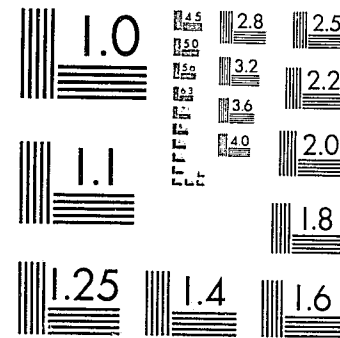

STATISTICAL NOTES:

1. The majority of the tables presented in this report are based on a total homicide count of 1332 for New York City in 1981. However, in several instances, to insure comparability with Nationwide U.C.R. statistics, "INDEX HOMICIDES", as tabulated by the F.B.I. uniform crime reporting system, is the statistic chosen for comparison. Since 1978 the F.B.I. has excluded Non-negligent homicides committed by intoxicated drivers from the U.C.R. statistics. N.Y.C. recorded six (6) of these cases in 1981 giving a U.C.R. homicide count of 1826. These cases are classified as homicides under the N.Y.S. Penal Law. Tables using "Index homicides" therefore present total cases of 1826 while all other tables present N.Y.S. Penal Law homicides, a total of 1832.

2. In addition to the information sources previously noted, data for the 1981 homicide analysis was gathered during interviews with each detective squad commander regarding the homicides within his precinct. This more rigorous data collection method, which had first been used for the 1980 homicide analysis, has been continued for the 1981 cases given the increased accuracy and thoroughness of the data supplied through this method.

3. Although both 1980 and 1981 circumstance data is presented, comparison between these years is somewhat inappropriate. In the course of collecting data for the 1980 homicide analysis, there were a significant number of cases in which a drug dealer was robbed and murdered. These cases were classified as "robbery" homicides rather than "drug related" in 1980 because classification was dependent upon a circumstance hierarchy in which "robbery" preceded "drug related." For the 1981 homicide analysis it was decided that these cases should more properly be classified as "drug related" since in most cases it was the drug dealing (and all the accompanying contacts, relationships, etc) which precipitated the robbery and the homicide of the dealer. The 1981 circumstance hierarchy was changed to reflect this decision. Approximately 160 homicides in 1981 were drug related robberies (i.e., the homicide victim was a drug dealer who was robbed). In the 1981 homicide analysis they were placed in the "drug related" category. In the 1981 analysis "drug related" also took precedence over burglary and sex crime. Overlap between

"drug related" and either of these categories was however minimal. Thus, even if the actual circumstance of homicides had remained constant between 1980 and 1981, one would expect to find a significant increase in "drug related" homicides and a significant decrease in "robbery" homicides. (Based solely on changes in classification.)

4. It should be noted that an "unknown" characterization is a mix of investigative and administrative unknowns.

5. Homicide cases are tabulated by victim rather than by incident (E.G. one incident involving 3 victims results in three separate homicide cases in this analysis). The analysis of perpetrator data may therefore involve the same perpetrator several times.

Additionally, statistics comparing perpetrator and other case characteristics involve only the first perpetrator on that case. Tabulations of perpetrators ONLY data, present data on all perpetrators.

6. Perpetrator data is not limited to those perpetrators who were arrested, but rather represents all instances of suspect characteristics known to the police at the time of this analysis.

7. Arrest data is tabulated by location. The precinct of arrest is however not necessarily the precinct of commission. Thus it would be possible to have precincts with more than 100 arrests per 100 complaints (Map 3).

8. Since the number of cases where information is unavailable varies between 1981 and 1980 and between different case characteristics within each year, some tables in this report deal with tabulations of only those cases where information is available. Any tables with a total case count less than 1832 for 1981 or 1821 for 1980 have excluded cases with unavailable information.

In Tables where cases have been excluded the appropriate comparison measures is the various proportions of row, column, and grand total displayed.

9. In a few instances 1980 data in the 1981 Analysis Book differs slightly from 1980 data presented in the 1980 Homicide Analysis Book. These few discrepancies are due to

corrections which had been made in the 1980 data prior to preparation of the 1981 book. (E.G. in the 1980 Homicide Book, the count for "Blunt Instrument" as a means was 49 and "Other" was 50. In the 1981 book "Blunt Instrument" was 50 and "Other" was 49.)

1. Reading down each cell; the first figure is the number of cases, the second is the row percentage (are totaled across table), the third is the column percentage (are totaled reading down the table) and the last is the percentage relative to all the cases in the matrix.

