ACQUISITIONS

Selected characteristics of juveniles who were first-released and re-released during the years 1973-1977 are reported in Tables A through D. Information regarding juveniles released to aftercare in calendar year 1977 is found in Tables 1 through 14. Information regarding juveniles directly discharged or discharged by court order from juvenile correctional institutions in calendar year 1977 is found in Appendices A (males) and B (females).

Note: Since the age of majority in the State of Wisconsin is 18, case termination becomes effective at that age, thus having the impact of reducing the average (mean) length of stay (months served).

The average (mean) length of stay for first-released juvenile males continued the downward trend resulting in a 1977 average length of stay of 7.8 months. There was an approximately 50 percent decrease from 1976 in the proportion of juvenile males with excellent vocational progress at the institutions. All other characteristics remained relatively constant over the five year period.

The average (mean) length of stay for first-released juvenile females continued the downward trend resulting in a 1977 average length of 4.7 months. There was a substantial increase from 1976 to 1977 in the percentage of first-released juvenile females with excellent institutional adjustment, but a significant decrease in the percentage of first-released juvenile females with excellent educational progress during the same period. All other characteristics remained relatively constant in 1977, as compared

with the previous four years.

The percentage of juvenile males re-released to Milwaukee County continued in a downward trend, resulting in a 1977 percentage of 16.2. There was a significant decrease from 1976 to 1977 in the percentage of juvenile males with excellent institutional adjustment. Also, the sharply reduced proportion with excellent vocational progress remained constant through 1975-1977.

The average length of stay for re-released juvenile females continued to decrease, resulting in a 1977 average length of stay of 4.7 months. In 1977 there were no re-released juvenile females with excellent institutional adjustment or excellent vocational progress. The total number of re-released juvenile females, however, was a five-year low of only 9 persons.

This 1977 bulletin introduces a change in data presentation in that much of the information is now broken down in Probation and Parole Regions. (See Table 3 for a listing of counties comprising each Region.)
