

Dear User,

This is the second publication of the Management Data Book by the Corrections Research and Statistics Bureau. This Data Book, utilizing the experiences gained by the first publication, again attempts to provide timely and useful statistics for use in the areas of corrections and parole.

There have been quite a few changes in the format and style of the second publication. Many of the tables in the first data book have been deleted for one of the following reasons: (1) the table was too complicated; (2) the data, in the Bureau's opinion, was not useful; and (3) the source of the data was found to contain ambiguities that could totally distort the picture of what actually occurred.

CAUTION: Before making comparisons between data from the first publication and the second, be sure to first check with Corrections Research and Statistics Bureau, since many of the definitions used are not identical.

This Management Data Book primarily focuses on fiscal year 1975-76 data and is intended to be utilized as a management tool for correctional administrators. However, in keeping with the executive policy of open government, we are making this information available to the public.

We realize that data in any form may be misused or misinterpreted. It is hoped that this will not happen. The research staff of the Bureau will be more than willing to assist the user in clarification or further interpretation of the data. 



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INTRODUCTION

The ultimate objective of Corrections Research and Statistics Bureau in the development of the Management Data Book is to clear the field of corrections of ambiguous and unusable statistical information. It is our hope that, eventually, this data book will evolve into what might be referred to as a corrections 'Bible' of information from which uniform and employable statistical inferences may be utilized toward assisting the Corrections Division in its pursuit of sound and effective rehabilitation programs.

The above stated objective is not one that can be accomplished by the staff of CRSB alone, but requires the cooperation of all agencies involved. Statistics is a management tool that could prove to be a very powerful one when not abused. Abuse, however, is not the only vulnerability of statistics. Statistical inferences can only be as accurate as the information or data that is fed into the research unit. This is why the establishment of stable and consistent lines of communication between the users and the researchers is vitally important to maximizing the benefits of research.

The evolvement of the data book into a corrections "Bible" itself depends heavily on the cooperation of the users and agencies out in the field. Without proper feedback from the users, the research staff will have a difficult time in determining what information is needed and what information is useless. For this reason, each figure in this data book will be accompanied by a feedback mechanism comprised of a brief questionnaire to be filled out by the user and sent to our office. This will assist the

research team in determining which types of information should be maintained and continue to be published. User cooperation in this determination will be greatly appreciated.

Information on population accounting and movement will be published as a separate report by this office sometime in January, 1977.

This is the calendar year by which the admissions populations were segregated. This was obtained by dropping the month and day figures of the admissions date.



DEFINITIONS

SECURITY CLASSIFICATIONS

The following classification scheme is that which is used by the Corrections Division to label the degree of security risk a resident obtains as he passes through the corrections system.

- (1) Close A resident whose degree of risk is not yet determined.
- (2) Maximum A resident who requires constant observation because of his high risk.
- (3) Medium-close A resident who is considered to be medium security risk but cannot be allowed to do work outside of the facility's walls.
- (4) Medium A resident who is considered to be medium security risk and is permitted, on occassion, to do work outside of the facility.
- (5) Minimum A resident who is considered to be minimum security risk and is usually allowed to work in the community.













COMPLAINTS PERTAINING TO CORRECTIONS AND PAROLE SUBMITTED TO THE OMBUDSMAN DURING FY: 75 - 76

DEFINITIONS

MEDICAL TREATMENT OF INMATE

This type of complaint refers to those relating to medical mistreatment or the lack of proper medical care for an inmate.

PERSONAL BELONGINGS OF INMATE

This type of complaint pertains to the loss of personal belongings of an immate by the State or its officials.

PHYSICAL SAFETY OF INMATES

This type of complaint pertains to the fear of physical harm to the inmate.

PROGRAMMING OF INMATE

This type of complaint pertains to facility procedures or living conditions.

FACILITY EMPLOYEES

This type of complaint pertains to misconduct on the part of a facility employee.

PAROLE BOARD ACTIONS

This type of complaint pertains to decisions of the Parole Board.

PUBLIC SAFETY

This type of complaint pertains to Corrections Division policies and procedures relating to public safety.

OTHER

This type of complaint pertains to complaints that do not clearly fit into any of the above categories.

FOOTNOTE

¹ Other - This includes the following:

- (a) A request to baptize an inmate's child within the prison that was turned down.
- (b) A request to marry an inmate within the prison that was turned down.
- (c) An employee of one of the facilities made a complaint regarding his pay.

PURPOSE

The information given in this table enables the user to see the types of complaints that are submitted to the Office of the Ombudsman. This information could be used to locate problem areas within Corrections Division.



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
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
