PROSTITUTION IN INDIA

Background to the legislation on Suppression of Immoral Traffic

The origin and history of the abolitionist movement gives an interesting account of the struggle that went on among the Prohibitionists, Regulationists and Abolitionists in various countries in Europe as well as in the United States of America in the 19th Century. The triumph of the abolitionists in most of the European nations has been attributed to the idealistic, social and moral contents of their movement. The abolitionists have held that no law would ever suppress the commercial practice of prostitution but it was essential to fight against a legal situation that made a woman an object of commerce, as such, that first objective before them was to destroy the privileges that procurers and traffickers had built up for themselves.

With the advent of abolitionism, clandestine prostitution may have become more widespread; with the stress and strain of modern civilisation and the growth of industrialisation and consequential urbanisation, the structure of the family has been undergoing a rapid change. Problems like limited accommodation in towns, irregular hours of attendance of the workers in the factories, floating population and disparity of sexes in towns due to migration, both parents being in employment and consequential lack of attention to children are some other factors to accentuate the problem.

Penal Sanction against Immoral Traffic in India :

In the Indian Penal Code, passed in the latter part of the 19th Century, some penal provisions were included for the safety and protection of women and children against kidnapping and abduction. With several variations, these provisions are still retained in the Indian Penal Code.

Similar provisions also appeared in the Children Acts of various States for the protection, rescue and rehabilitation of minor girls along with children.

As a result of the Government of India being a signatory to the International Convention of 1921, the major Presidencies of Bengal, Bombay and Madras passed laws in the year following the 1st World war for suppression of immoral traffic.

After the World War II, the International Convention for the Suppression of Immoral Traffic in Women was passed on the 9th of May, 1950 in New York. India was a signatory to this Convention which called upon each nation to tackle this problem and enact suitable laws.

Suppression of Immoral Traffic Act, 1956:

The Suppression of Immoral Traffic in Women and Girls Act, 1956 was passed by the the Parliament in 1958. The implementation of the Act is the responsibility of the State Governments. The Act envisages a comprehensive scheme of suppression of immoral traffic in women and girls by penalising the traffickers and suppressing the activities of the prostitutes. The Act also provides for the setting up of the "Protective Homes" for treatment, reformation and rehabilitation of the women and girls under the programme for Moral and Social Hygiene and After-care, initiated during the Second Plan by the Central Social Welfare Board. The States have set up district level shelters and state level homes for all types of cases of women. These Homes were declared 'Protective Homes' under the S.I.T. Act.

The Act provides penalties for the following offences :

- (a) Keeping a brothel or allowing premises to be used as a brothel (Section 3);
- (b) Procuring inducing or taking woman or girl for the sake of prostitution (Section 5);
- (c) Detaining a woman or girl in premises where prostitution is carried on (Section 6);

- (d) Prostitution in or in the vicinity of public places (Section 7);
- (e) Seducing or soliciting for the purpose of prostitution (Section 8) ; and
- (f) Seduction of a woman or girl in custody (Section 9) ;.

The legislation in India seeks to inhibit the commercialised vice, i.e., the traffic in women and girls as an organised means of earning. The Act also provides for setting up of non-official advisory bodies to assist the special police officers and prescribe that while making any search of the premises, the special police officer should be accompanied by two responsible persons from the locality, one of whom should be a woman.

Statistical Analysis:

(i) According to the information available in 1969 from 9 States and one Union Territory, there were 52 whole-time Special Officers and 151 part-time Special Police Officers and 88 Non-Official Advisory Bodies.

(ii) During 1969, 6359 women and 1214 men were brought before the courts for offences under various sections of S.I.T. Act, out of whom 4359 women and 419 men were convicted; 135 women were sent to Protective Homes.

(iii) According to the information available from 13 States and 1 Union Territory, there were 39 Protective Homes and 30 district shelters run by the Government, and 6 Protective Homes and 1 district shelter run by voluntary agency.

