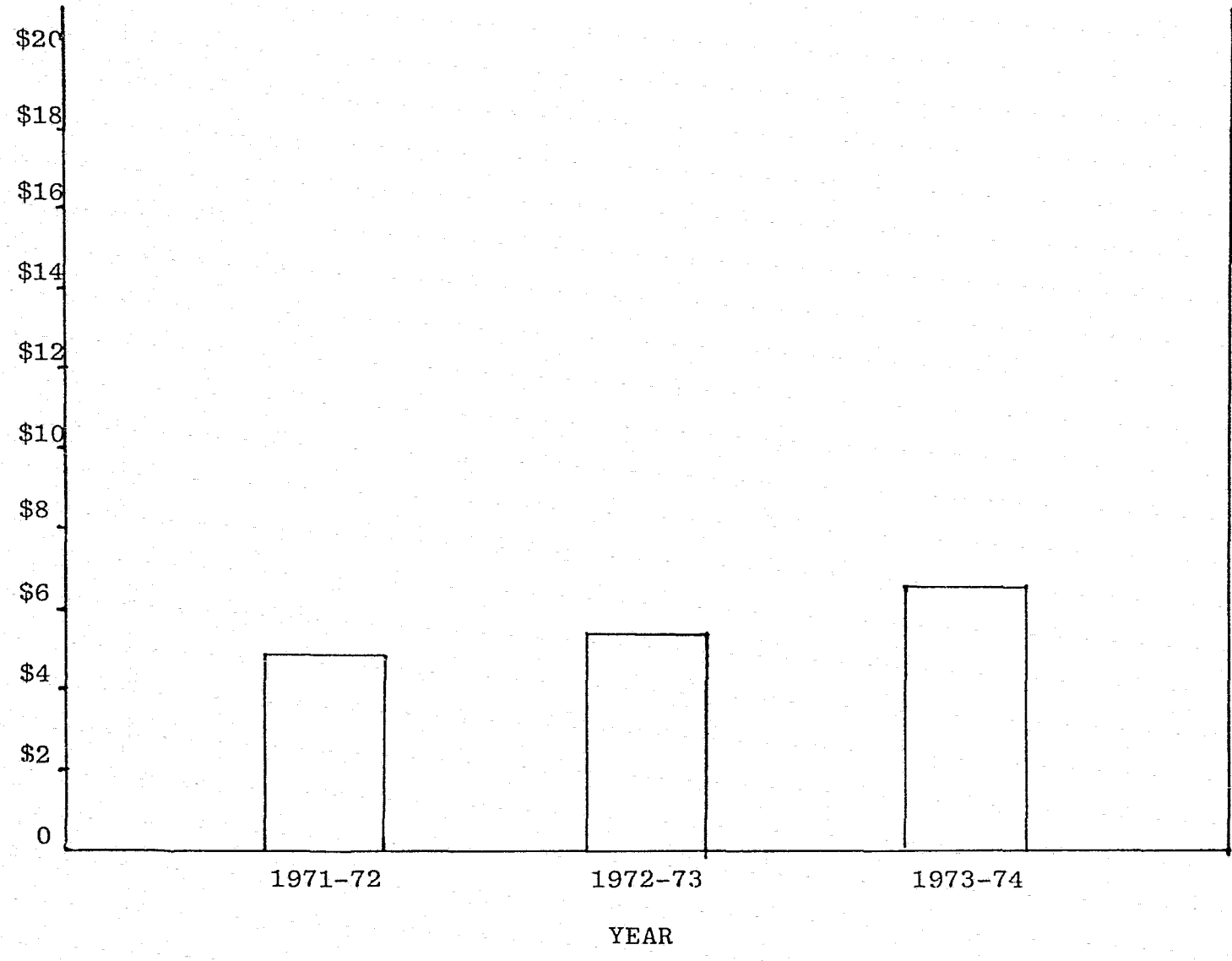

FY 1972 - FY 1974

