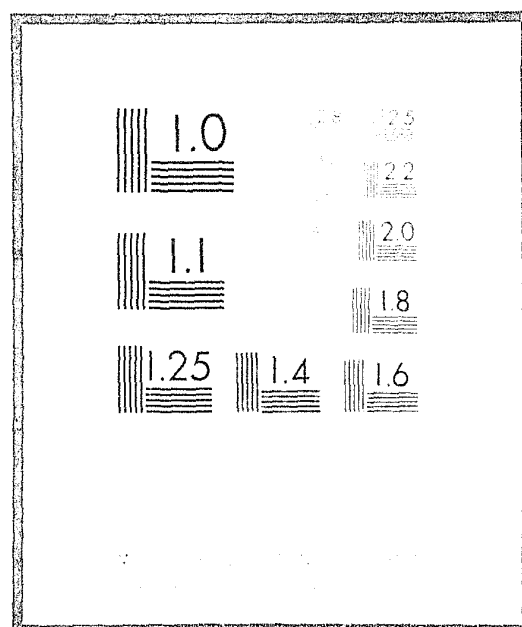

COMMITMENTS TO COUNTY AND CITY JAILS AND CITY JAIL FARMS YEAR ENDED JUNE 30, 1975

Race and Sex:

Of the 149,092 commitments to county and city jails and city jail farms reported during the fiscal year which ended June 30, 1975, 100,681 or 67.5 percent were white and 48,411 or 32.5 percent were non-white. Only 8.4 percent (12,493) of the commitments were female.

Age:

There were 6,573 persons committed to jail under 18 years of age, representing 4.4 percent of the total.

Offenses:

An analysis of the offenses shows that those against decency, peace and good order were most frequent (51,268 or 34.4 percent); violations of traffic and vehicle laws were second, with 30,625 or 20.5 percent, and offenses against property were third with 27,705 commitments, or 18.6 percent. Within the refined breakdown of offenses, the two most common were drunkenness/drunk and disorderly, accounting for one-fourth of all commitments (37,117 or 24.9 percent), and driving under the influence of intoxicants (16,765 or 11.2 percent of the total). Incarcerations in jail due to violations of the narcotic drug laws numbered 6,897 (4.6 percent).

Type of Offense:

Of the total commitments, more than half were charged with misdemeanors (83,433 or 56.0 percent), while 33,525 (22.5 percent) were charged with violation of local ordinances ("other" offenses), and 32,131 (21.5 percent) with felonies.

Place Committed From:

Virginia counties accounted for 55.7 percent of the jail commitments, and the cities 44.3 percent. Of the 83,008 commitments by counties, Fairfax had by far the largest number, with 9,532. Arlington, with 3,889, and Henrico, with 3,804, represented the second and third largest number of county commitments, respectively. Of the 66,084 city commitments, Norfolk accounted for 11,848, while Roanoke had 8,493 and Richmond, 6,564.

Average Number of Days in Jail Per Commitment:

The average length of stay in jail per commitment during fiscal 1975 was 10.3 days.

Average Daily Population of Jails:

The average daily population of the jails during the fiscal year was 4,217.

APPENDIX I EXPLANATION OF COVERAGE

A separate commitment is reported each time a person is confined in jail on a charge of having violated a law or ordinance, for being inebriate or insane, as a material witness in a criminal case, for investigation, for protection, or for any other legal reason. The confinement may be before or after adjudication of the case in which the prisoner is involved. A person who is recommitted after being released on bond or otherwise released, is reported each time the person is placed in jail.

APPENDIX II DATA SOURCE

The statistics contained in this report were obtained from the Forms DC-J6, Record of Prisoners Confined in Jail. These forms are submitted monthly by the individual jails and jail farms to the Department of Corrections, Bureau of Institutional Services, Jails Reimbursement Section. The primary function of these documents is to serve as a basis for determining costs of operation and amount of State reimbursement for local jails and city jail farms. To serve the secondary function, that of providing statistical data, the forms are then transmitted to the Bureau of Management Information, Production Group, which edits the pertinent data and computer processes them. The resulting computer prints are then used by the Reporting Group to compile statistical reports. All prisoner day figures, calculated by the individual jails, are manually edited by the Jails Reimbursement Section, and are not computer processed.

It should be noted that no comparisons have been made in this report with fiscal year 1974. Data on the jail commitments for that year were incomplete; as noted in the report for fiscal 1974, approximately 7,500 commitments were not included. Any comparisons made, therefore, should be viewed accordingly.
