

With Five-Year Trends for 1975-1979

A total of 3,434 persons (3,297 men and 137 women) were residents in state adult correctional facilities on December 31, 1979. This publication provides statistical information about them.

Tables 1-9 contain information about 3,208 males and 120 females who were residing in Wisconsin adult correctional institutions on December 31, 1979.

Adult males were housed in the Waupun Correctional Institution (WCI), Green Bay Correctional Institution (GCI), Dodge Correctional Institution (DCI), Fox Lake Correctional Institution (FCI), Kettle Moraine Correctional Institution (KCI), Oakhill Correctional Institution (OCI), and seven camps of the Wisconsin Correctional Camp System (WCCS). Adult females resided in the Taycheedah Correctional Institution (TCI).

Tables 10-18 present characteristics of the 89 men and 17 women who resided in the five Community Correctional Residential Centers supervised by the Bureau of Community Corrections: Men's Community Correctional Center (CCC), Abode, Baker House, St. John's, and Women's Community Center (WCC). Those facilities, intended for persons who will soon be reentering the community, are all located in Milwaukee.

Forty-eight men residing in adult correctional institutions and one male resident of a Community Correctional Residential Center were committed as Youthful Offenders prior to repeal of the Youthful Offender Act on July 1, 1978.

The birthplaces of residents in institutions and correctional centers are included in this report for the first time (Tables 7 and 16). Nearly half of the adult institution residents (44.7 percent) and correctional center residents (47.2 percent) were born in other states.

Also shown for the first time are the numbers and percentages of residents involved in assaultive, drug, and/or sex offenses (Tables 3 and 12). The largest proportion of adult institution residents (45.9 percent) was sentenced for assaultive offenses only, while 38.2 percent were sentenced for offenses that did not directly involve assaults, sex, or drugs. The percentages were similar for correctional center residents.

RESIDENTS IN ADULT INSTITUTIONS

The end-of-year adult male population declined to 3,208 from a five-year high of 3,212 in 1978. For the third successive year, the number of females declined. The year-end total of 120 women was 4.8 percent lower than the 126 women resident on December 31, 1978.

The proportion of male residents who had been institutionalized for less than a year dropped steadily, from 49.3 percent in 1975 to 39.1 percent at the end of 1979. Meanwhile, the percentage of men who stayed two years or more rose from 25.0 percent to 36.5 percent. Median length of time in institutions on current stay rose to 16.5 months from 16.1 months a year earlier and 12.3 months at year-end 1975.

Length of time in correctional institutions for adult female residents varies considerably from year to year. The proportion of women who had been in the institution less than two years rose from 74.6 percent at the end of 1978 to 83.3 percent on December 31, 1979. Average (median) length of time in the institution rose from 6.7 months in 1975 to 12.5 months in 1977, dropped to 10.3 months in 1978, and rose to 11.1 months in 1979.

The proportion of men who had entered the institutions as new admissions declined to 82.0 percent, while that of newly-admitted women rose slightly to 94.2 percent.

Robbery and burglary continued as the most prevalent offenses committed by men who were institutionalized as of December 31, 1979--25.6 percent had been sentenced for armed or unarmed robbery and 24.4 percent for burglary. Forgery and issuance of worthless checks continued to be the most prevalent offenses for women, but the percentage of women sentenced for those offenses dropped to 16.7 percent from 32.0 percent in 1975. The percentage of women who had been sentenced for theft rose sharply, from 8.7 percent to 12.5 percent.

The proportion of non-white residents rose slightly, from 40.8 percent to 42.4 percent for males and from 51.6 percent to 52.5 percent for females.

Median age of all residents edged up slightly--from 25.8 years to 26.0 years for males and from 26.4 years to 26.6 years for females. Since 1975, the median age of females has remained higher than that of males.

Median length of sentence for institutionalized men rose to a five-year high of 6.1 years after declining in each of the three previous years. Median length of sentence for women rose to 4.6 years after declining to 3.8 years at the end of 1978.

Milwaukee was the committing county for 48.3 percent of the men and 47.5 percent of the women who were incarcerated as of December 31, 1979. In previous years, over one-half to nearly two-thirds of the women had been Milwaukee County commitments.

For the fourth successive year, median time in the institution increased for men, rising from 16.1 months to 16.5 months. Median time in the institution for women also rose slightly, from 10.3 months to 11.1 months. More than one-third

of the men but only one-sixth of the women had been institutionalized for two years or more.

RESIDENTS IN COMMUNITY CORRECTIONAL RESIDENTIAL CENTERS

There were 89 men and 17 women resident in Community Correctional Residential Centers on December 31, 1979. Of these, 85.8 percent were from Milwaukee County and 60.4 percent were non-white.

Average (median) age of the individuals in residential centers was slightly higher than that of institution residents at 27.6 years for men and 27.3 years for women. Median length of sentence was slightly lower, at 5.4 years for men and 4.5 years for women. The men had been institutionalized for an average (median) of 23.8 months and the women for an average of 22.2 months.