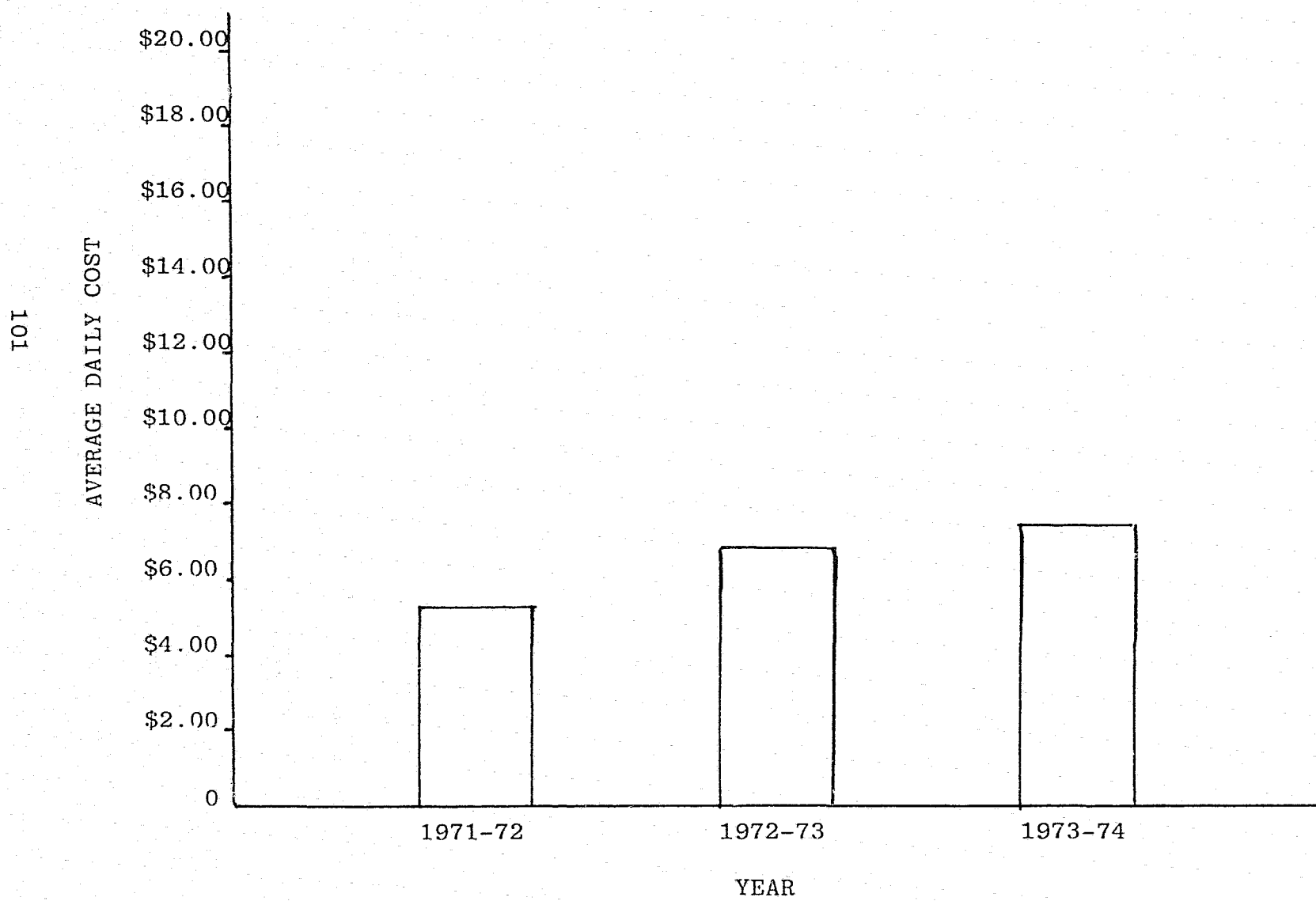

FY 1972 - FY 1974

