INTRODUCTION

THE PURPOSE OF THIS DOCUMENT IS TO PROVIDE OBJECTIVE INFORMATION FOR USE IN OFFENDER RISK ASSESSMENT ACTIVITIES WITHIN THE FIFTH JUDICIAL DISTRICT DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONAL SERVICES OF THE STATE OF IOWA. OBJECTIVE EXPERIENCE DATA FOR THE IOWA SYSTEM IS SYNTHESIZED IN SUCH A AGAINST SPECIFIED TYPES OF OFFENDERS HANDLED BY THE DEPARTMENT. WHILE THE EXPERIENCE DATA PRESENTED HERE SUMMARIZES PAST EXPERIENCES IN THE STATEWIDE PROBATION/PAROLE SYSTEM (DURING IN INDIVIDUAL JURISDICTIONS AND RATINGS ARE BELIEVED TO BE RELIABLE ENOUGH TO BE APPLIED OF OFFENDER RISK ARE MADE.

BASED ON THE MATERIALS PRESENTED HERE, BOTH GENERAL POLICY DECISIONS AND SPECIFIC CASE-BY-CASE DECISIONS CONCERNING OFFENDER PLACEMENT MAY BE MADE. ENOUGH INFORMATION IS PRESENTED TO ALLOW AN UNDERSTANDING OF THE ROLE OF INDIVIDUAL "RISK FACTORS," AND OF THE WAY THESE FACTORS COMBINE TO ESTABLISH THE FINAL RISK CATEGORIES AND RATINGS. TO FACILITATE THE OFFENDER SCREENING PROCESS, RISK ASSESSMENT CATEGORIES ARE GROUPED INTO RISK LEVELS RANGING FROM "VERY-LOW RISK" TO "ULTRA-HIGH

TO ALLOW TWO DIFFERENT PERSPECTIVES ON "THE DIMENSION OF RISK," DUAL RISK ASSESSMENT SYSTEMS ARE PROVIDED, ONE BASED ON FIVE FACTORS AND THE OTHER ON JUST TWO. IN THE ACTUAL SCREENING PROCESS, THE 2-FACTOR SYSTEM SHOULD BE USED ONLY AS A SUPPLEMENT TO - OR CHECK ON - THE 5-FACTOR RATINGS. WHERE THEY DISAGREE, THE 5-FACTOR SYSTEM IS JUDGED TO BE THE MORE ACCURATE.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

THE MATERIAL PROVIDED IN THIS DOCUMENT CONSTITUTES A FORM OF INFORMATION FEEDBACK TO CRIMINAL JUSTICE PRACTICIONERS IN IOWA. SPECIFICALLY, IT TAKES THE FORM OF TWO CLASSIFICATION/RATING SYSTEMS THAT EXPLAIN A GOOD DEAL OF THE VARIATION IN OBSERVED RECIDIVISM RATES AMONG CORRECTIONS CLIENTS IN THE STATE. THESE SYSTEMS WERE DEVELOPED FROM COMPUTER-ASSISTED ANALYSES OF OFFENDER CHARACTERISTICS AND CASE OUTCOME DATA FOR 6337 INDIVIDUALS RELEASED BY DISCHARGE, REVOCATION, OR AND PAROLEES (MISDEMEANANTS AND PAROLE CASELOADS IN IOWA DURING THE THREE-YEAR PERIOD 1974-1976. BOTH PROBATIONERS DECISIONS. BASED ON THE INCLUSIVE NATURE OF THE SAMPLE AND THE SCREENING EFFECTS OF SENTENCING AND PAROLE RELEASE CLASSIFICATIONS ARE JUDGED TO REFLECT TRUE RELATIVE CONTINGENCIES FOR FUTURE CRIMINAL BEHAVIOR AMONG PERSONS CHARGED WITH OR CONVICTED OF CRIMINAL OFFENSES IN THIS STATE.

TO DEVELOP USEFUL CLASSIFICATIONS, INFORMATION ON NEW CRIMINAL CHARGES AGAINST MEMBERS OF THE 6337-MEMBER STUDY POP-ULATION WAS BROKEN OUT ACCORDING TO A WIDE RANGE OF CHARACTERISTICS OF THE OFFENDERS CONCERNED. AS WITH PREVIOUS STUDIES OF A SIMILAR NATURE, SEVERAL KEY VARIABLES WERE IDENTIFIED THAT EXHIBIT CONSISTENTLY STRONG ASSOCIATIONS WITH THE PRO-BABILITY AND POTENTIAL SERIOUSNESS OF RECIDIVISM. IN FACT, RECENT ANALYSES OF PROBATION/PAROLE OUTCOME DATA FOR THE YEARS AND UNDERSTANDING, THE NUMBER OF EXPLANATORY VARIABLES REFLECTED IN THE FINAL CLASSIFICATIONS IS KEPT TO A MINIMUM.

THE METHOD USED TO INTERRELATE CHOSEN PREDICTORS (VARIABLES) INVOLVES DIRECTLY COMBINING CATEGORIES FROM INDIVIDUAL PREDICTORS INTO MULTI-FACTOR "CONFIGURATIONS." FOR EXAMPLE, THE CATEGORY "AGE 18/PRIOR ARREST/NO PRIOR INCARCERATION" IS OF PRIOR INCARCERATIONS. FINAL CLASSIFICATIONS, THEN, CONSIST OF THE FULL-RANGE OF CONFIGURATIONS COVERING CASES IN THE STUDY POPULATION.

DURING THE COURSE OF THE STUDY, EVERY EFFORT WAS MADE TO DEVELOP CLASSIFICATIONS THAT WERE BOTH INTUITIVE AND MEANINGFUL, AS WELL AS POWERFUL. THUS, CARE WAS TAKEN TO GROUP DATA IN "LOGICAL" COMBINATIONS THAT COULD BE SUPPORTED BY AN UNDERLYING THEORY OF THE PATTERNS OF BEHAVIOR INVOLVED. THIS FACT SHOULD MAKE THE FINAL CLASSIFICATIONS EMINENTLY APPLICABLE, IN THAT RATIONAL ARGUMENTS CAN BE OFFERED IN SUPPORT OF SPECIFIED DISTINCTIONS. THE FACT THAT THE RATINGS CAN BE TRACED INVOLVING ADDITIVE "POINTS" ASSIGNED TO SPECIFIED RISK FACTORS, DISGUISE THE UNDERLYING CONFIGURATIONS AND DISALLOW THIS TYPE OF SUPPORTIVE ARGUMENT.