Legislation not enough:

It will be admitted that in eradication of social vice, the penal measures alone are not enough. An active public opinion and awareness of the issues by the citizens, willingness to help official agencies in the task of apprehension and prosecution of offenders and the treatment and rehabilitation of the victims are a pre-requisite for the success of the programme. The Act has been found inadequate in several ways and vital amendments are called for.

On the other hand, prevention of the problem calls for widespread education of women and girls, better opportunities for gainful employment for women, raising the social status of women, parental guidance, sex-education for the adolescent and the youth, especially regarding the dangers of venereal diseases.

With this background, the statistical analysis of the implementation of the Suppression of Immoral Traffic in Women and Girls Act, 1956 is presented in this publication, in the hope that official and non-official agencies concerned with this problem will find them of some value.

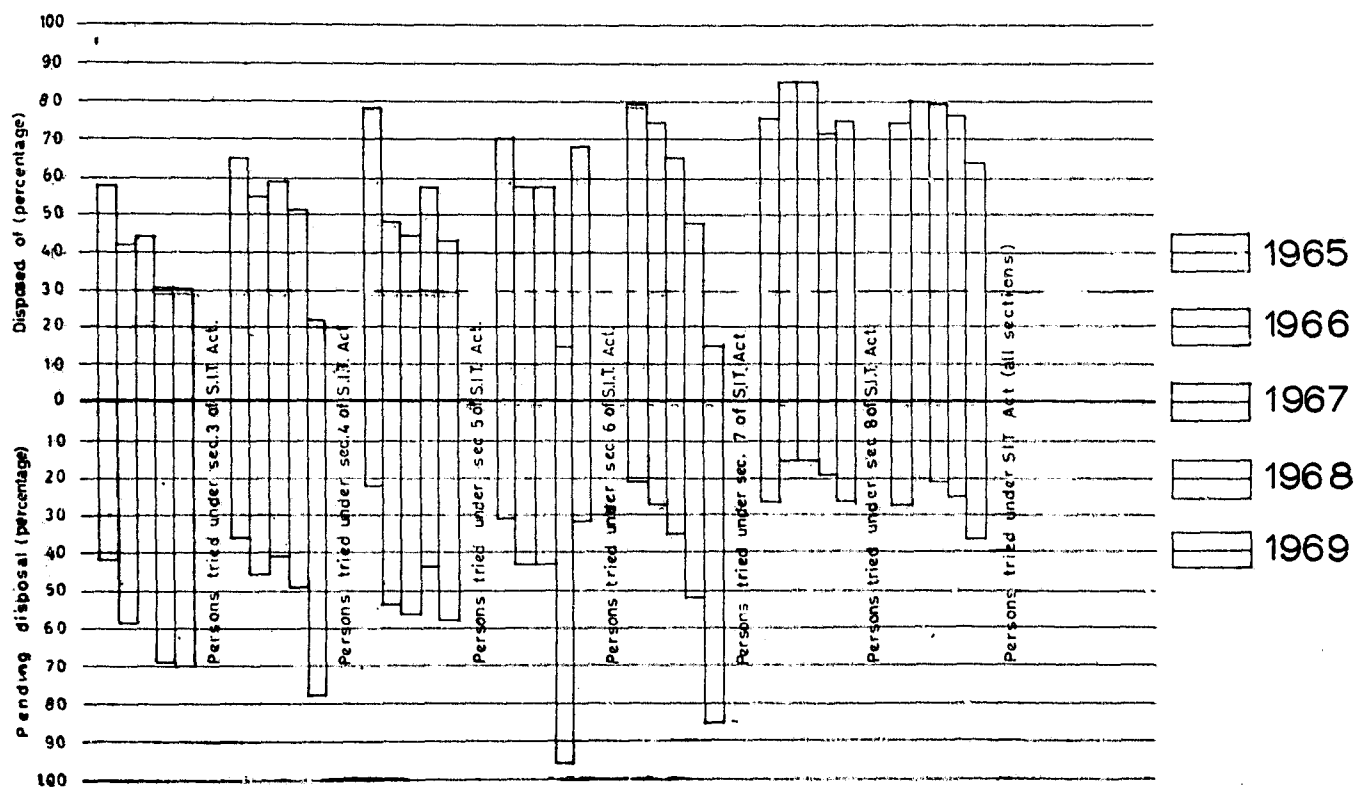

DISPOSAL OF CASES UNDER S.I.T. ACT (DURING 1965-1969)