HOMICIDE ANALYSIS

1981

GENERAL COMMENTS

1. There were 1,832 Homicides in New York City in 1981. This is .6% more than the 1980 total of 1,821. (Table 1).
2. Of the 10 Largest Cities, New York City ranked 6th in the rate of homicides per 100,000 population. N.Y.C. had 25.8 homicides per 100,000 population (Table 97).
3. Although Brooklyn had the greatest number of homicides (595), Manhattan was the Borough with the highest rate per 100,000 residents (39.1) (Table 1).
4. The Bronx had the largest increase in homicides (8.3%) and Queens had the largest decrease (-7.1%) comparing 1981 and 1980. (Table 1).
5. The 44th Precinct in the Bronx recorded the most homicides for 1981 (73). This precinct also accounted for the most homicide arrests (69) (Tables 3 and 4).
6. There were 1,110 homicide arrests in 1981. 78.4% of these arrests were made by Precinct Detective Unit personnel. (Table 5).
7. December was still the month in which most homicides occurred (188). February had the lowest count (118)(Table 6).
8. Homicides occurred most often on the weekend (Friday Saturday and Sunday) (Table 7).
9. Disputes continue to be the most frequent homicide circumstance, 41.6% in 1981. Robbery homicides in 1981, using a new categorization which excluded Robbery/Drug Related Homicides, accounted for 18.8% of the homicide cases recorded in 1981. (Tables 8 and 9; also see statistical notes section for a detailed description of classification changes and category definitions).
10. Handguns continue to be the most frequently used homicide weapon. Handguns were used in 59.3% (1087 cases) of the 1981 homicide cases recorded, the highest proportion of handgun utilization recorded to date. (Table 10).
11. Most homicides occurred either in open areas (48.4%) or in a residence (35.9%) (Table 12).

HOMICIDE VICTIMS AND PERPETRATORS

12. Homicides continue to be committed by someone known to the victim. The victim-perpetrator relationship category "Friend-Acquaintance" comprised 62.7% of all homicide cases in which a relationship could be determined. (Table 16).

13. Homicide perpetrators continue to be primarily Black (54.6%) and primarily Male (93.3%). (Tables 18 and 19).

14. Homicide victims were primarily Black (48.6%) and primarily Male (85.3%) (Tables 22 and 23).

15. More than half the homicide perpetrators were between the ages of 16 and 25 (Table 26).

16. More than one third of the homicide victims were between the ages of 21 and 30 (Table 28).

17. A Male Black between the ages of 26 and 30 was the most frequent homicide victim. (Table 30).

18. A Male Black between the ages of 16 and 20 continued to be the most frequent homicide perpetrator (Table 34).

HOMICIDE VICTIM/PERPETRATOR RELATIONSHIPS

19. Blacks were victimized by Blacks in 87.4% of the cases, Hispanics were victimized by Hispanics in 78.9% of the cases, and Whites were victimized by Whites in 48.7% of the cases. (Table 40).

20. Whites were more often killed by strangers than were Blacks or Hispanics. Hispanics were most likely killed by a friend or acquaintance (Table 42)

21. A cutting instrument was the most frequently used weapon in all intra-family and boy-girl friend homicides. Handguns were most often used by strangers and friends-acquaintances. (Table 50).

CIRCUMSTANCES OF HOMICIDES

22. Elderly homicide victims were murdered most often during a robbery (Table 52).

23. Blacks and Hispanics were most often murdered in disputes; Whites were most often murdered during robberies (Table 54).

24. Males were more likely than females to be murdered in robbery or drug related incidents. Females were more likely murdered in disputes or sex crimes. (Table 56).

25. Disputes and drug related homicides between friends and acquaintances accounted for half of New York City's 1981 homicides (Table 58).

26. A Handgun was the weapon most often used in all homicide categories other than burglary and sex crime. Physical force was most often used in these 2 categories (Table 60).

27. Robberies, disputes and drug related homicides occurred most often in open areas. Burglary and sex crime homicides occurred most often in a residence. (Table 62).

28. All burglary homicides and 92.8% of the recorded robbery homicides were committed by Blacks and Hispanics. While the majority of these cases are still intra-racial, cases in which victims are of a different race than the perpetrator account for over 40% of the cases. Sex crime homicides are almost exclusively intra-racial (Tables 74, 75 and 78).

HOMICIDE- MEANS EMPLOYED

29. Blacks and Hispanics were more likely than Whites to be murdered with a handgun. Whites were more likely murdered by physical force (Table 86).

30. Females were much more likely than Males to be murdered by the use of physical force. Males were more likely murdered with handguns (Table 88).

31. Handguns were the means most often used in all victim age categories, other than the very young and very old. Those over 60 were most often murdered through the use of physical force (Table 90).

32. Perpetrators in all age categories, other than those over 60, used handguns most frequently to commit homicides. Those in the 21 to 25 year old age category used **handguns** 64% of the time. (Table 92).

HOMICIDE HISTORICAL DATA

33. For a 20 year period, through 1958, the number of homicides recorded in New York City fluctuated between 200 and 350 cases per year. The yearly caseload since 1958 has steadily increased. (Figure 1 - Table 94).

