(a) Section 8 of the Inspector General Act of ed to read as follows:

PROVISIONS; DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE

(a) The provisions of section 1385 of title 18, Code, shall not apply to audits and investigad by, under the direction of, or at the request for General of the Department of Defense to purposes of this Act.

21 "(b) The Inspector General of the Department of De-22 fense shall conduct a further study of the operation of the 23 audit, investigative, and inspection components in the De-24 partment of Defense which engage in the prevention and de-25 tection of fraud, waste, and abuse, including a review of the

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1 findings of the task force on evaluation of audit, inspection, 2 and investigative components of the Department of Defense, 3 and shall make a report thereon to the Secretary of Defense 4 and to the Congress not later than September 30, 1983. 5 Such report shall include the views of the Inspector General 6 concerning the desirability of further statutory and adminis-7 trative changes in the organization and operations of such 8 components.".

(b) For administrative purposes, the Office of Inspector 9 10 General of the International Development Cooperation 11 Agency may be located in such bureau or component of that 12 Agency as the head of that Agency, with the agreement of 13 the Inspector General, shall prescribe by regulation.