AS STATED IN THE INTRODUCTION, THIS DOCUMENT DETAILS TWO INDEPENDENT RISK ASSESSMENT SYSTEMS, ONE BASED ON FIVE FACTORS AND THE OTHER ON JUST TWO. THE 5-FACTOR SYSTEM, WHICH IS DESCRIBED FIRST, IS BASED ON FIVE KEY VARIABLES THAT SHOW CONSISTENTLY STRONG RELATIONSHIPS WITH OBSERVED RECIDIVISM RATES IN IOWA, NAMELY CURRENT AGE (AT RELEASE), AGE AT FIRST ARREST,

NUMBER OF PRIOR ARRESTS, NUMBER OF PRIOR INCARCERATIONS, AND THE TYPE OF CONVICTING (OR CHARGED) OFFENSE. THE 2-FACTOR SYSTEM ASPECTS OF THE OFFENDER'S PRIOR ARREST, PROBATION, AND INCARCERATION RECORDS. FOR PURPOSES OF RISK ASSESSMENT, THE 5-FACTOR SYSTEM IS JUDGED TO BE THE MORE ACCURATE (AND POWERFUL) AND THUS IS RECOMMENDED FOR DIRECT SCREENING PURPOSES.

THE 2-FACTOR SYSTEM IS OFFERED FOR TWO PURPOSES. FIRST, IT CAN PROVIDE ANOTHER PERSPECTIVE ON "WHY" AN OFFENDER MAY BE RATED AS A GOOD OR POOR RISK, AND THUS SERVES TO GIVE FURTHER BASIS FOR ARGUING A GIVEN ASSESSMENT. SECOND, THE SYSTEM

GIVES SUPPORT AND CLARITY TO SOME OF THE POTENTIALLY NON-INTUITIVE OR POSSIBLY UNCONVINCING RATINGS OF THE 5-FACTOR SYSTEM. FOR EXAMPLE, THE 5-FACTOR SYSTEM MIGHT RATE A PREVIOUSLY IMPRISONED OFFENDER AS A BETTER RISK THAN A NEVER-IMPRISONED COUNTERPART. THE 2-FACTOR SYSTEM WOULD CLARIFY THIS APPARENT DISCREPANCY BY DIRECTLY SPECIFYING RECIDIVISM RESULTS AND COMPARATIVE RISK RATINGS BASED ON AGE AND PRIOR PRISON (AND NON-PRISON) RECORD.

IN LAYING OUT THE PARTICULARS OF BOTH SYSTEMS, RECIDIVISM RESULTS ARE GIVEN FOR INDIVIDUAL PREDICTORS AND FOR THE FINAL CLASSIFICATIONS. IN ADDITION, FOR THE 5-FACTOR SYSTEM, SELECTED 2-FACTOR AND 3-FACTOR RESULTS ARE PRESENTED AS A LEAD-IN TO THE 5-FACTOR MATERIAL. AGAIN, THE AIM IS TO ALLOW AS MUCH UNDERSTANDING OF THE FINAL DISTINCTIONS AS POSSIBLE.

TO STUDY THE RECIDIVISM PHENOMENON, "NEW CHARGE RATES" WERE DEFINED THAT WOULD REFLECT 1) ALL CHARGES (UP TO 3 PER OFFENDER) FILED AGAINST STUDY SUBJECTS DURING THE PROBATION/PAROLE SUPERVISION PERIOD, 2) THE SERIOUSNESS OF NEW CHARGES, AND 3) THE FREQUENCY OF NEW CHARGES IN TIME (PER UNIT OF SUPERVISION TIME). A GENERAL DEFINITION OF NEW CHARGE RATE WAS ADOPTED AS FOLLOWS: NEW CHARGES PER 100 MAN-YEARS OF SUPERVISION. THUS, IF A 10-MEMBER GROUP RECORDED 20 NEW CHARGES DURING A TOTAL SUPERVISION PERIOD OF 110 MONTHS, THEN THE NEW CHARGE RATE FOR THE GROUP WOULD BE 20 CHARGES PER 9.2 MAN-YEARS OR 218 CHARGES PER 100 MAN-YEARS OF SUPERVISION.

TO ALLOW FOR THE SERIOUSNESS OF NEW CHARGES, SEPARATE NEW CHARGE RATES WERE COMPUTED FOR SEVEN OFFENSE CATEGORIES, INCLUDING 1) VIOLENT-PART I, 2) PROPERTY-PART I, 3) PERSONS/WEAPONS-PART II, 4) PROPERTY-PART II, 5) DRUG-RELATED, 6) ALCOHOL-RELATED, AND 7) MISCELLANEOUS-PART II. PART I VIOLENT CRIMES INCLUDE MURDER/MANSLAUGHTER, FORCIBLE RAPE, ROBBERY, AND AGGRAVATED ASSAULT, WHILE PART I PROPERTY CRIMES INCLUDE BURGLARY (OR BREAKING AND ENTERING), LARCENY-THEFT, AND MOTOR VEHICLE THEFT. EXCEPT FOR NEGLIGENT MANSLAUGHTER, PART I CRIMES ARE PRECISELY THOSE REPORTED CRIMES USED TO COMPUTE CRIMES RATES. PART II PERSONS/WEAPONS CRIMES INCLUDE SIMPLE ASSAULTS, SEX OFFENSES EXCLUDING FORCIBLE RAPE, FAMILY OFFENSES, AND WEAPONS CRIMES. PART II PROPERTY CRIMES INCLUDE BAD CHECKS/FRAUD, FORGERY, EMBEZZLEMENT, STOLEN PROPERTY, VANDALISM, AND ARSON. DRUG-RELATED CRIMES INCLUDE POSSESSION AND DELIVERY OFFENSES, AND ALCOHOL-RELATED CRIMES DRUNKENNESS, DRIVING UNDER THE INFLUENCE, AND OTHER STRICTLY ALCOHOL-RELATED CRIMES. MISCELLANEOUS PART II CRIMES INCLUDE MORALS CRIMES, CRIMES AGAINST PUBLIC JUSTICE AND AUTHORITY (ESCAPE, ETC.), CONSPIRACY, MOTOR VEHICLE OFFENSES (EXCEPT DRUNKEN DRIVING AND MOTOR VEHICLE THEFT), AND OTHERS.

EACH OF THE TABLES TO FOLLOW GIVES 13 ITEMS OF INFORMATION FOR ANY INDIVIDUAL OFFENDER CATEGORY, INCLUDING TOTAL CASES, AVERAGE (MEAN) MONTHS OF SUPERVISION (ALL TYPES OF RELEASE), INDIVIDUAL NEW CHARGE RATES FOR THE SEVEN OFFENSE CATEGORIES SPECIFIED ABOVE, RATES FOR "ALL PART I" AND "ALL PART II" CATEGORIES, AN "ALL CHARGES" RATE, AND A "WEIGHTED RATE."

