


Juvenile Detentions in California  
Jails and Lockups  
1976 and 1977

This report presents a statistical summary of the total number of juveniles detained in California local jails or lockups during 1976 and 1977. Information is also presented on the number of minors held in detention for 24 hours or more.

The Department of the Youth Authority is legally mandated to inspect facilities that detain minors in excess of 24 hours. To carry out the mandate, the CYA conducts annual surveys of the 539 jails and lockups in the state in order to determine which facilities detain minors. Those facilities reporting detention of minors in excess of 24 hours are inspected for conformance to minimal standards by CYA staff. In addition, these facilities are required to submit reports to the CYA on the number and characteristics of minors detained for more than 24 hours. These data were collected beginning in July 1976.

Data in this report come from two sources: (1) annual surveys completed by local jails in 1976 and 1977, giving the number of youths detained for any period during the year, and (2) monthly reports completed by local jails on the number of youths detained in excess of 24 hours.

These data, which emanate from the local agencies, are presented in the following tables, grouped by county and, in an appendix, by reporting jurisdiction. The accuracy of the data has been liberally accepted, but in some cases adjustments were required when the number of detentions reported via the two data collection forms were not in agreement.

Table 1 presents the number of youths detained in secure facilities in each county as reported in the 1976 and 1977 annual surveys. Also shown are the county juvenile population aged 10 to 17, the number of juvenile arrests, and the number of minors detained for more than 24 hours. The figures for population are official estimates prepared by the Population Accounting Unit of the Department of Finance. The data on juvenile arrests are those collected by the Bureau of Criminal Statistics. One further feature presented in Table 1 is the rate of juvenile arrests per 1,000 juvenile population.

#### Juvenile Arrests

Included are all reported arrests of juveniles on felony, misdemeanor, and delinquent tendency charges. In 1976, there were a total of 353,752 juvenile arrests statewide, and 313,955 in 1977, a decrease of 11.2%. In all but six counties (Alpine, Humboldt, Kern, San Bernardino, Santa Cruz, and Yolo) the number of reported juvenile arrests went down in 1977.

#### Arrest Rates

Based on the juvenile population figure and the number of juvenile arrests, an arrest rate per 1,000 juveniles was calculated for each county for both years.\* For the total state, the 1976 juvenile arrest rate was 115.1, and in 1977 it was 104.4, a 9.3% reduction. There were reductions in the 1977 arrest rate in all but six counties. The largest reductions occurred in Lake (59.2%), Mono (85.2%), and San Benito (62.8%). In 1977, the annual arrest rates ranged from a low of 8.4 per 1,000 juveniles in Mono County to 169.8 per 1,000 in Shasta County.

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\*Arrest rates were not calculated in Alpine and Sierra counties due to juvenile populations in those counties being well below 1,000.

Juvenile Jail Detentions

In 1976, there were 166,224 reported detentions of minors in 286 secure facilities throughout the state. Of the 520 facilities surveyed, 227 reported no juvenile detentions, and 7 reported that the detention data were not available.

In 1977, there were 144,316 reported detentions in 284 statewide lockups. Of the 520 facilities surveyed, 234 reported no juvenile detention, and 2 reported that the detention data were not available.

From 1976 to 1977, the number of minors detained in jails decreased 13.2%. The percentage change varied widely among counties, as shown in Table 2.

A total of 41 counties (70.7%) showed a decrease in the number of detentions in 1977; 17 counties (29.3%) showed an increase.

The figures on jail detentions require some qualification. The numbers do not represent individual detentions, but rather the incidents of bookings and detentions. The figure may include multiple bookings: for example, a

minor may be booked into an outlying facility where the offense occurred, only to be transferred to a main or central facility, or to another county jurisdiction where a booking is again recorded (each facility would separately report the booking/detention). For this reason we cannot compare the number of detentions with the number of arrests, since it is possible that a single arrest could result in more than one booking.

