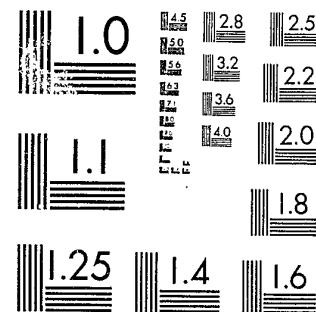

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Juveniles Released From
Division of Corrections Juvenile Institutions
in Calendar Year 1981

H I G H L I G H T S

- * Seven hundred and nineteen youths were released from Wisconsin's juvenile correctional institutions during calendar year 1981, a decrease of 19 percent from 1980 when 888 juveniles were reported as being released. A decline in admissions to and releases from Wisconsin's juvenile correctional institutions has been noted since 1979 and is probably attributable to the new Wisconsin Children's Code which was enacted in that year. The new code provides for community-based treatment of juvenile offenders except those found to be a danger to themselves or to the public and in need of restrictive or custodial care. Some children, who might have been sent to state correctional facilities, are, since 1979, being treated in their home localities.
- * Six hundred and fifty-eight boys were released during calendar year 1981: 394 first releases to aftercare, 76 re-releases to aftercare, 157 direct discharges, and 31 discharges by court order. A breakdown of the 61 girls released during 1981 shows 33 first releases to aftercare, 2 re-releases to aftercare, 16 direct discharges, and 10 discharges by court order. (Table 3)
- * Thirteen juveniles, 9 boys and 4 girls, released during 1981 are reported only in Table 3 either because they were released to out-of-state placements or because the Wisconsin county to which they were released was unknown. Boys excluded are 5 first releases to aftercare, 1 re-release to aftercare, and three direct discharges. All girls excluded were direct discharges.
- * Tables 4 through 14 present social and demographic data about boys first and re-released to aftercare by region to which released. Information about boys directly discharged or discharged by court order during the same time period can be found in Appendix Table A.
- * Data about the 33 girls first-released to aftercare and the two girls re-released to aftercare has not been presented in separate tables in this publication due to the smallness of numbers. This information has been combined with data about girls directly discharged and discharged by court order and can be found in Appendix Table B.
- * Over one-half of the boys first and re-released to aftercare during 1981 returned to living situations in the Southeastern or the Milwaukee Regions. Four out of 10 girls also returned to placements in the same regions. The following Wisconsin counties are included in the Southeastern Region: Kenosha, Ozaukee, Racine, Walworth, Washington, and Waukesha. Milwaukee County makes up the Milwaukee Region. (Table 3)
- * Boys first-released to aftercare in 1981 spent an average (median) of 7.9 months in the institution prior to release as opposed to 8.2 months for boys first-released during 1980. An average (median) of 8.7 months was spent in the institution by boys re-released to aftercare during 1981. Girls released during 1981 had an average (median) of 7.4 months in the institution.
(Table 4, Appendix B)

- * The average (median) age for boys first-released in 1981 was 16.7 years as contrasted with 16.9 years for those first-released in 1980. Boys re-released to aftercare were recorded as having an average (median) age of 17.2 years. The average (median) age of girls released during 1981 was 16.6 years. (Table 5, Appendix B)
- * Seven out of 10 boys, including 9 boys from Hispanic ethnic backgrounds, released to aftercare in 1981 were white. Almost one-fourth (24 percent) of the boys released to aftercare were black. Slightly less than two-thirds (65 percent) of all girls released were white while a little more than one-fourth (28 percent) were black. (Table 6, Appendix B)
- * Nine out of 10 boys first-released to aftercare and all boys re-released to aftercare were reported to have had at least an average institutional adjustment prior to being released. (Table 7)
- * A rating of at least satisfactory in educational progress while institutionalized was reported for 9 out of 10 boys first and re-released to aftercare during 1981. This was also true for all girls released during the same time period. (Table 10, Appendix B)
- * Almost three-fourths (73 percent) of the boys first-released to aftercare had come to the institutions from living situations in which at least one parent was present. First-released boys, however, returned to placements in which at least one parent was present in only 3 out of 10 instances. Boys re-released to aftercare came from and returned to living situations in which at least one parent was present in 4 out of 10 cases. (Tables 13, 14)
- * Selected characteristics for juveniles first and re-released during the years 1977-1981 are reported in Appendices C-F.
- * One-third of the boys first-released to aftercare were returned to placements in the Milwaukee Region, a high for the five-year period. The Northern Region consistently received the least number of boys released in each of the five years. (Appendix C)
- * Girls first-released to aftercare in 1981 had spent an average (mean) of 7.4 months in the institution. This is an increase over 1980 levels as well as a high for the five-year period. (Appendix D)
- * Over one-third (36 percent) of the boys re-released to aftercare in 1981 returned to placements in the Milwaukee Region. This is a high for the five-year period. (Appendix E)
- * The number of girls re-released to aftercare in 1981 is a low for the five-year period of 2. (Appendix F)