THE WEIGHTED RATE APPEARING IN THE TABLES REFLECTS A SERIOUSNESS WEIGHTING SCHEME FOR THE SEVEN NEW CHARGE CATEGORIES AS FOLLOWS: VIOLENT-PART I = 4, PROPERTY-PART I, PERSONS/WEAPONS-PART II = 3, PROPERTY-PART II = 2, AND DRUG-RELATED, ALCOHOL-RELATED, MISCELLANEOUS-PART II = 1. TO OBTAIN A WEIGHTED RATE, THE WEIGHTED SUM OF THE SEVEN INDIVIDUAL NEW CHARGE RATES IS COMPUTED AND THEN THE RESULT IS DIVIDED BY THE AVERAGE WEIGHT OF ALL NEW CHARGES IN THE STUDY POPULATION (1.9179). FOR THE TOTAL POPULATION, THIS SCHEME YIELDS THE SAME RESULT AS THE ALL CHARGES RATE (35.2).

FOR ANY INDIVIDUAL CATEGORY, THE WEIGHTED RATE WILL BE HIGHER THAN THE ALL CHARGES RATE IF NEW CHARGES IN THE CATEGORY ARE TYPICALLY MORE SERIOUS THAN NORMAL, AND WILL BE LOWER IF THE REVERSE IS TRUE. GENERALLY, IF A GROUP HAS A RELATIVELY HIGHER RATE OF NEW PART I CHARGES (ESPECIALLY VIOLENT) AS COMPARED TO PART II CHARGES, THE WEIGHTED RATE WILL BE THE HIGHER OF THE TWO. CONVERSELY, IF PART II CRIMES (SUCH AS ALCOHOL-RELATED) ARE ATYPICALLY HIGH, THE ALL CHARGES RATE WILL BE THE HIGHER OF THE TWO. IN MOST CASES, THE WEIGHTED RATE IS THE BEST INDICATOR OF BOTH THE FREQUENCY AND THE SERIOUSNESS OF NEW CHARGES AGAINST A GROUP OF OFFENDERS. ACCORDINGLY, THE WEIGHTED RATE IS USED TO ESTABLISH RISK LEVELS FOR THE TWO SYSTEMS.

5-FACTOR SCORING SYSTEM

5-FACTOR SCORING SYSTEM DESCRIPTIVE OVERVIEW

AS DESCRIBED ABOVE THE 5-FACTOR SCORING SYSTEM IS BASED ON FIVE KEY PREDICTORS OF RECIDIVISM AS FOLLOWS:

CURRENT AGE
AGE AT FIRST ARREST
NUMBER OF PRIOR ARRESTS
NUMBER OF PRIOR INCARCERATIONS
TYPE OF CONVICTING (OR CHARGED) OFFENSE

ON THE FOLLOWING PAGE, THESE FIVE ITEMS ARE CAREFULLY DEFINED TO ENSURE CONSISTENCY IN SCORING.

ON PAGES 8-12, NEW CHARGE RATES FOR CATEGORIES OF EACH OF THE FIVE VARIABLES ARE ITEMIZED. A BRIEF DISCUSSION OF THIS

ON PAGE 14, NEW CHARGE RATES FOR CONFIGURATIONS OF CURRENT AGE AND AGE AT FIRST ARREST ARE GIVEN, WITH A DISCUSSION ON THE PREVIOUS PAGE.

ON PAGES 17-21, NEW CHARGE RATES FOR CONFIGURATIONS OF CURRENT AGE, AGE AT FIRST ARREST, AND NUMBER OF PRIOR ARRESTS, ARE OFFERED, WITH A DISCUSSION ON PAGE 15-16.

ON PAGES 24-29, NEW CHARGE RATES FOR THE FINAL 5-FACTOR CONFIGURATIONS ARE GIVEN, WITH CATEGORIES GROUPED ACCORDING TO CURRENT AGE. A DISCUSSION APPEARS ON PAGES 22-23.

ON PAGES, 32-36, THE 5-FACTOR CATEGORIES (AND ASSOCIATED RATES) ARE LISTED IN DESCENDING ORDER OF THE WEIGHTED NEW CHARGE RATE (LAST COLUMN), WITH A DISCUSSION ON PAGES 30-31.

ON PAGE 37, THE 5-FACTOR CONFIGURATIONS ARE GROUPED, ACCORDING TO THE MAGNITUDE OF THE WEIGHTED RATE, INTO 8 OFFENDER RISK LEVELS (OR RATINGS). RATINGS RANGE FROM VERY-LOW RISK TO ULTRA-HIGH RISK. FOR EACH RATING, THE CORRESPONDING RANGE OF DATA, THE OVERALL TOTAL FOR THE 5-FACTOR SYSTEM IS REDUCED FROM 6337 TO 5662.

ON PAGE 38, NEW CHARGE RATES FOR THE 8-LEVEL RATING SYSTEM ARE OFFERED.

ON PAGE 40, A SAMPLE CODING FORM IS INCLUDED, WITH CODING INSTRUCTIONS ON THE PREVIOUS PAGE.

FINALLY, ON PAGES 41-43, THE OVERALL 5-FACTOR SCORING SYSTEM IS DISCUSSED, AND INTERPRETIVE COMMENTS ARE OFFERED.

ITEM DEFINITIONS 5-FACTOR SCORING SYSTEM

CURRENT AGE:

ALL REFERENCES TO "CURRENT AGE" ARE TO THE AGE OF THE OFFENDER AT THE TIME RELEASE WOULD BE CONSIDERED. THE FACT THAT STATISTICS PRESENTED BELOW REFER TO "AGE AT PROBATION/PAROLE RELEASE" REFLECTS NO MORE THAN THE FACT THAT OBSERVED NEW CHARGE RATES CONCERN PAST PRO-BATION AND PAROLE EXPERIENCE. THE FINAL RATINGS, HOWEVER, CAN BE APPLIED TO OFFENDERS CON-SIDERED FOR RELEASE AT ANY STAGE OF THE CRIMINAL JUSTICE PROCESS.

AGE AT FIRST ARREST:

THIS ITEM REFERS TO THE EARLIEST AGE AT WHICH THE OFFENDER WAS TAKEN INTO CUSTODY AND CHARGED WITH A CRIMINAL OFFENSE. THIS "FIRST" ARREST NEED NOT HAVE LED TO FORMAL PROCEEDINGS IN COURT OR TO A FINDING OF GUILT. THE SAME APPLIES TO ANY OTHER USE OF THE TERM "ARREST."

