IN 1978

Selected characteristics of juveniles who were first-released and re-released during the years 1974-1978 are reported in Tables A through D. Information regarding juveniles released to aftercare in calendar year 1978 is found in Tables 1 through 14. Information regarding juveniles directly discharged or discharged by court order from juvenile correctional institutions in calendar year 1978 is found in Table 3 and in Appendices A (males) and B (females).

Note: Since the age of majority in the State of Wisconsin is 18, case termination becomes effective at that age, thus having the impact of reducing the average (mean) length of stay (months served).

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The average (mean) length of stay for first-released juvenile males reversed its downward trend for the second successive year, rising from 7.8 months to 8.2 months. There was an approximately 50 percent decrease in the proportion of juvenile males with excellent vocational progress in the institutions. There was also a marked decline in the percentages of those who had an excellent institution adjustment and those who made excellent educational progress in the institution.

The average (mean) length of stay for first-released juvenile females also reversed its downward trend, rising from 4.7 months to 6.1 months. The percentages of those with excellent institutional adjustment and excellent educational or vocational progress in the institution all declined from 1977 to 1978. The percentage of juvenile females released to the Southeastern and Western Region rose by about 50 percent, while the percentage released to the Milwaukee Region declined by roughly 40 percent.

The percentage of juvenile males re-released to Milwaukee County reversed its downward trend, rising from 16.2 percent to 28.7 percent. The percentage of those with excellent institutional adjustment and excellent educational progress continued to decline, but the percentage with excellent vocational progress rose significantly.

The average length of stay for re-released juvenile females rose sharply, from 4.7 months to a five-year high of 8.5 months. None of the 13 juvenile females re-released in 1978 showed excellent institutional adjustment or excellent educational or vocational progress.

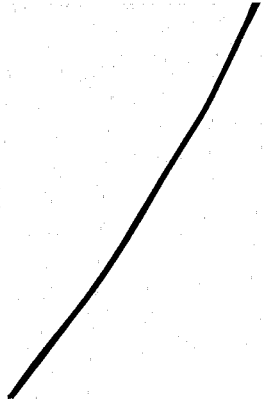
