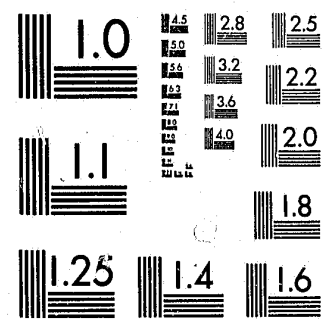

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INTRODUCTION

THIS REPORT DESCRIBES THE BACKGROUND, CRIMINAL HISTORY AND COMMITMENT INFORMATION OF THE POPULATION OF THE MASSACHUSETTS CORRECTIONAL INSTITUTIONS (MCIS) AT THE BEGINNING OF 1976. THE TABLES WERE DERIVED FROM THE COMPUTERIZED DATA BASE DEVELOPED BY THE CORRECTION AND PAROLE MANAGEMENT INFORMATION SYSTEM (CAPMIS) AND PRODUCED BY THE RESEARCH UNIT OF THE DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTION ON THE MASSACHUSETTS STATE COLLEGE COMPUTER NETWORK TIMESHARING COMPUTER SYSTEM.

THESE TABLES ARE INTENDED TO GIVE A BROAD OVERVIEW OF THE ADULT CORRECTIONAL INSTITUTION POPULATION IN MASSACHUSETTS. THE REPORT IS INTENDED AS A BASIC REFERENCE DOCUMENT TO ANSWER QUESTIONS REGARDING SPECIFIC CHARACTERISTICS OF THE RESIDENT POPULATIONS OF EACH OF THE CORRECTIONAL FACILITIES UNDER THE AUTHORITY OF THE MASSACHUSETTS DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTION. IN ADDITION IT IS HOPED THAT THE INFORMATION CONTAINED HEREIN WILL PROMPT REQUESTS OF A MORE SPECIFIC NATURE FROM DEPARTMENTAL PERSONNEL.

THE FOLLOWING NOTES OF CLARIFICATION SHOULD BE HELPFUL TO THE READER:

1. A LINE AT THE BOTTOM OF EACH TABLE STATES THE NUMBER OF MISSING OBSERVATIONS FOR THE PARTICULAR TABLE. THIS IS THE NUMBER OF PERSONS FOR WHOM DATA IS UNAVAILABLE FOR THE VARIABLES IN THE TABLE. THE PERCENTAGES IN THE TABLE WERE CALCULATED ON THE BASIS OF THE KNOWN TOTAL—THE GRAND TOTAL (2363) LESS THE NUMBER OF MISSING OBSERVATIONS.
2. THE CATEGORY BOSTON STATE INCLUDES SOME PERSONS WHO WERE NOT PHYSICALLY AT BOSTON STATE PRE-RELEASE CENTER BUT WHO WERE AT OTHER RESIDENTIAL PROGRAMS (MAINLY DRUG TREATMENT PROGRAMS) ELSEWHERE. THIS ACCOUNTS FOR THE FACT THAT THE TOTAL NUMBER LISTED FOR THIS FACILITY EXCEEDS THE CAPACITY OF THE INSTITUTION.
3. THE CATEGORY BRIDGEWATER INCLUDES PERSONS WHO WERE TRANSFERRED INTO MCI-BRIDGEWATER WHO WERE SERVING PENAL SENTENCES ON JANUARY 1, 1976. THIS GROUP INCLUDES BOTH STATE CORRECTIONAL COMMITMENTS AND HOUSE OF CORRECTION (COUNTY) COMMITMENTS.
