

1978 COUNTY JAIL AND DETENTION FACILITY REPORT

ACQUISITIONS

This bulletin makes available statewide information on adult and juvenile confinements to county detention facilities in Wisconsin during calendar year 1978. Included in the category of county detention facilities are: county jails, Dane County Huber Center, Milwaukee House of Correction, Waukesha County Huber Center, and the three juvenile detention centers located in Dane, Milwaukee, and Racine counties. City and village lockup information is included in this publication as Appendix Table 1.

The Division of Corrections, Wisconsin Department of Health and Social Services, has statutory responsibility for collecting statewide information on populations held in county and municipal detention facilities. This information currently is aggregated and reported annually by personnel of the various detention facilities who transmit it to the Division of Corrections where it is checked for accuracy and consistency and then assembled for publication.

There has been an increasing demand by planning agencies, local and state governments, criminal justice agencies in Wisconsin and other states, and the general public for more meaningful information about persons confined and detained within county detention facilities. To satisfy these demands, the Division of Corrections has been gradually implementing a computerized reporting system designed to collect basic admission, release, and social history data from Wisconsin's county jails and detention facilities. As of January 1, 1979, the Jail Information System was operational in 66 county jails and the Milwaukee House of Correction. (Three additional county jails began participation by August 1, 1979.)

SUMMARY OF 1978 COUNTY JAIL AND DETENTION FACILITY DATA

There were over 94,000 reported confinements in county detention facilities during calendar year 1978, including over 80,000 adult and over 14,000 juvenile confinements (Tables 1 and 7). The term "confinements" is used here specifically because the figures do not represent the number of different individuals confined but rather, the total number of confinements. It is known that many individuals were confined in county detention facilities more than once during the 1978 calendar year. However, there are no data specifying an unduplicated number of people held.

Information on adult confinements presented in Table 1 is categorized into two basic groupings--number held and number sentenced, with the number sentenced under Wisconsin Statute 973.09(4), confinement as a condition of probation as a sub group and included with the number sentenced. Number of adults sentenced is but one type of disposition or status reflecting detentions in county detention facilities. An adult arrested and held in a county jail may have many possible court dispositions--being dismissed, fined, given a term of probation, sentenced to a county detention facility, or sentenced to a state correctional facility. During 1978, more than 20 percent of all adult confinements had been reported as also sentenced to county detention facilities.*

As might be expected, the more populous counties generally had the greater number of confinements; e.g., during 1978, Milwaukee County institutions accounted for more than 24 percent of all adult confinements, 32 percent of all adult sentences, and 26.5 percent of all juvenile detentions. Statewide, females accounted for more than eight percent of total adult confinements, five percent of total adult sentences, and 28 percent of total juvenile detentions.

Within the publication Crime and Arrests 1978, Wisconsin's Crime Information Bureau reported that during 1978, there were 62,798 juvenile male arrests and 22,272 juvenile female arrests. Association of those statistics with the detention totals in Table 7 shows that approximately 18.5 percent of all the juvenile female arrests resulted in detention. Of juvenile male arrests, approximately 16.5 percent resulted in detention. Juvenile females thus had a slightly higher detention rate than did juvenile males.

There was more than a seven percent decrease in the number of juvenile confinements during calendar year 1978 as compared with the previous year (Table 7). The number of adult confinements increased more than 7.5 percent, and those with actual sentences increased less than one percent (Table 1).

*The percentage of sentenced cases to the total number of adult confinements can only be approximated because of the lack of uniformity in recordkeeping within the various county jails. In some jails, persons are booked each time they enter the facility. Therefore, a person booked, released on bond, and subsequently sentenced to jail under the original charge might be counted twice in some facilities and only once in others.

Table 2 reports confinements by reason for holding: traffic violations, drug violations, alleged mental illness (for adults only), and all other types. More than 44 percent of all adult confinements were for traffic violations. Drug violations accounted for 4.3 percent of total adult daily confinements and approximately three percent of juvenile confinements. There were 1,014 (1.3 percent) adult confinements for alleged mental illness, representing an increase of 97 from 1977. About 50 percent of the remaining adult confinements and more than 91 percent of the remaining juvenile confinements were held for other reasons. About five percent of all juvenile confinements were for alcohol violations (Table 7).

County personnel were asked to record the highest total adult count and date recorded for adult confinements during calendar year 1978, and make two one-day counts of juveniles confined in their facilities during the first full week of January 1979. Exact counts recorded are shown in Tables 3 and 8, respectively. Total one-day counts of juveniles held on both weekday and weekend decreased more than 55 percent from counts taken one year previously.

Tables 4 and 9 indicate the total number of adult and juvenile confinements by detaining facility and sex, according to Division of Corrections Regions for the past five years. Total adult confinements have gradually increased at a rate of approximately eight percent during 1974-77, but increased only seven percent in 1978. The most significant increases over 1977 were realized in the West (Region V) by 16.8% and South (Region I) by 11.4% while the Metropolitan Milwaukee area (including Milwaukee House of Correction) increased by 8.3% in 1978. Total juvenile confinements have decreased more than 21 percent since 1974, although the decrease from 1977 to 1978 was approximately eight percent.

Tables 5 and 10 indicate detention rates of adult and juvenile confinements to county adult and juvenile population. Total adult confinements have increased more rapidly than comparable growth (3.5%) in total adult populations during the period 1974-78, resulting in a detention rate per thousand increase of approximately 18 percent since 1974. Total juvenile confinements, however, have decreased while total juvenile population has increased. The result is a total overall juvenile detention rate decrease of more than twenty-two percent and a total juvenile detention center rate decrease of almost 26.5 percent since 1974.

Information in Table 6 relates to length of detention of juveniles in county detention facilities. Of the total number of juvenile confinements, almost 31 percent were for a duration of under one day, approximately 37 percent additionally for one to two days, and the remaining 32 percent for over two days. Since 1976 the percentage of juvenile confinements for a duration under one day has decreased 17.5 percent, while increasing about 8.5 percent for one or two days. Approximately 8.5 percent of all juvenile detentions lasted over ten days, with the majority (72.5 percent) occurring in juvenile detention centers. Total statewide detentions in juvenile detention centers for over 10 days (884) were slightly less in 1978 than in 1977 (891). Detentions of short duration most commonly occurred in the county jails. Detention center confinements (Dane, Milwaukee, and Racine counties) accounted for approximately 36 percent of total juvenile confinements.

There were 65 municipal lockups in Wisconsin in 1978, with the City of Milwaukee having seven district lockups. Local lockups differ from county detention facilities in that they can only be used to confine unsentenced persons for short periods of time (usually less than 48 hours) until either bond or initial court appearance is made. Persons held awaiting trial are transferred to county detention facilities.

A total of 64,598 confinements was reported in city and village lockups in 1978, of which 58,905 were adult and 5,693 juvenile (Appendix 1). These figures represent a 12 percent increase in total municipal confinements from 1977 and a four and one-half percent increase in juvenile municipal confinements. The district lockups in the City of Milwaukee accounted for 81.6 percent of all adult confinements and 81 percent of all juvenile confinements. Statewide, females accounted for approximately eight percent of total adult confinements and 19 percent of total juvenile confinements. This compares to an average for 1977 of 10 percent for adult confinements and 21 percent for juvenile confinements. The new Wisconsin Children's Code is expected to reduce even further these percentages.
