

To give a perspective to the state of system development, a table showing major statistics for each jurisdiction is given. These figures are taken from the reports produced under the mandate of the National Task Force on the Administration of Justice (NTF). INTRODUCTION

This inventory was prepared by David H. Mead for the National Work Group on Justice Information and Statistics (NWG). A draft was distributed at the annual meeting of The Association of Canadian Court Administrators in Banff, Alberta April 20-23, 1980. NWG supplied financial support and arranged help from the Federal Ministry of the Solicitor General in summarising the base line information. Further editing and formatting was done by NWG.

This inventory will provide a useful reference for locating court information systems presently in use or under development in Canada. For more details the reader can communicate directly with the contact persons given for each system included. NWG would welcome comments or updates to this information and there are sheets for this purpose on pages 102 and 103.

As a background to the structure and organization of the courts in each jurisdiction, considerable detail is given in the publication of the National Task Force on the Administration of Justice entitled "Court Services in Canada 1977-78". A very useful summary will be found in Chapter Six of Prof. G.L. Gall's work "The Canadian Legal System".