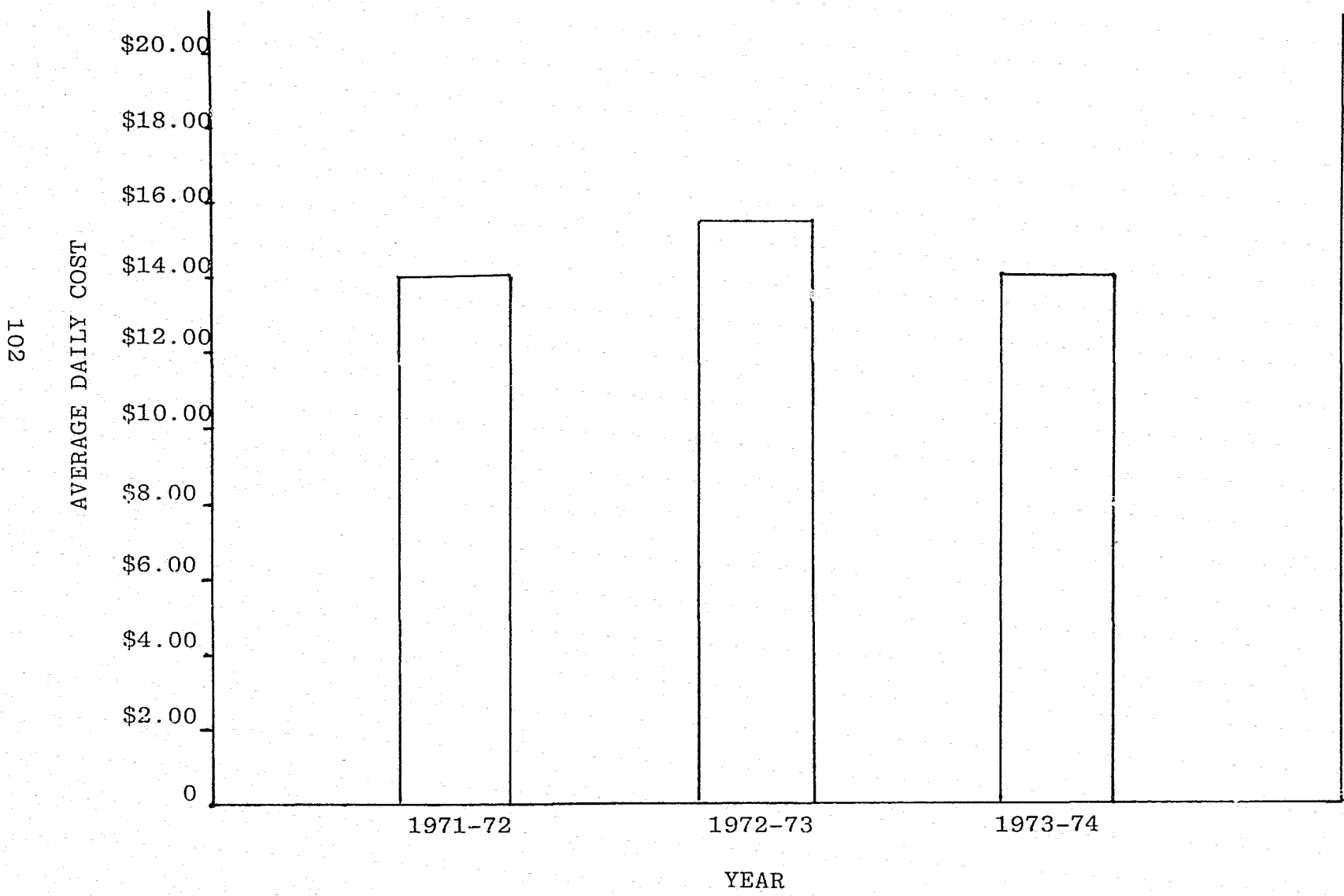


ILLUSTRATION XI

FY 1972 - FY 1974