NUMBER OF PRIOR ARRESTS:

THE TOTAL NUMBER OF ARRESTS, BOTH AS A JUVENILE AND AS AN ADULT, OCCURRING PRIOR TO THE MOST

NUMBER OF PRIOR INCARCERATIONS:

THE TOTAL NUMBER OF POST-CONVICTION INCARCERATIONS, BOTH AS A JUVENILE AND AS AN ADULT, IN WHICH THE INCARCERATION WAS IMPOSED AS A SENTENCE BY THE COURT. ALL JUVENILE AND ADULT COMMITMENTS AND COUNTY JAIL TERMS ARE TO BE COUNTED, INCLUDING INCARCERATIONS OF PROBATION VIOLATORS. RETURNS FOR VIOLATION OF A PAROLE OR OTHER POST-RELEASE CONDITION ARE NOT TO BE

TYPE OF CONVICTING (OR CHARGED) OFFENSE:

THIS ITEM REFERS TO THE GENERAL CATEGORY OF THE MOST SERIOUS OFFENSE FOR WHICH THE OFFENDER IS CURRENTLY CHARGED OR CONVICTED. IN THE 5-FACTOR RISK ASSESSMENT SCORING SYSTEM, MOST SERIOUS OFFENSES ARE GROUPED INTO THE SAME TYPES OR CATEGORIES AS ARE NEW CHARGES, NAMELY VIOLENT-PART I, PROPERTY-PART I, PERSONS/WEAPONS-PART II, DRUG-RELATED, ALCOHOL-RELATED, AND MISCELLANEOUS-

SINGLE FACTOR RATES 5-FACTOR SCORING SYSTEM

ON THE FOLLOWING FIVE PAGES, NEW CHARGE RATES ARE DELINEATED FOR CATEGORIES OF THE FIVE VARIABLES UNDERLYING THE 5-FACTOR SCORING SYSTEM.

AS WITH ALL SUCH TABLES APPEARING IN THIS DOCUMENT, TOTAL CASES, AVERAGE MONTHS OF SUPERVISION (PER OFFENDER), AND ELEVEN NEW CHARGE RATES - AS PREVIOUSLY DEFINED - ARE GIVEN FOR EACH CATEGORY. AT THE BOTTOM OF EACH TABLE, COMPOSITE NEW CHARGE RATES (ALL CASES) AND THE TOTAL NUMBER OF NEW CHARGES OF EACH TYPE IN THE STUDY POPULATION ARE GIVEN.

THE FOLLOWING BASIC PATTERNS EMERGE FROM AN EXAMINATION OF THE FIVE TABLES:

CURRENT AGE

- DISPROPORTIONATELY LARGE NUMBERS OF CASES FALL IN THE LOWER AGE CATEGORIES. NUMBERS OF CASES DECREASE STEADILY WITH INCREASING AGE. (FIVE-YEAR TOTALS SHOULD BE DIVIDED BY FIVE TO BETTER DISCERN THIS PATTERN.)
- 2. PROPERTY-PART I, DRUG-RELATED, MISCELLANEOUS-PART II, ALL CHARGES, AND WEIGHTED RATES SHOW SUBSTANTIAL REDUCTIONS
 WITH ADVANCING AGE. NOTE, IN PARTICULAR, THE EXTREMELY HIGH RATE (21.3) OF NEW PART I PROPERTY CHARGES AMONG 18-YEAR-OLDS.
- 3. THE VIOLENT-PART I RATE PEAKS IN THE 25-29 AGE RANGE (3.1) AND IS HIGHEST IN THE 21-34 RANGE. THE RATE IS MUCH LOWER FOR 18-YEAR-OLDS (1.1) AND FOR AGE GROUPS 35 OR OVER (0.6-1.1).
- 4. ALCOHOL-RELATED CHARGES PEAK IN THE 35-39 AGE RANGE (10.7) AND ARE HIGHEST IN THE 35 OR OVER RANGE.
- 5. THE PART I NEW CHARGE RATE SHOWS MUCH MORE ASSOCIATION WITH AGE THAN THE PART II RATE, AND THE WEIGHTED RATE MORE ASSOCIATION THAN THE ALL CHARGES RATE, ALTHOUGH THE LATTER STILL SHOWS A STRONG ASSOCIATION.

AGE AT FIRST ARREST

- 1. DISPROPORTIONATELY LARGE NUMBERS OF CASES FALL IN THE FIRST ARREST AGE CATEGORIES 16-17 AND 18-19.
- 2. VIOLENT-PART I AND PROPERTY-PART I RATES DECREASE SUBSTANTIALLY WITH INCREASING AGE AT FIRST ARREST. BOTH RATES ARE ESPECIALLY HIGH FOR THOSE FIRST ARRESTED BEFORE THE AGE OF 13. THE PROPERTY-PART I RATE IS ESPECIALLY LOW FOR THOSE
- 3. PART II RATES DECREASE WITH ADVANCING AGE AT FIRST ARREST, ALTHOUGH THE RELATIONSHIP IS NOT NEAR AS STRONG AS IS THE CASE WITH PART I RATES.
- 4. AS WAS THE CASE WITH CURRENT AGE, THE WEIGHTED RATE SHOWS A STRONGER ASSOCIATION WITH AGE AT FIRST ARREST THAN DOES

NUMBER OF PRIOR ARRESTS

- 1. ALL NEW CHARGE CATEGORIES SHOW INCREASING NEW CHARGE RATES WITH INCREASING NUMBERS OF PRIOR ARRESTS.
- 2. RATES ARE SUBSTANTIALLY LOWER FOR THOSE WITH NO PRIOR ARREST.
- 3. THE VIOLENT-PART I RATE IS ESPECIALLY HIGH FOR THOSE WITH SEVEN OR MORE PRIOR ARRESTS.
- 4. THE PROPERTY-PART I RATE IS HIGH FOR THOSE WITH THREE OR MORE PRIOR ARRESTS.
- 5. THE ALCOHOL-RELATED RATE IS HIGH FOR THOSE WITH SIX OR MORE PRIOR ARRESTS.
- 6. THE PERSONS/WEAPONS-PART II AND ALCOHOL-RELATED RATES ARE ESPECIALLY HIGH FOR THOSE WITH EIGHT OR MORE PRIOR ARRESTS.

NUMBER OF PRIOR INCARCERATIONS

- 1. NEW CHARGE RATES ARE MUCH HIGHER FOR THOSE WITH PRIOR INCARCERATIONS THAN FOR THOSE WITHOUT THEM.
- 2. THE VIOLENT-PART I RATE IS ESPECIALLY HIGH AND THE MISCELLANEOUS-PART II RATE HIGH FOR THOSE WITH FOUR OR MORE PRIOR INCARCERATIONS.
- 3. THE PERSONS/WEAPONS-PART II AND ALCOHOL-RELATED RATES ARE ESPECIALLY HIGH FOR THOSE WITH FIVE OR MORE PRIOR INCARCERATIONS.

