


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

A SURVEY OF SEXUAL OFFENCES WITHIN THE O.P.P. JURISDICTION
DURING THE SIX MONTH PERIOD OF APRIL 1978 TO SEPTEMBER 1978

INTRODUCTION

A major concern to the public is what seems to be a sharp rise in sex crimes. Banner headlines in newspapers relating to sexual offences, the establishment of Rape Crises Centres and the change in the courts attitude towards rape victims have further increased the public's fear and deep concern that our society is in an era of decadence. The fact that everyday parlance now includes such phrases as "new morality", "generation gap", "turned on" and "homosexual rights" does nothing to allay this fear.

In the public's interest it was deemed feasible to conduct a special survey of sex offences in O.P.P. jurisdiction during a six month period from April 1978 to September 1978 inclusive. Letters of enquiry were sent to the sixteen District Commanders and to all the Detachment Commanders requesting that the occurrences involving sex offences, excluding rape, be forwarded to the Director, Planning and Research Branch, G.H.Q., for the purpose of this survey. All occurrences regarding rape offences were requested from Field Audit Section, Field Administration Branch, GHQ.

Two hundred one reports of sex occurrences were received from the Detachments and 73 rape occurrence reports were received from Field Audit Section, Field Administration Branch. On the basis of these 274 reports the sex offences are broken down as follows:

Within the framework of this study there were 337 alleged victims and 307 accused persons.

Although during the first four months of 1978 there was a 46% increase in all sex offences in O.P.P. jurisdiction, the months April to September 1978 showed a figure of 366 sexual offences as compared to 365 in 1977. As these figures show no detail of the offences, the information put forth in this survey is based on the actual occurrence files received by the Planning and Research Branch, GHQ. from the sixteen Districts.

SUMMARY OF OBSERVATIONS

The majority of female victims of sexual offences are within the age group of 11 to 19 years. 65%

With the younger age group, 15 years and under, the accused person is nearly always related or known to the victim.

With the older age group, 16 years and over, there is a tendency to become involved with strangers.

With the younger age group, 15 years and under, the victims are mostly assaulted in a home environmental situation.

With the older age group, 16 years and over, the victims tend to be involved with hitch-hiking accepting rides with strangers, abuse of alcohol and/or drugs, especially with run-aways and on social occasions.

In the majority of cases involving the younger age group, 10 years and under, the parents of the victims do not press charges for fear of traumatizing the children further.

The age group of 20 years and over account for only 19% of the reported sex offences.

With the exception of 29% of the rape offences, or the rape offences that were unprovoked, the victims showed a great lack of discretion. Promiscuity was a predominant factor.

Persons accused of indecent acts are indiscriminate in their actions. They are exhibitionists that crave shock value. It is a spur of the moment occurrence that involves random victims and in every case the offence was unprovoked and varied, such as lewd gestures, mooning, swimming in the nude and exposing one's privates.

In most of the offences of indecent assault on a male, the victims were befriended by the accused persons. Drugs and alcohol were encouraged and made readily available to them.

In all cases of incest, the court ordered a psychiatric assessment of the accused before sentence was passed.

There were no females accused in the six month survey period.

There were no sex-murder occurrences in the six month survey period.

Drugs and/or alcohol are involved to some degree but are not a major factor.

Low I.Q. or a degree of retardation is not a factor.

Disposition by charge 47%, Otherwise 34%, Outstanding 19%

The analysis was made from police reports, so no evaluation could be made as to prevalent economic or environmental factors.

THE OFFENCE OF INDECENT ASSAULT ON A FEMALE

There were 95 occurrences received relating to this sexual offence, making up 34% of all the reported occurrences. These reports showed 113 alleged victims and 99 accused (of which all were male). A selection of elementary data is as follows:

In 11% of the Indecent Assault Against Female Occurrences, both the victim and the accused were under the influence of alcohol or drugs.

THE OFFENCE OF RAPE

There were 72 occurrences received relating to rape offences making up 26% of all the reported occurrences. These reports showed 75 alleged victims and 90 accused.

The following chart indicates the circumstances of the occurrence. With the exception of 29% of the rape offences or the rape offences that were unprovoked, the victims have shown a great lack of discretion. For example they were hitch-hiking, accepting rides from strangers. Over consumption of alcohol often combined with drugs and promiscuity are predominant factors.

INDECENT ACT

There were 37 occurrences received relating to indecent acts or indecent exposure, making up 13% of all the reported occurrences. These reports showed 54 alleged victims (44 females and 10 males) and 42 offenders.

Age Distribution of Victim And Accused

The age group of victim is not a factor. It is obvious that the offenders are indiscriminate in their actions. They are exhibitionists that crave shock value. It is a spur of the moment occurrence that involves random victims and in every case the offence was unprovoked and varied such as lewd gestures, mooning, swimming in the nude and exposing one's privates.

CONTRIBUTING TO JUVENILE DELINQUENCY

There were 11 occurrences received relating to this offence making up 5% of all the reported occurrences. These reports showed 12 alleged victims (of which 9 were female) and 15 accused.

Of the 12 victims 7 were less than 14 years old, 5 were 14 years old. Eight of the accused persons were between the ages of 13 and 18. The remaining 7 accused were 29 years of age or over.

In all cases the accused was known to the alleged victim. A lack of parental authority was obvious from the reports submitted, as the majority of the girls involved (seven out of nine) were less than circumspect in their behaviour.