Decreases in detentions may have resulted from a number of factors, including (1) a change in legislation affecting detention of minors (e.g., AB 3121), (2) a change in local detention policies, (3) a reduction in the number of available jail beds, (4) a reduction in juvenile arrests, etc. Jail detentions within each reporting facility are presented in Appendix A.

#### 24-Hour Detentions

The final column in Table 1 lists the number of juveniles detained for more than 24 hours. For 1976, the number of 24-hour detentions is that which occurred between July and December 1976 (the monthly reporting system was initiated in July 1976). For 1977, two figures are shown: the first, in parentheses, is the number of 24-hour detentions that occurred during July to December 1977; the second figure is the total 24-hour detentions for 1977. The percentage change figure is based on the two comparable six-month periods in 1976 and 1977.

The data in Table 3 summarize the data on 24-hour-plus detentions for the total state from July 1976 to December 1977. In the final six months of 1976, there were 1,738 such detentions in 35 counties; in the final six months of 1977, the figure was 1,050 in 31 counties, resulting in a decrease of 39.6% in the number of juveniles detained for more than 24 hours between the two comparable time periods. More complete data on the number of 24-hour detentions, by reporting jurisdiction, are shown in Appendix B.

Jail Detention in Relation to Presence of Juvenile Halls

It might be expected that minors are more frequently detained in those counties that do not have a local juvenile probation detention facility. Table 4 shows the total number of detentions and detentions in excess of 24 hours that occurred in counties with juvenile halls compared to the number that occurred in counties without juvenile halls.

In 1977, in the 40 counties with juvenile halls, there were 142,668 minors booked in local jails, and in the 18 counties without halls 1,648 minors were booked. The rate of bookings (per 1,000 juvenile population) was 48.3 in counties with halls and 30.4 in counties without halls.

Regarding detentions of minors in excess of 24 hours, there were in 1977 a total of 1,706 such detentions in 21 counties with halls\*, and 497 in 12 counties without halls.\*\* The rate (per 1,000 juvenile population) was much higher in counties without halls: 9.2 compared to a rate of 0.6 for counties with halls. While numerically more minors were detained over 24 hours in counties with halls, the rate of such detentions was higher in counties without halls.

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\*Of the 40 counties with halls, 19 did not detain minors in excess of 24 hours.

\*\*Of the 18 counties without halls, 6 did not detain minors in excess of 24 hours.

## Appendix A

Appendix A lists for each reporting jurisdiction the number of juvenile bookings/detentions for 1976 and 1977. The data are grouped by county. Within the county are listed the number of detentions by the sheriff's department and for each city police department within the county. Percent changes in detentions were not calculated when the base number was too small (less than 10 cases). Where data were reported as not available, N/A appears in the column.

## Appendix B

The data presented in Appendix B are taken from the monthly reports filed by those facilities that detained minors in excess of 24 hours. This data collection system was initiated in July 1976. The data are presented for three six-month periods: July-December 1976, January-June 1977, and July-December 1977.

For each time period, the following data are shown: total detentions in excess of 24 hours, number of males and females, type of booking charge (602, 601, or other), data on length of stay in detention, and the disposition of cases at release.

During the three time periods, there were 1,738, 1,153, and 1,050 24-hour detentions, respectively. The number of females was small in each period. The majority of detentions were for 602 charges. In the last six months of 1976, there were 446 status offenders detained in jails in excess of 24 hours. In the first six months of 1977, there were 116 detained status offenders, and 189 during the last six months of 1977.

Length of stay in detention is presented in two ways. Data reported on forms used during 1976 did not allow for computation of an average length of stay; the only data available were the number of minors detained for longer than 14 days. The form was revised in 1977, and it was possible to calculate an actual average length of stay (in addition to the number of detentions over 14 days). In early 1977, the LOS was 9.9 days; in late 1977, the LOS was 9.2 days.

The reporting form used in 1976 also did not provide data on dispositions. In 1977, data were available for the following dispositions: transferred to other detention facility, released outright, released to probation or parole, released after serving sentence, and other.