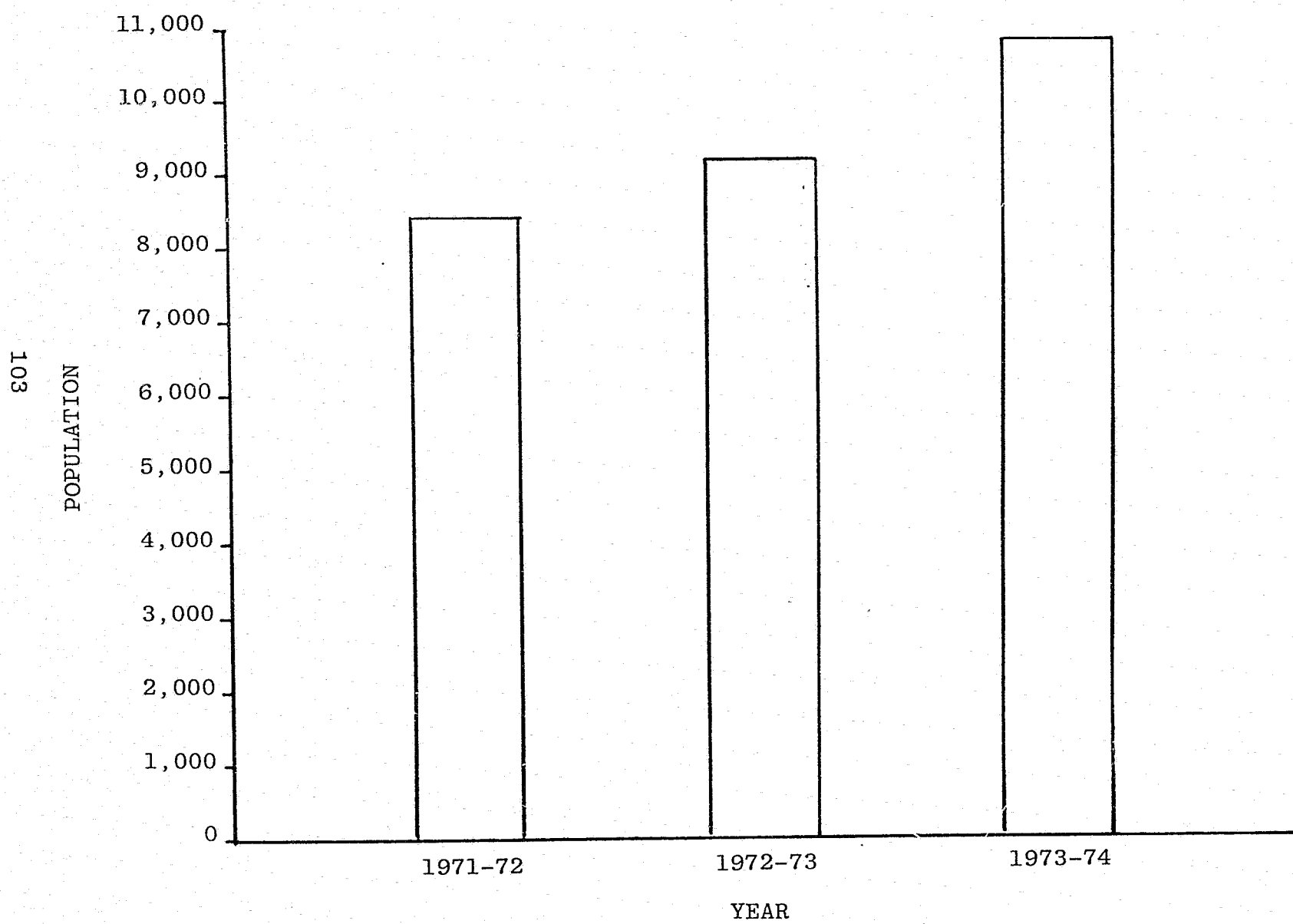


ILLUSTRATION XII

FY 1972 - FY 1974

