## INTRODUCTION

Arizona has 67 city and county jails ranging in age from one year to over 70 years, and in capacity from one inmate to 630 inmates, with a total statewide capacity of 3,999. On September 30, 1979, Arizona jails held 2,759 inmates, an increase of 10% over the same day in 1978.

This report contains the major findings of a jail survey conducted in September of 1979 by the Statistical Analysis Center of the Arizona State Justice Planning Agency (ASJPA). As defined for this study, a jail is an area of confinement intended for adults, which is under the control of a county sheriff or a city police chief. Such questions as the age and capacity of facilities, the number and type of inmates, and the number of jail employees were asked of each local jail in the state. Juvenile detention centers and jails located on military bases, Indian reservations, and national parks were not included in the jail survey. A similar survey of Arizona jails was conducted by the Statistical Analysis Center in September, 1977 and September, 1978. The results of these surveys are summarized in ARIZONA JAILS and UPDATE ON ARIZONA JAILS published by ASJPA in November, 1977 and 1978.

UPDATE ON ARIZONA JAILS-1979 has four sections. The first section is a summary of data on jail facilities. The second section summarizes data on inmate characteristics while data on jail employees are presented in the third section. The final section is a listing by county of data on jail facilities and inmates.


## JAIL FACILITIES


Each of the state's fourteen counties maintains at least one jail in its county seat, and nine counties also maintain substation jails in outlying communities. In addition, many cities and towns have jails, although the number of municipal jails has decreased in recent years.

## NUMBER OF JAILS

Arizona has 67\* city and county jails: 25 city jails, 14 county jails, 3 county jail annexes, and 25 substation jails. Three new facilities were opened during 1979—the Mohave County Sheriff's Office, the Greenlee Correctional Facility and the Nogales City Jail. The overall number of city and county jails has remained relatively stable since 1977.

\*This total does not include the maximum security detention ward at Maricopa County Hospital.





## AGE OF JAILS

Twenty-five of Arizona's 67 jails are less than 10 years old. In contrast, 6 jails have been in operation for 40 or more years. On the average, county jails and jail annexes are older than city jails and substation jails. The age of 18 years for city jails and 13 years for substation jails.

Perhaps because of their age, nine county jails and two jail annexes have been renovated in recent years. Nine other jails in the state have also been upgraded since their construction.

## CAPACITY

Arizona's jails have a combined capacity of 3,999 inmates, an increase of 6% from the 1978 survey. On the average, county jails and jail annexes are much larger than city jails and substation jails. County jails and annexes have an average capacity of 175 inmates while city jails and substation jails average 23

During the month of September 1979, the highest daily statewide jail population was 3,152 inmates, or 79% of capacity, while the lowest daily jail population was 2,464 inmates, or 62% of capacity. On September 30, 1979, the overall rate of occupancy in Arizona jails was 67%. County jails had the highest rate of occupancy (78%). The three county jail annexes had an occupancy rate of 70%, while city jails and substation jails had occupancy rates of 39% and 21%, respectively.

## INMATES

Local jails are the intake points of the entire criminal justice system. City and county jails are used both as detention centers for adults facing criminal charges and, along with state prisons, as correctional facilities for those serving sentences. Confinement in a local jail may range from a few hours prior to initial court appearance or transportation to another facility, up to one year if sentenced.

Jails in Arizona confined 2,759 inmates on September 30, 1979. Eighty-nine percent of the inmates (2,470) were held in county jails and jail annexes. City jails held 224 inmates or 8% of the total, and substation jails held 90 (3%) inmates. Due to different reporting practices, the Maricopa County Jail subsystem is listed separately for age breakdown.

Males predominated the jail population, accounting for almost 9 out of 10 irmates; however, there was a 17% increase in the number of females detained. Females accounted for 12% (296) of the jail population in 1978 and 13% (359) in 1979. Over one-half of the inmates were between the ages of 18 and 24 years. Whites made up 54% of the inmate population while Blacks and American Indians accounted for a total of twenty-two percent. Approximately one of every 20 inmates was a citizen of Mexico; sixty-nine percent were incarcerated in the four counties bordering Mexico.

## GEOGRAPHIC DISTRIBUTION

Maricopa County and Pima County which together account for 75% of the state population, held 72% of the jail inmates on September 30, 1979. Yuma County ranked first in the number of inmates per 1,000 population (1.9). Navajo County followed closely with 1.7 inmates per 1,000 population.

## LEGAL STATUS

Just under half of the inmates incarcerated on September 30, 1979 were either awaiting arraignment, trial or sentencing. Sentenced inmates comprised 51% of the inmate population, a 10% increase over the number of sentenced inmates in 1978. This figure includes persons waiting transfer to other facilities, holds and material witnesses.

CUSTODY

Roughly half of the inmates confined on the last day of September were held in maximum custody. A working definition of maximum custody is a type of confinement which requires constant supervision of inmates by jail staff. This type of custody is characterized by very tight security, limited movement, and absolute control.

Twenty-eight percent of the inmates were held in medium custody. Although still within a tight security environment, medium custody requires a lesser degree of supervision than maximum custody. Medium custody allows the inmate to move within the secured areas of the jail without constant or direct supervision.

The remaining 24% of the jail inmates were in minimum custody, the type of confinement usually given to "trusties." Minimum custody allows the inmate a margin of freedom to work with intermittent supervision both inside and outside the jail facility.

The custody level of 79 inmates within the Maricopa County Jail subsystem on September 30, 1979 was unknown.

## JAIL EMPLOYEES

Arizona jails employ 761 persons. Eighty-seven percent of these employees are jail officers, while the remainder are engaged in other functions such as administration, food service, and maintenance.

## STAFFING

Of the 761 jail employees, 13% work on a part-time basis. The majority of the part-time employees (78 out of 85) are reported by city police department, many of which utilize patrolmen, radio dispatchers, and clerical staff in the operation of their jails. With both full-time and part-time staff support, all of the county jails and jail annexes, 80% of the city jails, and 41% of the substation jails are attended 24 hours per day, 7 days per week.



On September 30, 1979, the ratio of inmates to Arizona jail employees, both full-time and part-time, was 3.6 to 1. Among the counties, the ratio varied widely. In one county the number of jail employees exceeded the number of inmates, while in another the ratio of inmates to employees was 5 to 1. It is important to note that these figures reflect the total number of jail employees. Thus, for many facilities, the ratio of inmates to employees on any one shift is considerably higher than indicated in Table 6.

This section contains a listing by county of data on each of the 67 jails in Arizona. Also included are data for each county on the characteristics of persons incarcerated in local jails on September 30, 1979.






