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# Virginia's Jail Population Awaiting Trial/Tried

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#### PURPOSE OF THE STUDY

The purpose of this study is to document the population of convicted prisoners and prisoners awaiting trial in the local jails of Virginia, in order to arrive at the number of convicted felons and misdemeanants in the state as a whole and the nature and composition of the jail population.

A look at the rated capacity and population statistics for state institutions<sup>1</sup> explains why this task was undertaken. The Department of Corrections has released figures for June 30, 1973, 1974, and 1975 for these institutions (see Appendix 1). Total confinements on these dates showed a 6% decrease in 1973, a 6% increase in 1974, and a 1% increase in 1975. Capacity statistics as compared to population (see Appendix 11) may explain this apparent leveling off of population growth in the state system. As of December 1, 1975, the figures show a rated capacity for operational institutions of 5,640 inmates, and a population of 6,231. It is apparent from this that the state system is currently at capacity.

As such, the population figure is one constrained by false boundaries, as it is so near capacity. Therefore, the plateau in population should not suggest that conviction rates are also leveling off but that regardless of convictions, the system cannot admit many more inmates, without expanding facilities. While actual conviction rates are unavailable, it is reasonable

to assume that convictions have not declined to a level consistent with the lack of growth shown in the state institution population. Even if conviction rates have remained the same over the past several years, there should be offenders committed to the system consistently. Due to the capacity and population rates, however, these inmates cannot be brought into the state correctional system.

In light of this, it has been suggested that the backlog of convicted offenders is being maintained in local jails, for lack of immediate alternatives. Table I shows Commitments, Prisoner Days, and Average Length of Stay for prisoners in local jails for fiscal years 1970 through 1975, with percent of change over previous year in parentheses.

Of particular interest, in order to compare with state institution figures mentioned earlier, are the 1975 figures. These show a nearly 8% increase commitments over 1974 and a 15.3% increase in average length of stay for the same period.

The tables that follow represent an effort to document what kind of prisoners are reflected in these jail statistics. They show jail population

on June 30, 1974 and 1975, by Planning District, by Jail, including state-wide totals. Table III shows this population by tried/awaiting trial, municipality charged for prisoner maintenance (local, state, or federal), and offense category (felon, misdemeanor, and ordinance). Table III describes the population by tried/awaiting trial, race and sex.

## METHODOLOGY

The data in the tables were drawn manually from the J-6 form, filed by the local jail to the Jail Pre-Audit Section of the Department of Corrections for the purpose of reimbursement for state prisoners in the jail.

The J-6 of July for each year included in the study was used as it lists prisoners actually in the jail on the night of June 30 prior to listing July commitments. The date of June 30 was chosen for this study as it is the last day of the fiscal year. It is also the day for which data are reported in the Department of Corrections' Annual Report for prisoners in state institutions. Comparable data from the jails would thus give a picture of the total incarcerated population in the state on that date.

There are several potential limitations in this method.

Firstly, as in any manual data collection process, there is the opportunity for human error.

Secondly, because this had to be done manually, there was a time limit determining how many years could be included, and how many days in those years could be done. Certainly a five year span and a quarterly sample of days or months would have greatly increased the usefulness of this study, particularly in establishing trends over time. However, this would have extended the time required for data collection by months.

### DISCUSSION OF TABLES II AND III

In analyzing the statewide totals for Table II, the following percentage differences apply:

While total population only increase by 2% in 1975 over 1974, the total tried population increased by 22%. The greatest increase within the tried population was among felons charged to the state, which increase by 68%. All other categories within the tried population showed mild increases, except for tried misdemeanants charged to local government, which decreased sharply by 96%.

One hypotheses or possible interpretation of the increase in the felon population is that by 1974 misdemeanants were already being kept after trial in the local jail, but that felons were being transferred to state institutions. By 1975, the situation in state institutions had reached the point of near capacity and felons were therefore also being left in the local jails awaiting transfer.

Of those awaiting trial, again the greatest increase, +15%, was by felons charged to the state. All other categories decreased, with ordinance offenders showing the greatest decrease, -69%. There was an overall decrease of 11% among those awaiting trial.

Table III reveals the following percentage differences statewide for 1975 over 1974:

#### SUMMARY AND CONCLUSIONS

In general, the following conditions were found to exist, based on the June 30, 1974 and 1975 populations in the jails:

1. The number of offenders awaiting trial decreased between 1974 and 1975; those tried and either sentenced or awaiting sentencing increased;
2. The number of felons charged to the state in local jails increased substantially; the number of felons charged to the federal government declined;
3. The number of misdemeanants charged to the state declined substantially, as did misdemeanants charged to the locality;
4. The number of local ordinance offenders declined overall;
5. Regarding race and sex, non-white males showed a substantial increase; all others declined overall;
6. And the total population only increased slightly.

While data covering two years cannot establish a trend, these statistics do suggest certain questions that need to be considered by Corrections Planners and public decision makers. A discussion of some of these questions follow.

Firstly, jails have traditionally served to house offenders awaiting trial and those who have received short sentences (usually 12 months or less or weekend sentences). However, this study shows that not only did the

number of those awaiting trial in local jails decrease between 1974 and 1975, but also that those tried and being maintained in jails after trial increased. Further, the number of felons in this population increased considerably while those guilty of less serious crimes decreased.

Are local jails equipped with the personnel necessary for maintaining large numbers of felons?

Given that state institutions are full, how long must the jails maintain these prisoners? If for an extended period, should programs be provided for this population?

Following from the above, what is the feasibility of establishing the jails as community corrections centers? And what will be the public reaction to maintaining felons in such local centers?

These are but a few of the issues which need to be addressed if these population figures are in any way indicative of future conditions.


