
The statistical summary which follows provides an overview of the Juvenile Court operations in Pennsylvania. It is limited to Juvenile Court delinquency cases originating in County Juvenile Probation Offices. Please note that dependency cases are not included in this report. The majority of dependency cases originate in the County Child Welfare Agency, and the small number of dependency cases originating in the County Juvenile Probation Offices may lead to erroneous interpretations of State-wide dependency data.

The report contains data on selected juvenile characteristics and methods by which children were handled by each Court. Although the report is general in nature, it should be used by each county to identify areas of court management that may need further evaluation or monitoring. More detailed data that is beyond the scope of this report is available in our Statistical Office data files. The Office will be glad to discuss any specific data requirements with each county court.

The Juvenile Court Judges' Commission is firmly committed to supplying reliable Juvenile Court data. It is our hope that the information contained in this report will be informative and meaningful in providing more effective services for the children reported in these statistics.

I wish to thank the Juvenile Court Judges and the Chief Juvenile Probation Officers and their staff for without their cooperation, it would be impossible to complete this report.

SUMMARY OF JUVENILE COURT DISPOSITIONS, 1981

MANNER OF HANDLING

There were 36,341 delinquency referrals disposed of in Pennsylvania Juvenile Courts during 1981. 20,938 or 57.6% of the juveniles processed were handled by an adjudication hearing. 10,503 or 28.9% of the cases were handled informally, and 4,900 or 13.5% were handled by a consent decree.

DETENTION

Of the 36,341 referrals processed, there were a total of 8,732 pre-disposition detention experiences and 946 detentions after disposition. These detention incidents do not represent the number of juveniles detained since one child may be counted more than once (by both pre and post disposition detention or by entering more than one facility.) The majority of the detentions, 95.1% were in detention homes while 2.1% were in shelter facilities. Foster homes accounted for 1.0% of all detentions.

DISPOSITION

31,934 or 88.0% of the total delinquency cases disposed of during 1981 did not require placement or other transfer of custody. Probation accounted for the major part of these dispositions with 12,057 or 37.8% followed by cases that were dismissed, 11,281 or 35.3%. 5,310 or 14.6% of these cases were handled by an informal adjustment. 4,407 or 12.0% of the delinquency cases disposed of did require a placement or other transfer of custody. Total placements showed an increase of almost 6% from the 1980 figure with the most significant change in the number of placements to private institutions for delinquents, up 26% from a year ago.

1981 Delinquency referrals in Philadelphia County were up 12% from 1980. The number of delinquency referrals in Allegheny were down from 1980 by 6.3%. One-half of all delinquency referrals in the state, 50.8%, are accounted for by these two counties. In the 65 other counties of Pennsylvania delinquency referrals were up slightly, by 0.2%.

Placement of delinquents in private institutions has increased by 26% during the last year, while their placement in public institutions decreased by almost 6%. A summary of placements of delinquency referrals for the last three years is shown in Table C.

Annual placements of delinquent children to other court ordered care has remained relatively stable during the last three years. Placement in private or public delinquency institutions is not exactly comparable with the category of other court ordered care since the latter contains community based facilities. Nonetheless, combining both types of facilities shows a net increase over this period of 6.7% or 278 placements.

TIME LAPSE DATA FOR THE JUVENILE COURT PROCESS

The average time lapse from referral to disposition during 1981 was 77.76 days. This is an increase of 4.1 days or 5.6% above the 1980 figure. Adjudicatory and informal cases both showed significant increases in the average number of days from referral to disposition, almost 7 days longer for adjudicatory cases and 5 days longer for informal cases. Consent decree cases however, took 10% less time from referral to disposition than they did a year ago.

ATTORNEY REPRESENTATION

The following information is based on 12,244 cases where attorney representation was known. Attorney representation is divided into four (4) categories: court appointed, private, public defender and cases where the juvenile waived his right to an attorney. No statewide county breakdown is available in the detail tables.

Mean time lapse from referral to disposition for cases under court appointed attorneys was up 17.4%, from 68.38 to 80.30, in 1981. Median time lapse increased from 46 to 55 days. Total juvenile court cases using court appointed attorneys decreased 10.8% to 463 during 1981.

Private attorneys had an average time lapse between referral and disposition of 88.78 days, up 0.2%. The median time lapse increased 1.4% from 1980. The gap between time lapse data for court appointed attorneys V.S. private attorneys decreased from 20.2 days in 1980 to 8.5 days in 1981.

When the Attorney representing the youth was the Public Defender the time lapse from referral to disposition was 71.14 days. 50% of the juveniles in this category had disposition within 52 days. The median for this group was down 1.9% from the median for 1980.

The average time lapse from referral to disposition when the attorney was waived was 61.37 days. The median time lapse was 38 days, 7 days less than for 1980. Expressed as a percentage of the median time lapse when the attorney was waived, private attorneys took 90% longer, Public Defenders took 37% longer and Court appointed Attorneys took 45% longer.