TYPE OF CONVICTING OFFENSE

- 1. INDIVIDUAL NEW CHARGE RATES ARE UNIFORMLY HIGHEST FOR THE MATCHING CONVICTING OFFENSE CATEGORY (PROPERTY-PART I HIGHEST FOR PROPERTY-PART I, ETC.)
- 2. THOSE CONVICTED OF PART I-PROPERTY CRIMES SHOW THE HIGHEST OVERALL WEIGHTED AND UNWEIGHTED NEW CHARGE RATES.
- 3. NEW CHARGE RATES ARE SUBSTANTIALLY LOWER FOR THOSE CONVICTED OF DRUG OR ALCOHOL-RELATED CRIMES, AND ESPECIALLY SO FOR THE LATTER.

FROM THE TABLE, IT CAN BE SEEN THAT AGE AT FIRST ARREST MAINTAINS A STRONG ASSOCIATION WITH NEW CHARGE RATES WITHIN INDIVIDUAL AGE CATEGORIES. IN OTHER WORDS, AGE AT FIRST ARREST OFFERS ADDITIONAL EXPLANATION OF THE VARIATION IN NEW CHARGE RATES - BEYOND THAT AFFORDED BY THE CURRENT AGE VARIABLE.

NOTE IN PARTICULAR THAT YOUNGER OFFENDERS ARRESTED AT AN EARLY AGE HAVE THE HIGHEST NEW CHARGE RATES - AS WOULD BE EXPECTED. THE VIOLENT-PART I RATE IS HIGH FOR 21-34 YEAR-OLDS FIRST ARRESTED BEFORE THE AGE OF 15. ON THE OTHER HAND, THE PROPERTY-PART I RATE IS HIGH FOR 18-20 YEAR-OLDS FIRST ARRESTED AS JUVENILES (ESPECIALLY IF UNDER AGE 16), AND FOR 21-24 YEAR-OLDS FIRST ARRESTED BEFORE AGE 15.

NOTICE, ALSO, THE LARGE-ORDER DROP IN NEW CHARGE RATES (SEE ESP. ALL-PART I AND WEIGHTED RATES) AMONG 21-24 YEAR-OLDS FROM THE 0-14 AGE AT FIRST ARREST CATEGORY TO THE NEXT CATEGORY. FINALLY, FOR OFFENDERS AGE 30 OR OVER, THERE IS LITTLE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN THE TWO EARLIEST AGE AT FIRST ARREST CATEGORIES, BUT A LARGE DIFFERENCE DOWN TO THE NEXT CATEGORY.

ON PAGES 24-29 BELOW, NEW CHARGES RATES APPEAR IN THEIR FINAL 5-FACTOR FORMS, I.E., WITH THE FURTHER INCORPORATION OF THE VARIABLES "NUMBER OF PRIOR INCARCERATIONS" AND "TYPE OF CONVICTING OFFENSE."

THE 5-FACTOR CATEGORIES ARE SIMPLY REFINEMENTS OF THE 3-FACTOR CATEGORIES PREVIOUSLY DISCUSSED. IN SOME CASES, ONE OF THE TWO ADDED VARIABLES EXACTS THE REFINEMENT, WHILE IN OTHERS BOTH ARE INCORPORATED. THE EXTENT OF REFINEMENT IS, OF COURSE, COMMENSURATE WITH THE EXPLANATORY POWER OF THE TWO ADDED VARIABLES WITHIN 3-FACTOR CATEGORIES. THE EXTENT OF ADDITIONAL EXPLANATION, HOWEVER, IS SUBSTANTIALLY LESS THAN THAT AFFORDED BY THE ADDITION OF AGE AT FIRST ARREST AND NUMBER OF PRIOR ARRESTS TO THE CURRENT AGE FACTOR.

AGAIN, 5-FACTOR RATES ARE GROUPED ACCORDING TO CURRENT AGE. FURTHERMORE, 5-FACTOR CATEGORIES SPLIT FROM WITHIN CORRESPONDING 3-FACTOR CATEGORIES APPEAR TOGETHER TO CLARIFY THE EXTENT OF "THE SPLIT."

WE NOTE THAT ONE OR BOTH OF THE TWO ADDED VARIABLES EXACTS A GOOD SPLIT WITHIN MANY OF THE 3-FACTOR CATEGORIES, THEREBY ESTABLISHING THE ADDITIONAL EXPLANATORY POWER AFFORDED BY THE TWO FACTORS. GENERALLY SPEAKING, THE FACTOR "TYPE OF CONVICTING OFFENSE" EXACTS BETTER SPLITS IN 3-FACTOR CATEGORIES WITH LOWER NEW CHARGES RATES, WHILE THE FACTOR NUMBER OF PRIOR INCARCERATIONS EXACTS BETTER SPLITS IN CATEGORIES WITH HIGHER NEW CHARGE RATES. THIS IS BY NO MEANS A CLEAR-CUT DISTINCTION, HOWEVER.

TO ILLUSTRATE, THE FACTOR "TYPE OF CONVICTING OFFENSE" - BY ITSELF - SPLITS THE FOLLOWING 3-FACTOR CATEGORIES:

## CODING INSTRUCTIONS 5-FACTOR SCORING SYSTEM

TO OBTAIN THE 5-FACTOR CATEGORY AND CORRESPONDING 8-LEVEL RISK RATING FOR AN INDIVIDUAL OFFENDER, A FORM SUCH AS THAT APPEARING ON THE NEXT PAGE SHOULD BE CODED.

TO BEGIN, NAME, CASE NUMBER (IF APPLICABLE), AND THE FIVE INDIVIDUAL FACTORS UNDERLYING THE 5-FACTOR SYSTEM SHOULD BE CODED AT THE TOP LEFT OF THE FORM. EXACT VALUES FOR EACH OF THE ITEMS SHOULD BE CODED (AGE 47, 13 PRIOR ARRESTS, ETC.),

THE NEXT STEP IS TO LOCATE THE CORRECT 5-FACTOR CATEGORY FOR THE OFFENDER IN QUESTION. FOR THIS PURPOSE, THE TABLES ON PAGES 24-29, WHICH GROUP 5-FACTOR CATEGORIES BY AGE, SHOULD BE USED:

- 1. FIRST LOCATE THE TABLE CORRESPONDING TO THE CURRENT AGE OF THE OFFENDER (18-20, 21-24, ETC.).
- 2. FIND THAT PORTION OF THE TABLE CORRESPONDING TO THE OFFENDER'S AGE AT FIRST ARREST (IF NOT OF
- 3. FURTHER NARROW THE RANGE, BASED ON THE THREE REMAINING FACTORS, UNTIL THE CORRECT 5-FACTOR CATEGORY IS LOCATED.
- 4. WRITE OUT THE SPECIFIED DESCRIPTION OF THE FINAL 5-FACTOR CATEGORY ON THE BLANKS PROVIDED ON THE TOP
  RIGHT OF THE CODING FORM (CATEGORICAL DESCRIPTION).

