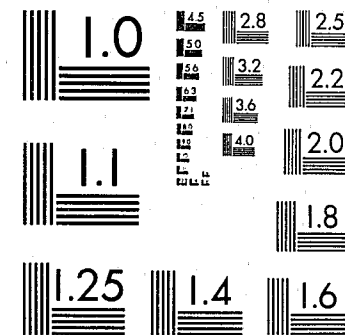

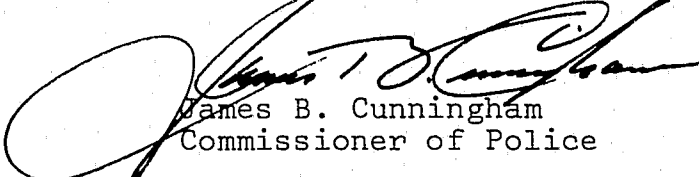
During the year 1980, there were 29,087 Index Crimes reported to the Department as compared to 26,975 Index Crimes reported during the year 1979. Although this reflects an increase of 7.8% in Index Crime, Violent Index Crime showed a decrease of -.01% and crimes against property showed an increase of 9.2%. In fact, most of the increase was due to an increase of 14% in the crime of Larceny alone.

Also, during 1980, our City had 33 traffic deaths compared to 32 the previous year. Total motor vehicle accidents during 1980 showed a decrease of 783 or -6.4% compared to the previous year. We are confident that we will again lead the nation in traffic safety in the 350,000 - 500,000 population group for the year 1980.

Relations between the Police Department and the Community have improved in the past year and this can be attributed in large part to the members of this Department who have so vividly demonstrated such exemplary conduct in carrying out their responsibilities, often under most difficult circumstances; and to the continuance of the Precinct Liaison Program.

We feel that our Department has had a very successful year and has achieved most of the goals that it had set out to. Without the unselfish dedication of the men and women of this Department and the outstanding cooperation of you and your staff, this would not have been possible. We shall continue in our efforts to make the quality of life in our city "second to none".