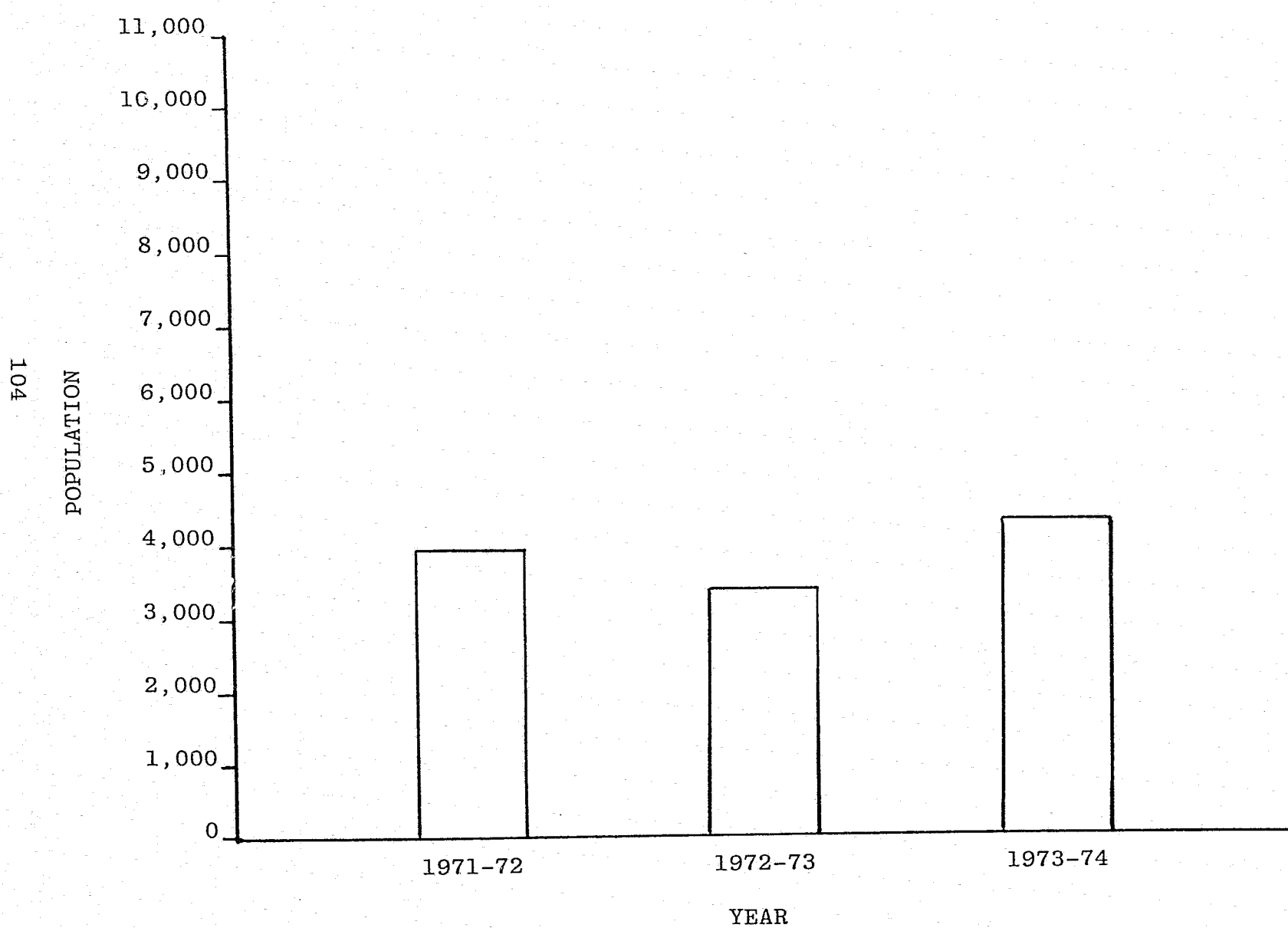

FY 1972 - FY 1974

