PREFACE

The information in the following annual statistical report was compiled by the Virginia Department of Corrections, Research and Reporting Unit. Copies of similar annual reports on felons paroled and discharged are available for fiscal years 1976 through 1979.

This is the first fiscal year for which data on mandatory parolees are included. Effective July 1, 1979, legislative action (Code of Virginia, § 53–251.3) required that every person sentenced and committed to any State correctional institution be mandatorily discharged on parole by the Virginia Parole Board when six months remain in the person's sentence. Each "discharge on parole." Such persons who are so discharged on parole (Mandatory Parolees) are subject to a minimum of six months supervision.

DISCHARGES

A total of 139 felons were discharged during the fiscal year which ended June 30, 1980. Of these, 103 or 74.1% were first releases, 29 or 20.9% were discharged after having been returned as mandatory parole violators and seven or 5.0% were discretionary parole violators. In total, there were 36 (25.9%) felons discharged who were violators. First releases served an average of 14 months, while violator releases served an average of 29 months. The average time served for all discharges was 18 months. Of the 139 discharges, 131 or 94.2% served less than five years. The longest time served was 12 years, 7 months.

More than half (83 or 59.7%) of the discharged felons had committed Offenses Against Property. There were 32 (23.0%) felons who had committed Offenses Against Persons.

There were 89 (64.0%) felons discharged who had sentences of two years or less, 29 (20.9%) who had sentences of three to five years and 21 (15.1%) who had sentences of over five years. The longest sentence was 16 years.

DISCRETIONARY PAROLEES

Felons discretionarily paroled during fiscal year 1980 numbered 1,693. Of these, 1,621 or 95.7% were first releases, 71 or 4.2% were discretionarily paroled after having been returned as discretionary parole violators and one or 0.1% had been a mandatory parole violator. In total there were 72 (4.2%) felons discretionarily paroled who were violators. First releases served an average of 35 months, while violator releases served an average of 95 months. The average time served by all parolees was 38 months. Of the 1,693 discretionary parolees, 1,649 or 97.4% served less than ten years. The longest time served was 38 years, 1 month.

Among the discretionary parolees, 627 or 37.0% committed Offenses Against Persons, 775 or 45.8% committed Offenses Against Property, and 291 or 17.2% committed other offenses.

There were 90 (5.3%) parolees who had terms of sentence of two years or less. A total of 1,130 discretionary parolees (66.8%) had sentences of less than ten years. Nine felons with life sentences were paroled.

MANDATORY PAROLEES

A total of 1,674 felons were mandatorily paroled during fiscal year 1980. Of these, 1,481 or 88.5% were first releases, 186 or 11.1% were mandatorily paroled after having been returned as discretionary parole violators and seven or 0.4% were mandatorily paroled again, after having been returned as mandatory parole violators. In total, there were 193 (11.5%) violator releases. First releases served an average of 17 months, while violator releases served an average of 47 months. All mandatory parolees served an average of 20 months. Of the 1,674 mandatory parolees, 1,661 or 99.2% served less than ten years. The longest time served was 17 years, 3 months.

Among the mandatory parolees, 361 or 21.6% committed Offenses Against Persons, 900 or 53.7% committed Offenses Against Property, and 413 or 24.7% committed other offenses.

There were 888 (53.1%) parolees who had terms of sentences of two years or less. A total of 1,606 or 95.9% had sentences of less than ten years. The longest sentence was 27 years.


TOTAL DISCHARGES AND PAROLEES

A total of 3,506 felons were either discharged or paroled during fiscal year 1980. The average time served by all parolees and discharges was 28 months. The median time served was 20 months.

OTHER OUTGOING FELONS

Among the other outgoing felons, there were two felons pardoned, 18 released by court order, and 11 felons who died.