AFTER THE 5-FACTOR CATEGORY IS LOCATED AND HAS BEEN DESCRIBED ON THE CODING FORM, THE ELEVEN NEW CHARGE RATES GIVEN FOR THAT CATEGORY SHOULD BE CODED ONTO THE FORM IN THE DESIGNATED BLANKS (UNDER <u>CASE</u>). THESE RATES CAN THEN BE COMPARED DIRECTLY WITH CORRESPONDING RATES - TO THE RIGHT - FOR THE TOTAL 6337-MEMBER STUDY POPULATION TO OBTAIN AN IDEA OF THE TYPES OF NEW CRIMES FOR WHICH THE OFFENDER IS HIGHER OR LOWER RISK THAN NORMAL.

### DISCUSSION AND INTERPRETATION 5-FACTOR SCORING SYSTEM

THE SCORING SYSTEM DESCRIBED ABOVE ESTABLISHES WHAT MIGHT BE TERMED A "DIMENSION OF RISK" AMONG ADULTS CHARGED WITH, OR CONVICTED OF, CRIMINAL OFFENSES IN THE STATE OF IOWA. AS A MEANS OF PREDICTING RECIDIVISM - OR THE RELATIVE PROBABILITIES OF SAME - THE 5-FACTOR SCORING SYSTEM IS ONE OF THE MOST ACCURATE AND RELIABLE DEVELOPED ANYWHERE IN THE UNITED STATES. THE SYSTEM HAS THE ADDED ADVANTAGES THAT IT INVOLVES A MINIMUM OF DATA COLLECTION AND PROVIDES AN EXPLICIT METHOD OF OFFENDER CLASSIFICATION.

FROM AN EXAMINATION OF 5-FACTOR CATEGORIES FALLING IN THE VARIOUS RISK LEVELS, AN APPRECIATION CAN BE GAINED FOR SOME OF THE MAJOR DISTINCTIONS MADE EXPLICIT IN THE FINAL CATEGORIZATION. IN PARTICULAR, IT SHOULD BECOME APPARENT THAT MANY OF THOSE RATED IN THE HIGHER RISK LEVELS ARE YOUNGER OFFENDERS WITH PRIOR RECORDS. IN CONTRAST, MANY OLDER OFFENDERS WITH PRIOR RECORDS (EVEN PRISON RECORDS) FALL IN LOWER LEVELS. THIS FINDING RUNS AGAINST THE GRAIN OF RECENT SCREENING DECISIONS IN THE IOWA SYSTEM IN THAT OLDER REPEATERS TYPICALLY ARE TREATED MUCH MORE HARSHLY IN SUCH DECISIONS THAN ARE YOUNGER COUNTERPARTS. ACCORDINGLY, USE OF A SYSTEM SUCH AS THAT PROPOSED HERE COULD HAVE A DECIDED IMPACT ON CRIMINAL JUSTICE POLICY IN THIS STATE, IN ADDITION TO ITS LIKELY IMPACT ON RECIDIVISM.

IN APPLYING THE 5-FACTOR SYSTEM IN SCREENING DECISIONS INVOLVING A JUDGMENT OF RISK, IT SHOULD BE REMEMBERED THAT THE RISK OF RECIDIVISM IS SELDOM CONSIDERED IN ISOLATION. OFTEN OTHER FACTORS, SUCH AS OFFENSE SEVERITY, RESIDENCE (OTHER COUNTY OR STATE, ETC.), OR A HISTORY OF VIOLENCE, MAY BE CONSIDERED IN ADDITION TO RISK. ALSO, THE RISK OF VIOLENCE MAY BE JUDGED IN ADDITION TO THE OVERALL RISK OF RECIDIVISM. (THE DETAILED INFORMATION IN THE TABLES CONCERNING TYPES OF NEW CHARGES CAN ASSIST IN THIS LATTER DETERMINATION.)

EVEN AS A VEHICLE FOR ASSESSING RISK, THE 5-FACTOR SYSTEM IS FAR FROM FOOLPROOF. IN FACT, THE SYSTEM SHOULD SERVE MAINLY AS A "GUIDE" TO RISK ASSESSMENT RATHER THAN AS A REPLACEMENT FOR TRADITIONAL PROCESSES. THE USER SHOULD LOOK FOR OTHER FACTORS THAT MIGHT WEIGH AGAINST THE ASSESSMENT BASED ON THE CHOSEN FIVE. OVER THE LONG RUN, HOWEVER, IF THE SYSTEM IS USED TO GOOD ADVANTAGE, ITS IMPACT SHOULD BECOME EVIDENT IN THE OUTCOMES OF SCREENING DECISIONS TO WHICH IT IS APPLIED. VERY SIMPLY, THE EXPLICIT RISK ASSESSMENT SHOULD "CHANNEL" THE DISCRETION OF DECISION-MAKERS IN THE DIRECTIONS ESTABLISHED BY THE SYSTEM. STATISTICAL MONITORING CAN MEASURE THE EXTENT TO WHICH THE SYSTEM ALTERS PREVIOUS DECISION PATTERNS, AND THE EXTENT TO WHICH DECISIONS DEVIATE FROM STRICT RELIANCE ON THE FIVE FACTORS.

IF RELATIVELY STRICT RELIANCE IS PLACED ON THE SYSTEM, SUCH AS WITH CUT-OFFS FOR ACCEPTANCE/REJECTION, A PRELIMINARY CASE STUDY SHOULD BE CONDUCTED TO DETERMINE THE LIKELY IMPACT OF STRICT RELIANCE ON DECISION OUTCOMES. SETTING THE CUT-OFFS AT THE WRONG POINTS, FOR EXAMPLE, COULD LEAD TO A DRASTIC CHANGE IN RATES OF ACCEPTANCE.

FINALLY, THE SYSTEM REFLECTS CURRENT KNOWLEDGE ABOUT PATTERNS OF RECIDIVISM WITHIN THE ADULT OFFENDER POPULATION OF THIS STATE. IN THE FUTURE, BETTER AND MORE REFINED INFORMATION CAN LEAD TO IMPROVEMENTS IN THE SYSTEM. SUCH WILL BE INCORPORATED AS IS SEEN FIT.

2-FACTOR SCORING SYSTEM

## 2-FACTOR SCORING SYSTEM DESCRIPTIVE OVERVIEW

AS DISCUSSED AT THE ONSET, THE 2-FACTOR SCORING SYSTEM IS OFFERED AS A SUPPLEMENT TO THE 5-FACTOR SYSTEM TO PROVIDE FURTHER SUPPORT FOR 5-FACTOR RATINGS AND TO CLARIFY SEEMINGLY ANOMALOUS RESULTS OF THE 5-FACTOR ASSESSMENT. THE 2-FACTOR SYSTEM IS BASED ON TWO KEY PREDICTORS OF RECIDIVISM AS FOLLOWS:

## CURRENT AGE MOST SERIOUS PRIOR JUSTICE SYSTEM INVOLVEMENT

ON THE FOLLOWING PAGE, THESE TWO ITEMS ARE CAREFULLY DEFINED TO ENSURE CONSISTENCY IN SCORING.

