

I. INTRODUCTION

It is the purpose of this report to update the statistical factors used in evaluating the performance of the Major Offense Bureau from its inception to the present time. Attention is called to the previous eight reports which accurately reflect the present operation and policies of the Bureau. Consequently, this report will be brief and largely statistical. In evaluating these statistics it should be noted that the last quarter reflected in this report covered two months, namely, July and August, in which the Criminal Justice System operates at less than full capacity due to the exercising of vacational privileges by those who maintain the System.

II. STATISTICAL ANALYSIS OF OPERATIONS

A. <u>CASE LOAD</u>: This past quarter the Major Offense Bureau obtained an additional 53 Indictments covering an additional 93 Defendants, thereby bringing the total number accepted for prosecution to 679 Indictments covering 1,015 Defendants.

These figures reveal the following pertinent information: Of those prosecuted by the Major Offense Bureau, 762

Defendants involving 535 Indictments have been convicted. 445

Defendants were convicted of the top count of the Indictment while not one defendant in the Control Group has been convicted of a Class "A" Felony, and only 17 have been convicted of a Class "B" Felony. In addition, in the Control Group only 27 were convicted of the top count, three of which were Class "E" Felonies. A comparison of the level of disposition of the cases within each group indicates that those cases disposed of within the Major Offense Bureau are two grade levels above those of the dispositions within the Control Group.

A further analysis of those cases disposed of by the Major Offense Bureau reflects that the median time span from arrest to final disposition is 85 days. More than 15% of those defendants being prosecuted by the Major Offense Bureau have requested and obtained psychiatric examinations. The average delay caused by said examination is approximately 60 days.

A clear indication of the relationship between the speed and the quality of disposition is evidenced by the fact that 80% of the cases handled by the Major Offense Bureau have reached disposition as against 55% of those cases in the Control Group. Thus, the superior quality of disposition in the Major Offense Bureau cases may be attributed to the fact that these cases are handled in a uniform manner, and brought to a speedy disposition by highly experienced personnel.

Ninety-five (95%) percent of all cases prosecuted by the Major Offense Bureau resulted in conviction. For the same period the conviction rate for the City of New York was approximately 75%.

C. TRIALS:

Beginning in September of 1973, two trial parts in the Supreme Court were designated as Major Offense Bureau Trial Parts. To date, 141 cases involving 182 Defendants were brought to trial. During the course of these trials, 71 Defendants pleaded guilty to the charges. Of those remaining. 77 were found guilty, 16 were acquitted, 2 were dismissed by the court. 8 were granted a mistrial as result of a jury disagreement*, and 8 were in the process of trial at the time of this report.

Thus, the conviction rate of these defendants brought to trial is 90%.

By way of comparison, in the very same period only 59 defendants in the Control Group were brought to trial. Of these, 23 were acquitted, 24 were convicted, 5 were dismissed, 3 pleaded guilty during trial. 3 were granted mistrials and one was engaged on trial at the time of this report. The conviction rate for cases brought to trial within the Control Group is 48%.

*Four defendants were subsequently retried and found guilty on all counts, one plead guilty to the entire indictment prior to retrial and three are awaiting retrial.

A comparison of the sentences imposed upon those defendants prosecuted by the Major Offense Bureau and those defendants prosecuted within the Control Group reflects that the average sentence imposed is substantially different. 93% of those defendants prosecuted by the Major Offense Bureau received a sentence of incarceration as opposed to 60% of those prosecuted within the Control Group. The defendants prosecuted by the Major Offense Bureau received an average sentence of 10 years whereas those prosecuted in the Control Group received an average sentence of 2.3 years. The court imposed a minimum sentence in 55% of the Major Offense Bureau cases, but did so in only 16% of the Control Group's cases. The average minimum sentence imposed in Major Offense Bureau cases is 3 years in contrast to an average of 4 months in the Control Group. Thus, the minimum sentence imposed upon a defendant prosecuted by the Major Offense Pureau was greater than the maximum imposed on those prosecuted in the Control Group.

III. CONCLUSION

The contents of this report to a large degree speak for themselves. Clearly the operation and performance of the Major Offense Bureau has reached a level of consistency that reflects a constant attainment of its stated purposes. Public knowledge and support of the Bureau and its achievements continue to grow.

In September, the L.E.A.A. convened a conference which brought together the eleven jurisdictions which have functioning bureaus dealing specifically with the Career Criminal. Present were Attorney-General Edward Ievi, the chief prosecutor for each jurisdiction, the local Chief of Police, and many members of the judiciary. After day-long work shops, President Ford joined the meeting and was briefed as to the progress of these programs. The Bronx County project was singled out for its achievements and as a model for the other ten jurisdictions. The President's remarks indicated his support for these programs and the significant part they play in the national effort to combat crime.
