

1978 JUVENILE DETENTION REPORT

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ACQUISITIONS

## INTRODUCTION

During the past couple of years, new emphasis and direction have been applied to the area of the detention of juveniles.

The Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention Act contains guidelines which state that:

- a. No status offenders should be held in detention prior to trial; however, if held, it should be for no longer than 24 hours.
- b. All juveniles should be placed in non-secure detention facilities when possible.
- c. All juveniles who must be placed in a detention facility should be separated from adults and removed as soon as possible.

In South Carolina, as of July 1, 1978, all juvenile probation and intake functions were subsumed under a state system administered by the Department of Juvenile Placement and Aftercare (JP&A). This unified system created increased emphasis on coordination between intake officers and detention authorities to assist in removing juveniles from jails when possible and to decrease the length of stay in detention facilities when appropriate. Several other entities, the Alston Wilkes Society, various group homes, and emergency shelters have increased the concern over removal of juveniles from jails.

This environment of concern and activity raised several questions regarding current detention practice.

1. How many juveniles are being detained and where?
2. Who are the juveniles being detained?
3. How long are juveniles being detained?
4. When are the peak periods for juvenile detention?  
When should those entities involved in finding other environments for these juveniles be most active?

This report is an attempt to answer the above questions and provide all agencies involved with a clearer picture of the extent and nature of juvenile detention.

#### Report Methodology

The statistics, results and inferences presented in this report are based on monthly compilations from South Carolina's detention facilities that held juveniles for the year 1978. Data collected included age, race, sex, admission date and time, and discharge date and time for each juvenile held in South Carolina as reported by these facilities.

The South Carolina Department of Youth Services collected the data from facilities monthly on a standardized form along with instructions on the procedures used to complete the forms (See Attachment A). The types of offense were broken down into two (2) groups and each offense given a code number. These two offense groups are: (1) criminal offense (an act committed that is in violation of the law for both juveniles and adults) and (2) status offense (an act which is prohibited for a juvenile but which would not be a crime if committed by an adult). A list of each offense and code number is as follows:

The South Carolina Department of Youth Services received the juvenile detention reports until October, 1978, at which time the South Carolina Department of Corrections (SCDC) began receiving them. Once these forms were gathered from both agencies, data were taken from each form and recorded for analytical purposes. Each detention facility that reported holding juveniles was given a code number, the age of each juvenile in years was entered along with their race (coded: white-W; non-white-N,) sex (male-M; female-F), offense (coded as shown in Table 1), admission date and time (date - day/month/year; time - military hours) and discharge date and time (coded same as admission). At the completion of recording the information, the data were keypunched and set up for analysis. One hundred and forty-two facilities reported the data. Seventy-five of these held juveniles.

The first step taken to measure these data was to compute cross tabulation tables (joint frequency distributions) for the 46 counties and 75 of the 142 reporting detention facilities in South Carolina. Implications from these tables showed that there were certain counties and facilities with a greater workload of juveniles than for others and also that there were several peak days and hours when juveniles were most often admitted to the facilities.

Mean Number of Juveniles Detained

Further examination of the data pointed out that there were eleven (11) counties and seventeen (17) facilities (as seen in Tables 2A and 2B) that detained a large number of juveniles for 1978. The mean by county for juveniles held was 142 and the mean for the facilities was 83. Any counties or facilities holding more juveniles than the respective mean were considered to hold a large workload.

Day & Time of Detention

From these same cross tabulation tables, data were taken to measure specific days and hours when juveniles were most often admitted to the detention facilities. Table 3 shows the total number of juveniles admitted to detention facilities

for each day of the week. Tuesday was the day of the week for 1978 which had the highest number of juveniles (1,002) admitted.

In table 4, the total number of juveniles is shown by admission time. The hours during the day with the largest number of juveniles admitted was 4 p.m. to 8 p.m. There were 1,662 juveniles admitted during this time period for 1978. These tables showing the day and time of detention should help in scheduling intake officers on a daily and hourly basis so they can efficiently handle the current juvenile workload for the detention facilities in South Carolina.

EXTENDED RESEARCH ON JUVENILE DATA

The collected juvenile data was set up to provide further cross tabulation tables. Data was used to give a breakdown of juvenile offenders by age, by sex, by offense and by

length of stay. For each breakdown, three cross tabulation tables were computed. One analysis gives data on the total number of juvenile offenders held for 1978. The other two analyses are breakdowns of the total, one showing juvenile criminal offenders and the other juvenile status offenders. Due to unreported offenses for some of the juvenile offenders held in 1978, the sum for criminal offenders and status offenders will not equal the total number of juveniles held.

#### Breakdown of Juvenile Offenders by Age

This cross tabulation shows a breakdown of juvenile offenders by age. There are 8 categories used for age, beginning with ages 9 or less up to age 16. The most frequent age for the total number of juvenile offenders detained was age 16 with 2,671 or 38% of total juveniles held in 1978. Age 16 is again the mode when juvenile offenders were divided among the two offense groups. For criminal offenders age 16, there were 1,658 or 41% of total criminal offenders held and for status offenders age 16, there were 622 or 32% of total status offenders held.

Breakdown of Juveniles by Sex

The cross tabulations for juveniles by sex shows that more males were held in 1978 than females. For the total number of juveniles held, 5,146 or 72% were male. Of these, 3,304 or 64% were criminal offenders and 1,036 or 20% were status offenders. The remaining number of juvenile offenders held were female, 1,886 or 27% of total juvenile offenders. Of the total number of female juvenile offenders, 751 or 40% of total female offenders were criminal offenders and 881 or 47% of total female juvenile offenders were status offenders.

Breakdown of Juvenile Offenders by Offense

These tables show a breakdown of the total number of juveniles held in 1978 by offense group - criminal offense or status offense. The most frequent offense group was criminal. For criminal offenders, there were 4,075 or 58% of total juveniles detained in 1978. There were 1,920 status offenders held in 1978 or 27% of the total juveniles.

### Breakdown by Length of Stay

The breakdown of juveniles by length of stay gives five time frames (012 hours, 13-14 hours, 25-36 hours, 37-48 hours, 49+ hours) to show how long juveniles were detained in 1978. For the total number of juveniles held, most of them 2,595 or 37%, were held during the 0-12 hour time frame. The next most frequent time frame for detaining a high number of juveniles was 49+ hours. There were 1,794 or 25% held for 49+ hours or longer.

Of the criminal offenders, held between 0-12 hours, there were 1,614 or 40% of total criminal offenders and of status offenders held there were 651 or 34 % of total status offenders held between 0-12 hours. The next most frequent time frame for criminal offenders was 49+ hours with 1,059 or 26% of total criminal offenders. The next most frequent time frame for status offenders was 13-24 hours with 489 or 25% of total status offenders being held.