ON PAGES 49-50, NEW CHARGE RATES FOR CATEGORIES OF THE TWO VARIABLES ARE ITEMIZED. A BRIEF DISCUSSION APPEARS ON PAGE 48.

ON PAGES 52-53, NEW CHARGE RATES FOR SELECTED 2-FACTOR CONFIGURATIONS ARE PRESENTED, AND APPEAR IN GROUPINGS BY CURRENT AGE. IN THE 2-FACTOR SYSTEM, THE AGE RANGE 18-20 IS SPLIT INTO INDIVIDUAL AGES (AS OPPOSED TO THE 5-FACTOR SYSTEM). A DISCUSSION OF THE GROUPED 2-FACTOR RATES APPEARS ON PAGE 51.

ON PAGE 55, THE FINAL 2-FACTOR CATEGORIES ARE ITEMIZED, AND ARE LISTED IN DESCENDING ORDER OF THE MAGNITUDE OF THE WEIGHTED NEW CHARGE RATE. A DISCUSSION APPEARS ON THE PRECEDING PAGE.

ON PAGE 56, FINAL 2-FACTOR CONFIGURATIONS ARE GROUPED, ACCORDING TO THE MAGNITUDE OF THE WEIGHTED RATE, INTO 8 OFFENDER RISK LEVELS (OR RATINGS). RATINGS RANGE FROM VERY-LOW RISK TO ULTRA-HIGH RISK. FOR EACH RATING, THE CORRESPONDING RANGE OF THE WEIGHTED RATE IS GIVEN, ALONG WITH THE TOTAL NUMBER OF CASES SO-CATEGORIZED IN THE STUDY POPULATION. DUE TO MISSING DATA, THE OVERALL TOTAL FOR THE 5-FACTOR SYSTEM IS REDUCED FROM 6337 TO 5403.

ON PAGE 57, NEW CHARGE RATES FOR THE 8-LEVEL RATING SYSTEM ARE OFFERED.

ON PAGE 59, A SAMPLE CODING FORM IS INCLUDED, WITH CODING INSTRUCTIONS ON THE PREVIOUS PAGE.

FINALLY, ON PAGES 60-61, THE 2-FACTOR SCORING SYSTEM IS DISCUSSED, AND INTERPRETIVE COMMENTS ARE OFFERED.

#### CURRENT AGE:

ALL REFERENCES TO "CURRENT AGE" ARE TO THE AGE OF THE OFFENDER AT THE TIME RELEASE WOULD BE CONSIDERED. THE FACT THAT STATISTICS PRESENTED BELOW REFER TO "AGE AT PROBATION/PAROLE RELEASE" REFLECTS NO MORE THAN THE FACT THAT OBSERVED NEW CHARGE RATES CONCERN PAST PROBATION AND PAROLE EXPERIENCE. THE FINAL RATINGS, HOWEVER, CAN BE APPLIED TO OFFENDERS CONSIDERED FOR RELEASE AT ANY STAGE OF THE CRIMINAL JUSTICE PROCESS.

#### MOST SERIOUS PRIOR JUSTICE SYSTEM INVOLVEMENT:

THIS ITEM REFERS TO THE OFFENDER'S <u>HIGHEST</u> LEVEL OF <u>PRIOR</u> INVOLVEMENT WITH THE JUSTICE SYSTEM, AND COVERS BOTH JUVENILE AND ADULT INVOLVEMENTS. LEVELS OF PRIOR INVOLVEMENT ARE ON A 9-LEVEL SCALE AS BELOW. THE MOST SERIOUS PRIOR JUSTICE SYSTEM INVOLVEMENT OF AN OFFENDER IS THE HIGHEST OF THE LEVELS OF INVOLVEMENT APPEARING IN THE 9-LEVEL SCALE. <u>PRIOR</u> INVOLVEMENTS COVER ALL IN-VOLVEMENTS OCCURRING PRIOR TO THE MOST RECENT ARREST. PRISON TERMS DO <u>NOT</u> INCLUDE RETURNS OF PAROLE VIOLATORS ON THE ORIGINAL SENTENCE.

SINCE PATTERNS ASSOCIATED WITH CURRENT AGE WERE DISCUSSED PREVIOUSLY, WE LIMIT ATTENTION TO THE VARIABLE "MOST SERIOUS PRIOR JUSTICE SYSTEM INVOLVEMENT." THE FOLLOWING BASIC PATTERNS EMERGE:

- 1. THE FOUR CATEGORIES "NO PRIOR ARREST," "ARREST-FINE ONLY," "PROBATION ONLY," AND "INCARCERATION (COMPOSITE)"
  HAVE SUCCESSIVELY HIGHER NEW CHARGE RATES. FURTHER, ALL CATEGORIES OF PRIOR INCARCERATION HAVE HIGHER RATES
  THAN REMAINING CATEGORIES.
- 2. THE CATEGORY "ONE PRISON TERM (WITH OR WITHOUT LESSER INVOLVEMENTS)" HAS SUBSTANTIALLY LOWER RATES THAN OTHER CATEGORIES OF PRIOR INCARCERATION, AND IN FACT LOWER RATES THAN THE "PROBATION ONLY" CATEGORY.
- 3. THE CATEGORIES "BOTH OF PRECEDING (COUNTY JAIL TERM AND JUVENILE COMMITMENT)" AND "THREE + PRISON TERMS" HAVE
  THE HIGHEST RATES, AND THE CATEGORIES "JUVENILE COMMITMENT" AND "TWO PRISON TERMS" SIMILAR BUT SOMEWHAT LOWER
  RATES.
- 4. THE VIOLENT-PART I RATE IS HIGH FOR THE CATEGORIES "BOTH OF PRECEDING" AND "TWO PRISON TERMS," AND IS VERY HIGH FOR THE CATEGORY "THREE + PRISON TERMS."
- 5. THE PROPERTY-PART I RATE IS HIGH FOR THE CATEGORIES "JUVENILE COMMITMENT" AND "BOTH OF PRECEDING," WHICH COVER ALL CASES OF A JUVENILE COMMITMENT WITHOUT A PRIOR PRISON TERM. ON THE OTHER HAND, THE PROPERTY-PART I RATE IS VERY LOW FOR THE CATEGORY "ONE PRISON TERM."
- 6. THE PERSONS/WEAPONS-PART II AND MISCELLANEOUS-PART II RATES ARE HIGH FOR THE CATEGORY "BOTH OF PRECEDING," WHILE THE DRUG-RELATED RATE IS HIGH FOR THE CATEGORY "JUVENILE COMMITMENT."
- 7. THE ALCOHOL-RELATED RATE IS HIGH FOR THE CATEGORIES "COUNTY JAIL TERM" AND "THREE + PRISON TERMS."
- 8. FINALLY, THE WEIGHTED RATE IS HIGHER THAN THE ALL CHARGES RATE FOR THE CATEGORIES "JUVENILE COMMITMENT," "BOTH OF PRECEDING," "TWO PRISON TERMS," AND "THREE + PRISON TERMS."