Implementation of Suppression of Immoral Traffic in Women and Girls Act, 1956.

Statistics (1965—1969) at a glance

1. During 1969, 7573 persons were brought before the courts, in 9 States and 1 Union Territory, for trial under various sections of the S.I.T. Act whereas during 1965 the corresponding number was 6428, indicating an increase of about 17.8 percent.

2. Out of 7573 persons brought for trial during 1969, about 63 percent of them were tried whereas in 1965 out of 6428 persons about 73 percent of them were tried and their cases decided. This indicates a decline in the rate of prosecution by about 10 percent in 1969 compared to 1965.

3. About 58 percent (2749) of the persons, tried under the Act, were sentenced to pay fine only; 14 percent (587) were discharged or acquitted; 8 percent (494) were released under section 562 Cr. P.C. on admonition and probation of good conduct; 11 percent (505) were sentenced to imprisonment with fine and 4 percent (212) to imprisonment without fine, 3 percent (135) were ordered to be kept in protective homes; and 2 percent (96) were dealt with in other manners. This distribution was observed to be persistent throughout the period of five years under study.

4. Classification of the persons, brought before courts, according to the offences committed under the Act, indicated that about 78 percent (5841) of the persons were charged under section 8 of the Act for seducing or soliciting for purpose of prostitution, 7 percent (544) were charged under section 4 of the Act for procuring, inducing or taking woman or girl for prostitution; 6.5 percent (506) were charged under section 3 of the Act for keeping a brothel and allowing premises to be used as a brothel; 5 percent (410) were charged under section 7 of the Act for prostitution in or in the vicinity of public places; and the remaining 3.5 percent (258) were charged with offences under sections 5 and 6 of the Act. This distribution was observed to be maintained during all the five years of the period under study.

Staff:

5. Number of whole time special officers appointed under section 13(1) of the S.I.T. Act was 52 in 1969 whereas the corresponding strength of special officers in 1965 was 19 only. However, the number of part time special officers declined from 229 in 1965 to 151 in 1969.

Advisory Bodies:

6. Number of Advisory Bodies, formed under section 13 (3b) of the Act, declined from 109 in 1965 to 88 in 1969.

Preventive Action:

7. During 1965, 810 women were rescued from moral danger, in Mysore State, under section 17 of the Act and in the succeeding years no such action was taken in this State.

In general, sharp decline was observed in the number of such women rescued under section 17 of the Act during the period of 5 years.

8. Number of women who sought admission to protective homes voluntarily, under section 19 of the Act, slightly increased from 24 in 1965 to 30 in 1969.

9. Under section 18 of the Act, 18 proceedings were instituted, in 1965, for the closure of brothels and eviction of offenders from the premises whereas during 1969 only 9 such proceedings were reported. Only the State of Madhya Pradesh and Union Territory of Delhi reported to have taken such action during 1969.

