YOUTHFUL OFFENDER SUMMARY

Data Source:

The data used to produce the felon tables were extracted from felon inmate files located in the Division of Adult Services, under the File Maintenance section of Classification and Treatment Services.

The criterion used in selecting the Youthful Offenders of the confined population was the age at the time of commitment. This differs from the criterion used in the Annual Statistical Report of Felons Confined which reflects age on June 30, the last day of the fiscal year. There are many felons who were under age twenty-three when they were initially committed but who are reflected in the Annual Statistical Report as over age twenty-three on June 30.

Age, Race and Sex:

Among the youthful offenders, the modal group is black males between the ages of eighteen and twenty. These males comprise over 26 per cent of all youthful offenders for 1974, 1975 and 1976. The total youthful offender population in 1976 is composed of 37.0 percent white males, 1.3 percent white females, 59.5 percent black males, 1.9 percent black females, and 0.3 percent other males. In analyzing the age composition of the group in 1976 there are 8.4 percent between ages 15 and 17 years, 45.2 percent between 18 and 20 years, and 46.4 percent between 21 years and 23 years.

Prior Criminal Record:

The percentage of youthful offenders with no prior felony or misdemeanor convictions has increased over the last three fiscal years. In 1974, 40.7 percent had no prior convictions; in 1975 there were 59.1 percent in this category and at the end of 1976 the percentage increased to 67.5 percent.

Although the percentage of youthful offenders with no prior felony or misdemeanor convictions has increased, it is significant to note that over sixty percent of the youthful offenders do have a juvenile record.

Term of Sentence:

Although the modal category for term of sentence is less than five years, the percentage ratio of this category to the total group has decreased from 40.2 percent in 1974 to only 30.8 percent in 1976. The term of

sentences for youthful offenders appears to be shifting towards longer terms. In 1976 there are almost as many offenders with sentences of six to ten years (27.1 percent) as the modal category of one to five years (30.8 percent). Youthful offenders with life sentences increased from 5.3 percent in 1974 to 6.1 percent in 1976.

Committing Court:

The county courts committed 38 percent of the youthful offenders during the three fiscal years, with Fairfax County committing the largest number of youths.

City courts committed 62 percent of the youthful offenders; Richmond committed the largest amount in all three years with 16.7 percent of the youthful offenders confined in 1976.

Committing Offense:

Offenses against persons have increased from 49.5 percent in 1974 to 56.2 percent in 1976. The offenses against property have therefore decreased from 37.5 percent in 1974 to 33.3 percent in 1976. The most prevalent crime is Robbery followed by Burglary, Break and Enter. Violators of narcotic drug laws have decreased from 11.3 percent in 1974 to 9.0 percent in 1976.

Habits:

The percentage of youthful offenders with no record of either drug use or liquor habits has decreased slightly from 11.0 percent in 1974 to 7.8 percent in 1976. In 1976, 30.2 percent were heavy drinkers and 64.2 percent were drug users.

Intelligence and Education:

Almost one half (49.4 percent) of the youthful offenders fall into the normal intelligence range, an additional one third fall below the normal intelligence range. The modal category of tested education is intermediate which ranges from the fifth grade level to the eighth grade level. In 1976 20.5 percent were classified as illiterate.



BY AGE**



BY COMMITTING OFFENSE**



BY HABITS**