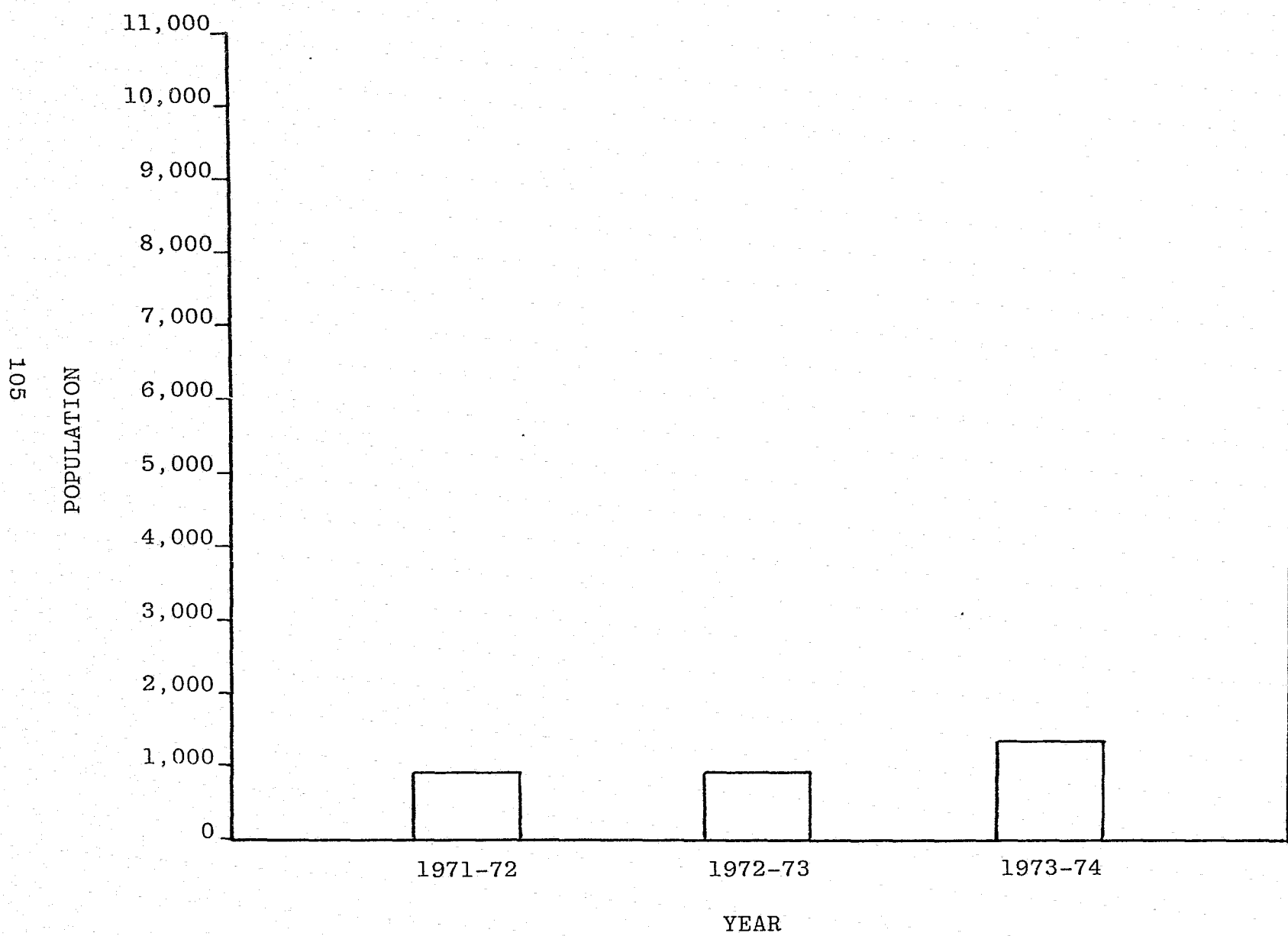
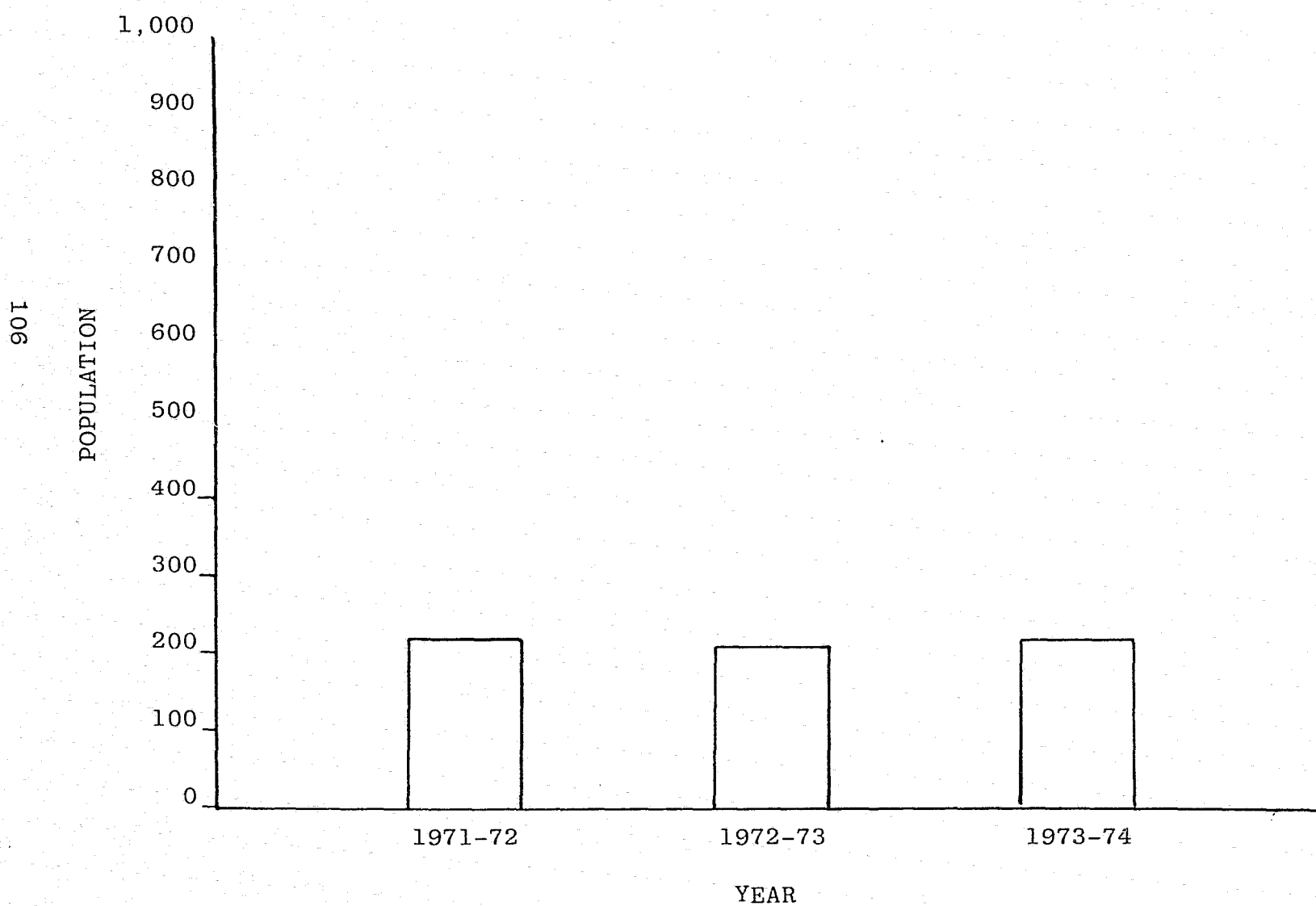


