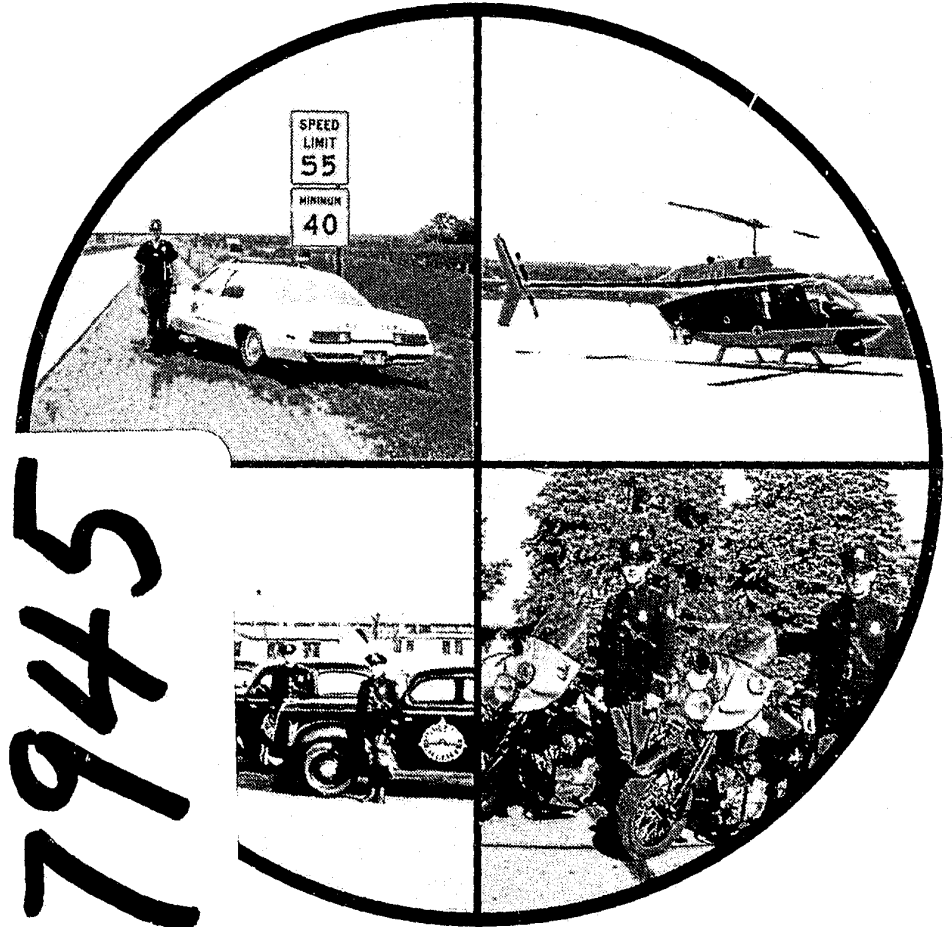


I am pleased to present to you the Annual Report of the Nebraska State Patrol for 1977.

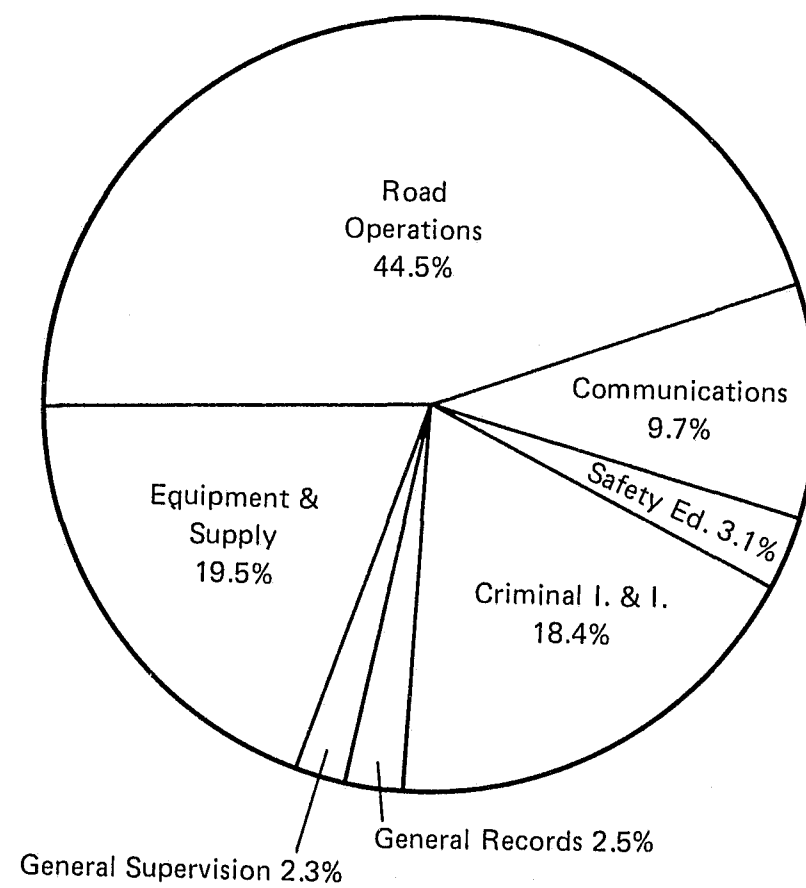

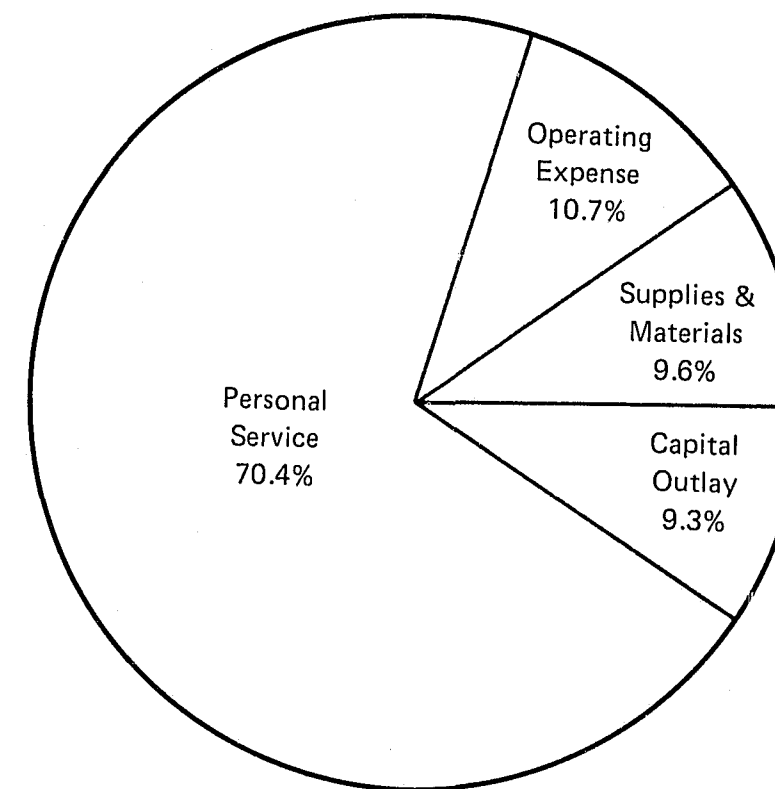