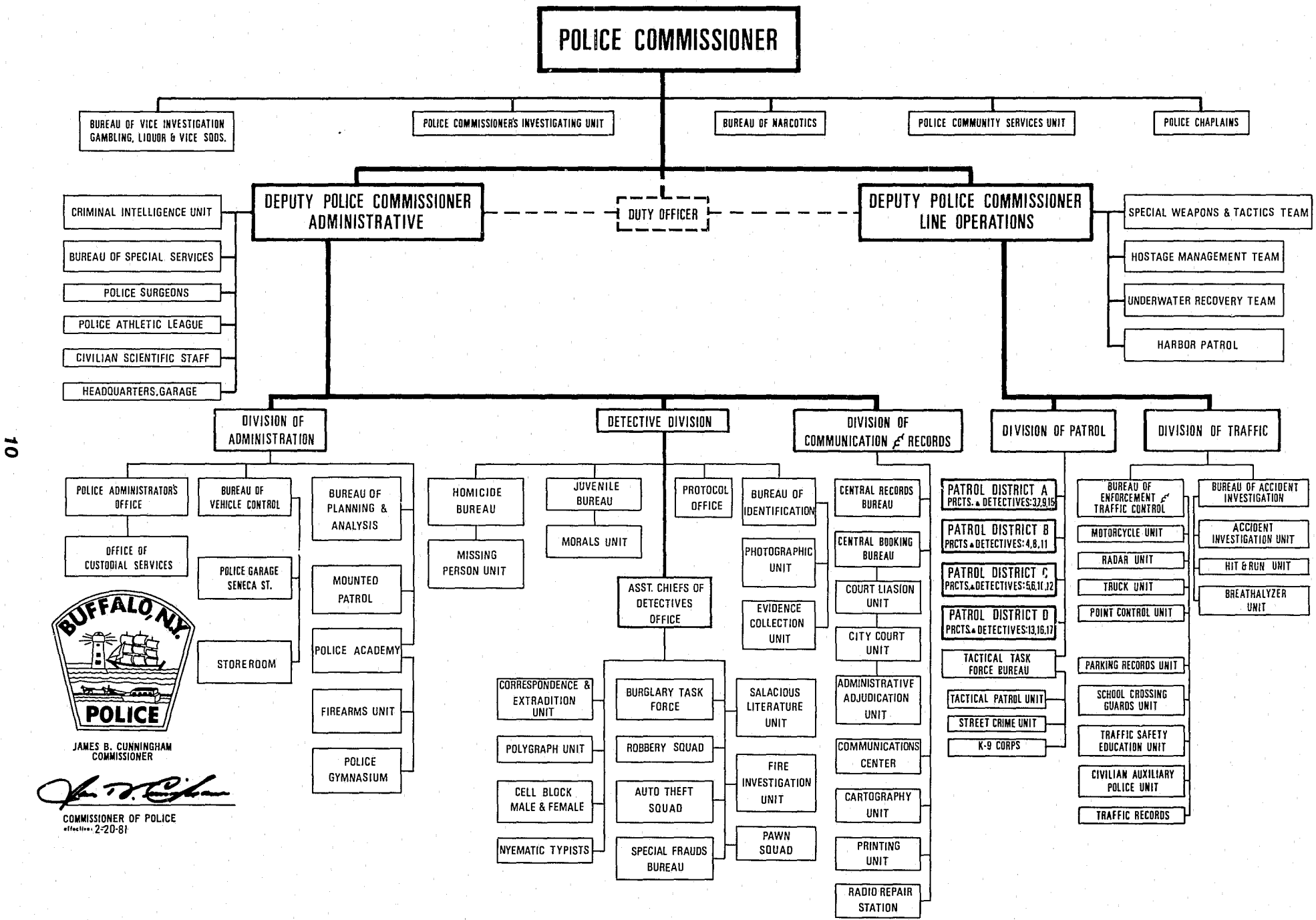

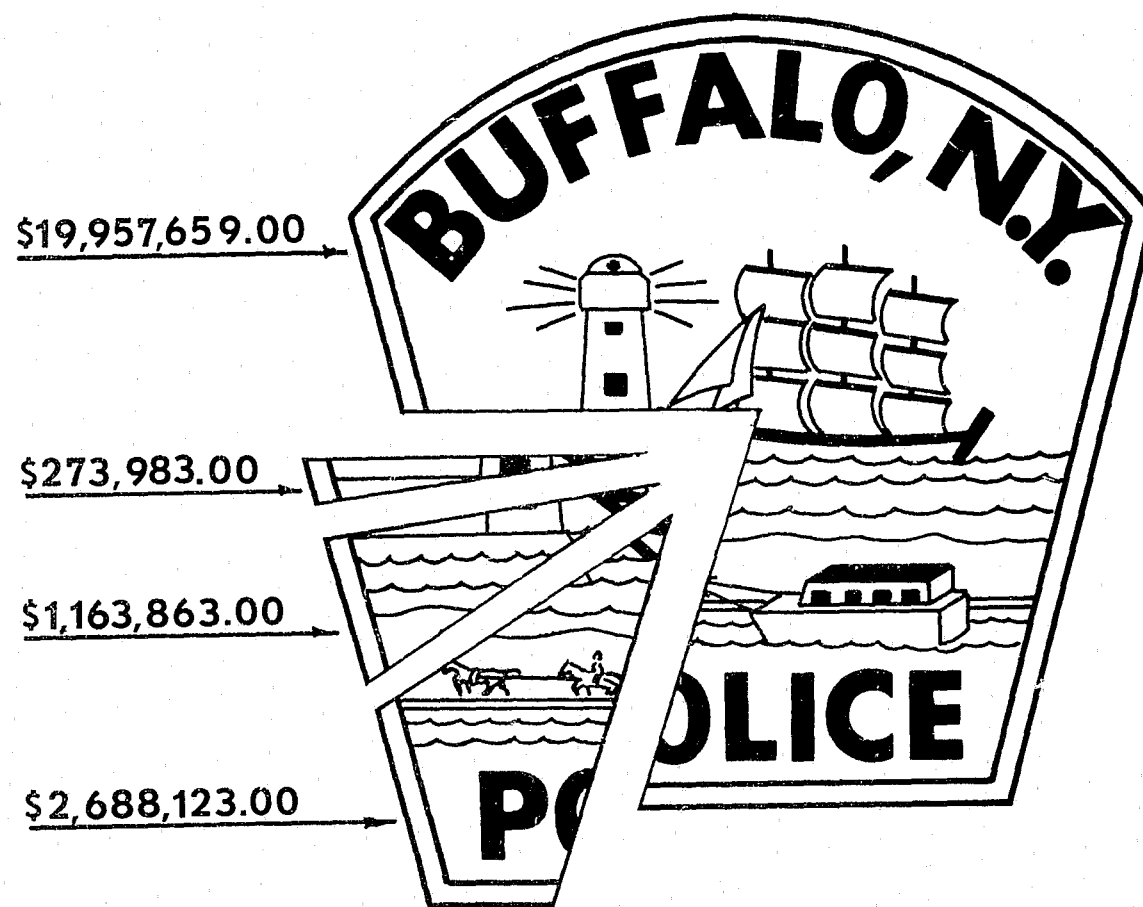