ILLUSTRATION XIV

FY 1972 - FY 1974

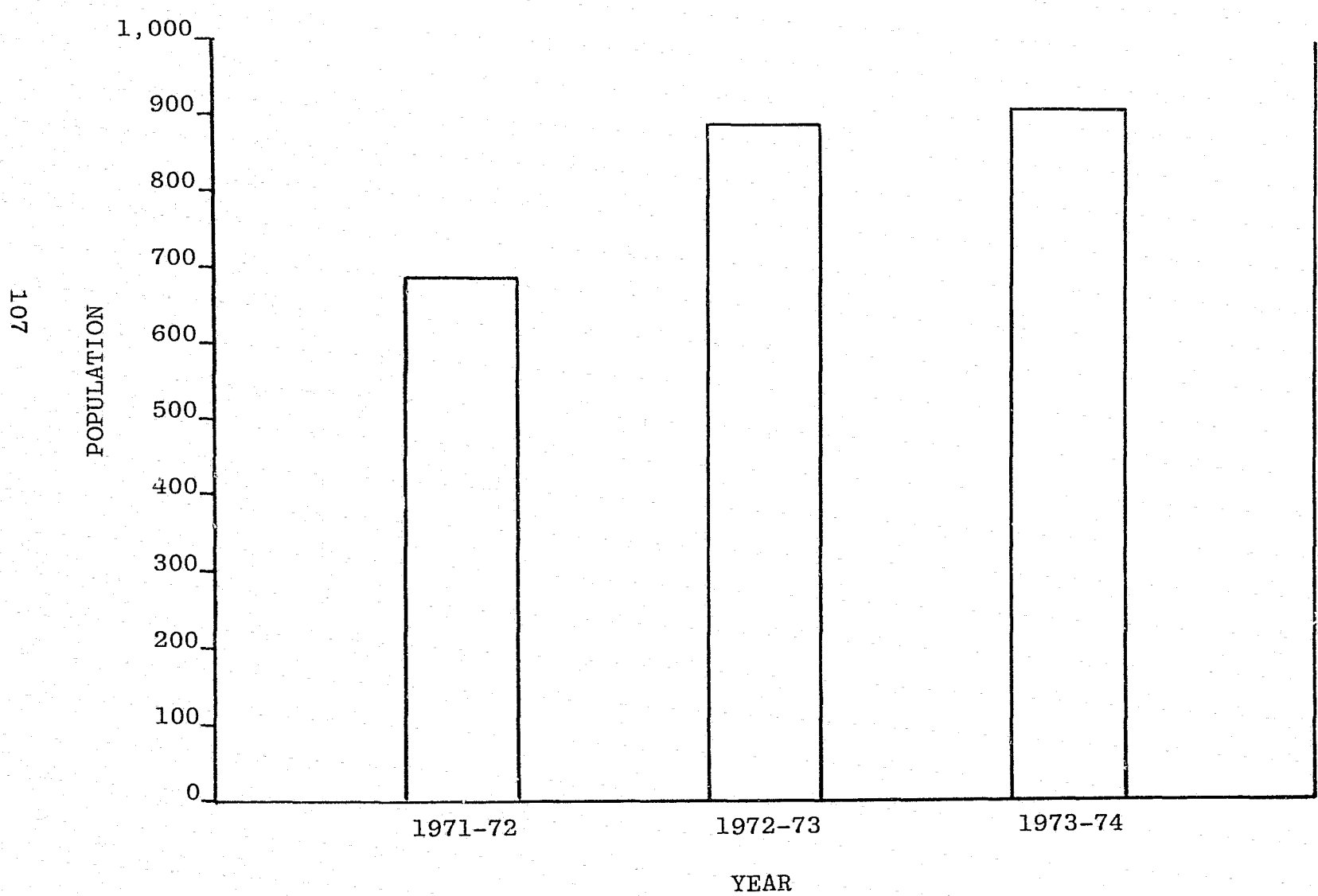