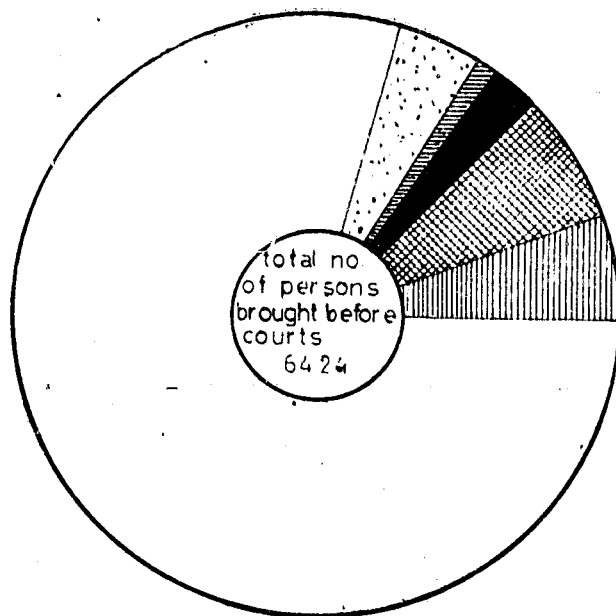

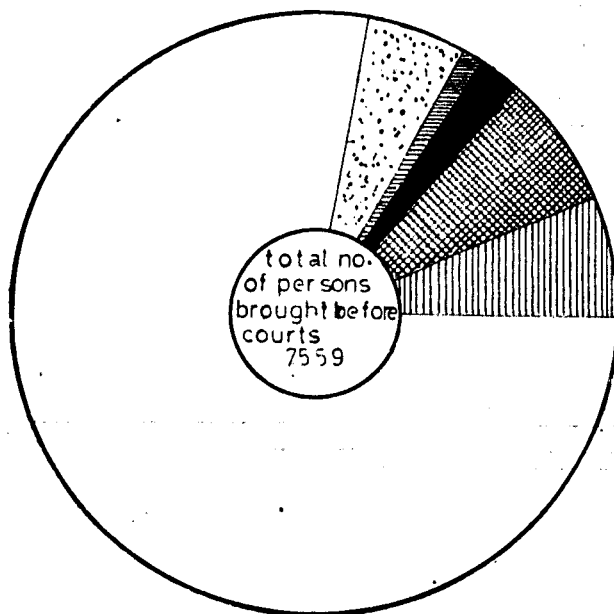

PERSONS BROUGHT BEFORE COURTS UNDER VARIOUS SECTIONS OF S.I.T. ACT



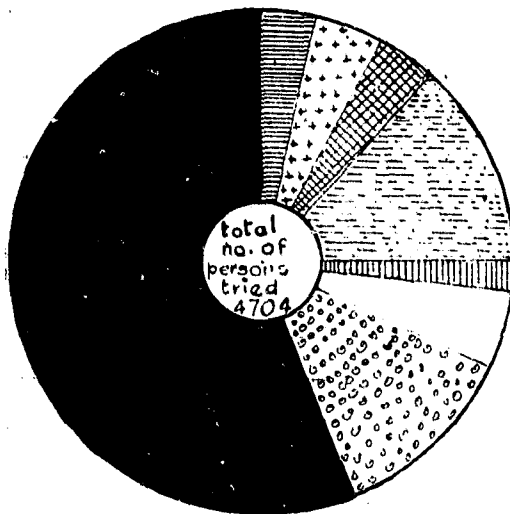

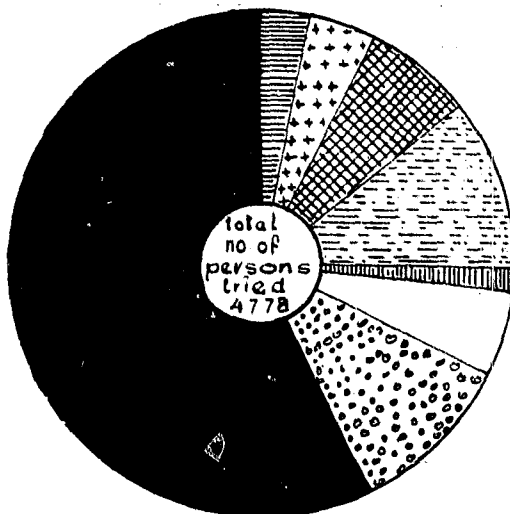
