With Five-Year Trends for 1977-1981

A total of 4,249 persons, 4,093 males and 156 females were residents in Wisconsin's adult correctional facilities on December 31, 1981. This is an increase of 12 percent (12 percent for males, 17 percent for females) over December 31, 1980 when 3,788 persons, 3,655 males and 133 females, were reported as being in residence.

Tables 1-10 present data on the 3,976 males and 139 females resident in adult correctional institutions on December 31, 1981. This includes males confined at institutions operated by the Bureau of Adult Institutions, men resident in the Parole Opportunity Program at Oakhill, men participating in the program at the Corrections Drug and Alcohol Treatment Center, and men transferred under contract to serve Wisconsin sentences at the Stillwater or St. Cloud correctional institutions in Minnesota. Information about the 134 persons, 117 males and 17 females, resident in Bureau of Community Corrections Residential Centers on December 31, 1981 can be found in Tables 11-20. Five-year trend data for male and female residents in adult institutions and community residential centers on December 31, 1977-1981 can be found in Tables A and B.

The year-end adult male population rose from a low of 3,211 in 1977 to a five-year high of 4,093 in 1981, an increase of 27 percent, with the greater proportion of the increase taking place during the years 1980-81. The proportion of men received as new admissions remained relatively constant during the five-year period. The median age for men, which has been increasing during the five-year period, rose to a high of 27.1 years in 1981. Men in residence on December 31, 1981 had a medium length of sentence of 5.8 years, a slight drop from the five-year high of 6.1 years recorded in 1979.

Beginning with men in residence, on December 31, 1979, residents were classified as to type of offender; i.e., assaultive offender, sex offender, drug offender, combinations of the preceding three, and not assaultive, sex, or drug offenders. The proportion of men in residence who had not been convicted of assaultive, sex, or drug offenses remained relatively stable (38 percent) during the three-year period. Less than 1 percent of the men in residence were reported as being convicted only of sex offenses while the proportion of men serving sentences for drug offenses only decreased from 4.6 percent in 1979 to 3.5 percent in 1981. The proportion of men classified as being only assaultive offenders declined from 46.4 percent in 1979 to 35.6 percent in 1981. However, the proportion of residents reported as being both assaultive and sex offenders almost doubled during the three-year period from 9.4 percent in 1979 to 18.3 percent in 1981 while the proportion of men classified as assaultive, sex, and drug offenders rose from one-tenth of a percent in 1979 to 2.9 percent in 1981.

The number of females in residence on December 31 rose to a five-year high of 156 in 1981; an increase of 17 percent over 1980 levels. The proportion of new admissions dropped from a high of 99 percent in 1980 to 94 percent in 1981. The proportion of residents reported as being non-white rose in 1981 after declining since 1978. The decline in the proportion of females committed from Milwaukee County first noted in 1978 continued with a low for the five-year period of 43 percent being recorded in 1981. Median age remained relatively stable during the five-year period.

On December 31, 1979, one-half (50.3 percent) of the females in residence were reported as having been convicted on other than assaultive, sex, or drug charges. This proportion decreased during the three-year period to a low of 44.8 percent in 1981. There was a slight increase in the proportion of females sentenced for drug offenses only in each of the three years.

In 1979, 41.7 percent of the females in residence on December 31 had been sentenced for assaultive crimes or a combination of assaultive, sex and/or drug offenses. This figure increased to a three year high of 46.2 percent in 1981.