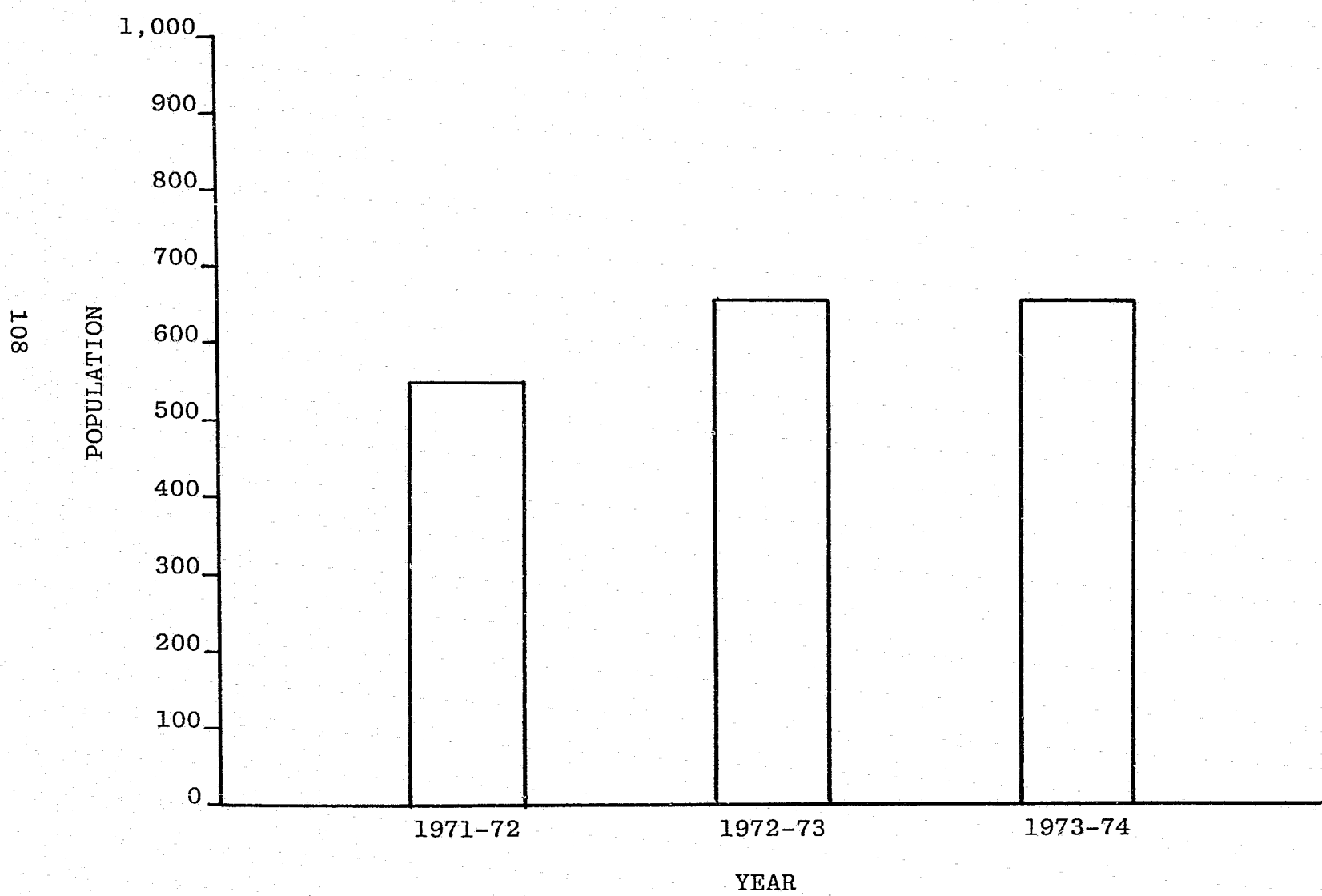
