Juveniles Released From Division of Corrections Juvenile Institutions in 1980

HIGHLIGHTS

- * Releases from Wisconsin's juvenile correctional institutions remained at the same level: 888 releases during calendar year 1980; 883 releases during calendar year 1979. Eight-hundred and nine boys were released during 1980: 406 first releases to aftercare, 105 re-releases to aftercare, 272 direct discharges, and 26 discharges by court order. The breakdown of the 79 girls released in 1980 is as follows: 38 first releases, 8 re-releases, 28 direct discharges, and 5 discharges by court order. (Table 3)
- * Thirty-five juveniles, 27 boys and 8 girls, released during 1980 are reported only in Table 3 either because they were released to out-of-state placements or because the Wisconsin county to which they were returned was unknown. Boys excluded are 4 first releases, 6 re-releases, 15 direct discharges, and 2 discharges by court order. Girls excluded from further tables are 1 re-release, 4 direct discharges, and 1 discharge by court order.
- * Slightly over two-fifths (44 percent) of the boys released to aftercare during 1980 were returned to placements in the Milwaukee or Southeastern Region. Almost three-fifths (58 percent) of the girls released during the same time period also returned to the Milwaukee or Southeastern Region. (Table 1, 1-A)

- * Five out of 10 boys and girls released from juvenile correctional institutions during 1980 were first releases to aftercare supervision a contrasted with 1979 when somewhat less than three-fifths (58 percent) of the boys and a little over two-thirds (68 percent) of the girls were first releases to aftercare supervision. (Table 2)
- * The average (median) length of stay for boys first-released to aftercare increased from 7.6 months in 1979 to 8.2 months in 1980. Boys re-released to aftercare supervision in both years spent an average (median) of 8.9 months in the institution prior to release. An average (median) of 6.7 months was spent in the institution by all girls released to aftercare in 1980 as contrasted with 1979 when first-released girls remained for 7.2 months and re-released girls stayed for 7.8 months prior to placement on supervision. (Tables 4, 4-A)
- * Boys first-released in 1980 had an average (median) age of 16.9 years as contrasted with 1979 when the average for first-released boys was 16.7 years. The average (median) age for first-released girls increased from 16.0 months in 1979 to 16.7 months in 1980. Girls re-released in both years had an average age of 16.6 years. (Tables, 5, 5-A)
- * Seven out of 10 boys released to aftercare during 1980, as in 1979, were white. Slightly less than one-fifth (19 percent in 1980; 18 percent in 1979) of the boys first and re-released to aftercare were black. Three-fifths (60 percent) of all girls released to aftercare during 1980 were white while almost three-tenths (29 percent) were black. During calendar year 1979 almost two-thirds (65 percent) of the girls released to aftercare supervision were white; one-fourth were black. (Tables 6, 6-A)

- * Nine out of 10 boys and girls who were first releases to aftercare supervision during 1980 were reported to be making at least an average institutional adjustment prior to release. This was also true for 87 percent of the boys and all seven girls re-released during the same time period. (Tables 7, 7-A)
- * Four out of 10 boys and 5 out of 10 girls first-released in 1980 were reported as being from families in the lower socio-economic levels. This was also true for about one-half (47 percent) of the re-released boys and almost three fifths (57 percent) of the re-released girls. (Tables 9, 9-A)
- * The majority, 8 out of 10 first-released and two-thirds of the re-released boys, were reported to have made satisfactory educational progress while institutionalized. The same was true for two-thirds of the first-released girls and 6 out of the 7 girls re-release during 1980. (Tables 10, 10-A)
- * Almost two-thirds (64 percent) of the first-released and 70 percent of the re-released boys participated in some type of vocational program during institutionalization. Only about one-fourth of the girls first-released in 1980 participated in vocational programs but over one-half (57 percent) of the re-released girls were reported to have been involved in such programs. (Tables 11, 11-A)
- * Three-fourths of the boys and girls first-released to aftercare during 1980 were reported to have been living with at least one parent or step-parent prior to institutionalization. The same was true for slightly more than three-fifths (63 percent) of the re-released boys and somewhat over two-fifths (43 percent) of the re-released girls. (Tables 13, 13-A)

- * Almost two-fifths (39 percent) of the boys first-released to aftercare and one-half of the re-released boys returned to living situations in which at least one parent or step-parent was present. One-half of the first-released girls and almost three-fifths (57 percent) of the re-released girls were also returned to live with at least one parent or step-parent. (Tables 14, 14-A)
- * Information relating to the 257 boys directly discharged and the 24 boys discharged from the institutions by court order during 1980 can be found in Appendix A.
- * Twenty-four girls received direct discharges from Wisconsin juvenile correctional institutions in 1980. Four girls were discharged by court order during the same year. See Appendix B for selected characteristics.
- * Selected characteristics for juveniles first and re-released during the years 1976-1980 are reported in Appendices C-F.
- * The median age of first-released boys continued its upward trend, rising from 16.2 in 1977 to 16.9 years in 1980. (Appendix C)
- * Less than one-fourth (24 percent) of girls first-released during 1980 went to foster home placements. This is low for the five-year period. (Appendix D)
- * The percentage of re-released boys reported to have made excellent educational progress in the institution increased from a five-year low of 11.7 in 1977 to a high of 20.2 in 1980. (Appendix E)

- * The average (mean) length of stay for re-released girls dropped from a five-year high of 9.7 months in 1979 to 6.4 months in 1980. (Appendix F.)