THE TABLE CLEARLY ESTABLISHES THAT THE FACTOR "MOST SERIOUS PRIOR JUSTICE SYSTEM INVOLVEMENT" MAINTAINS A STRONG ASSOCIATION WITH NEW CHARGE RATES WITHIN INDIVIDUAL AGE CATEGORIES, AND THUS OFFERS SIGNIFICANT ADDITIONAL EXPLANATION OF THE VARIATION IN NEW CHARGE RATES BEYOND THAT AFFORDED BY THE CURRENT AGE VARIABLE.

EVIDENT, ALSO, IS THE TENDENCY TOWARD SIGNIFICANT REDUCTIONS IN NEW CHARGE RATES WITH INCREASING AGE - WITHIN INDIVIDUAL PRIOR INVOLVEMENT CATEGORIES.

UNDER THE AGE GROUPINGS 20 AND 21-24, THE CATEGORY "PROB-JUV COMM-CJ TERM" INCLUDES ALL THOSE WITH A PRIOR PROBATION, JUVENILE COMMITMENT, OR COUNTY JAIL TERM, BUT WITHOUT BOTH OF THE LATTER, AND WITHOUT A PRIOR PRISON TERM. UNDER AGE GROUPING 30-34, THE CATEGORY "PROBATION-INCARCERATION" INCLUDES ALL THOSE WITH A PRIOR PROBATION TERM OR INCARCERATION, THOSE WITH A PRIOR PROBATION TERM OR COMMITMENT, BUT EXCLUDES THOSE WITH 2+ PRISON TERMS AND THOSE WITH A COUNTY JAIL

# CODING INSTRUCTIONS 2-FACTOR SCORING SYSTEM

TO OBTAIN THE 2-FACTOR CATEGORY AND THE CORRESPONDING 8-LEVEL RISK RATING FOR AN INDIVIDUAL OFFENDER, A FORM SUCH AS THAT APPEARING ON THE NEXT PAGE SHOULD BE CODED.

TO BEGIN, NAME, CASE NUMBER (IF APPLICABLE), CURRENT AGE, AND THE FIVE INDICATED ASPECTS OF THE OFFENDER'S PRIOR CRIMINAL RECORD SHOULD BE CODED AT THE TOP LEFT OF THE FORM. THE EXACT AGE OF THE OFFENDER AND THE EXACT NUMBER OF PRIOR PRISON TERMS SHOULD BE CODED. FOR THE FOUR REMAINING ITEMS, A YES/NO INDICATOR IS ALL THAT IS NECESSARY.

USING THE FIVE PRIOR RECORD INDICATORS, THE LEVEL OF THE MOST SERIOUS PRIOR JUSTICE SYSTEM INVOLVEMENT OF THE OFFENDER SHOULD BE CODED AT THE TOP RIGHT OF THE FORM. THE DEFINITION OF THIS FACTOR - ON PAGE 47 - SHOULD BE CAREFULLY NOTED.

FROM THE CURRENT AGE AND MOST SERIOUS PRIOR INVOLVEMENT FACTORS, THE FINAL 2-FACTOR CATEGORY SHOULD BE DETERMINED BY SCANNING THE TABLE ON PAGE 55. WRITE OUT THE SPECIFIED DESCRIPTION OF THIS CATEGORY ON THE BLANK PROVIDED ON THE TOP RIGHT OF THE FORM (CATEGORICAL DESCRIPTION).

AFTER THE 2-FACTOR CATEGORY IS LOCATED AND HAS BEEN DESCRIBED ON THE CODING FORM, THE ELEVEN NEW CHARGE RATES GIVEN FOR THAT CATEGORY SHOULD BE CODED ONTO THE FORM IN THE DESIGNATED BLANKS (UNDER CASE). THESE RATES CAN THEN BE COMPARED DIRECTLY WITH CORRESPONDING RATES - TO THE RIGHT - FOR THE TOTAL 6337-MEMBER STUDY POPULATION TO OBTAIN AN IDEA OF THE TYPES OF NEW CRIMES FOR WHICH THE OFFENDER IS HIGHER OR LOWER RISK THAN NORMAL.

FINALLY, THE WEIGHTED RATE FOR THE CATEGORY SHOULD BE NOTED (LAST OF ELEVEN BLANKS), AND THE 8-LEVEL OFFENDER RISK RATING DETERMINED BY CONSULTING THE CHART ON PAGE 56. THE TABLE ON PAGE 57 CAN THEN BE EXAMINED TO GAIN AN APPRECIATION FOR THE RELATIVE SIGNIFICANCE OF THE FINAL RATING.

### DISCUSSION AND INTERPREMATION 2-FACTOR SCORING SYSTEM

AS DISCUSSED AT THE OUTSET, THE 2-FACTOR SCORING SYSTEM IS <u>NOT</u> RECOMMENDED FOR DIRECT APPLICATION IN RISK ASSESSMENT. RATHER, IT CAN PLAY A SUPPORTING ROLE -TO THE 5-FACTOR SYSTEM - IN CLARIFYING AND RATIONALIZING RESULTS OF THE 5-FACTOR ASSESSMENT. WHERE THE TWO SYSTEMS GIVE RADICALLY DIFFERENT RATINGS, RELIANCE SHOULD BE PLACED ON THE 5-FACTOR SYSTEM.

PERHAPS THE BEST USE OF THE 2-FACTOR SYSTEM IS TO PROVIDE A CONVENIENT OVERVIEW OF RECIDIVISM POTENTIAL AT A REASONABLY REFINED LEVEL, THEREBY ACQUANTING THE USER WITH THE BASIC "THRUST" OF THE DIMENSION CALLED "RISK." ACCORDINGLY, THE 2-FACTOR MATERIAL ON PAGE 54 SHOULD BE CAREFULLY STUDIED TO GIVE A "FEEL" FOR THIS DIMENSION. IN PARTICULAR, THE DUAL ROLES OF AGE AND PRIOR RECORD IN ESTABLISHING RISK CAN BE EASILY PERCEIVED FROM THIS TABLE.