34. The significant increases since 1958 are not peculiar to New York City, but rather mirror quite closely a nationwide trend. (Figure 1 - Table 94).

35. The trend in homicide circumstances for the last 20 years has been a marked increase in both the number of "Crime Related Homicides" (Robbery, Drug Related, etc.) and their percentage of the total. Both dispute and family related homicides have decreased in terms of their percentage of the total homicides. (Figure 2 - Table 95).

36. The most significant trend over the last 20 years in terms of the Means Employed in Homicides has been the increase in handguns. This is evident in both the number of handgun homicides and their percentage of the total cases recorded. (Figure 3 - Table 96).

37. Handgun usage in New York City in the last decade, displays a trend different from that recorded for the remainder of the United States. While national statistics indicate a modest decrease in homicides committed through the use of a handgun, New York City has experienced a relatively steady increase in homicides involving a handgun. (Figure 4).

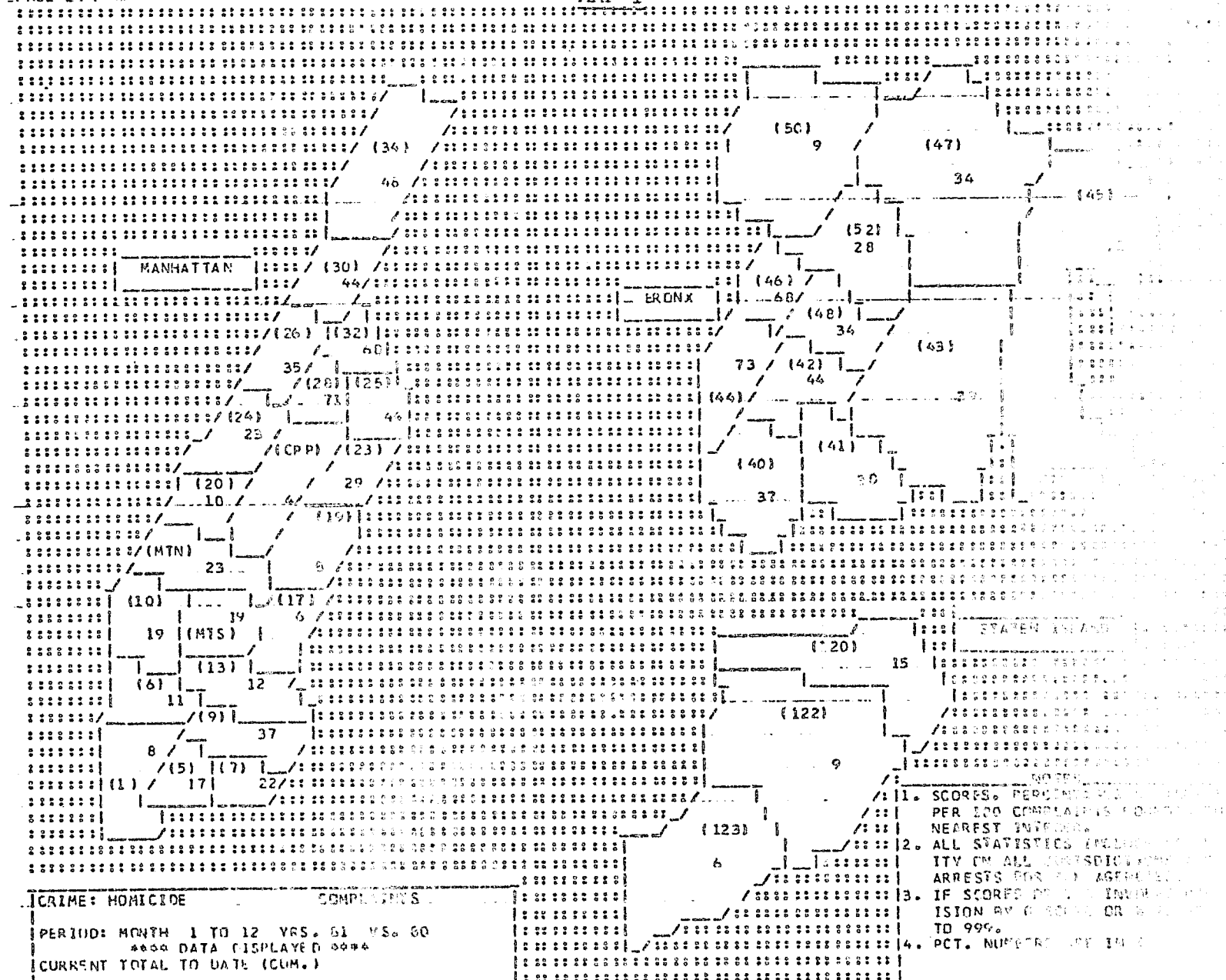

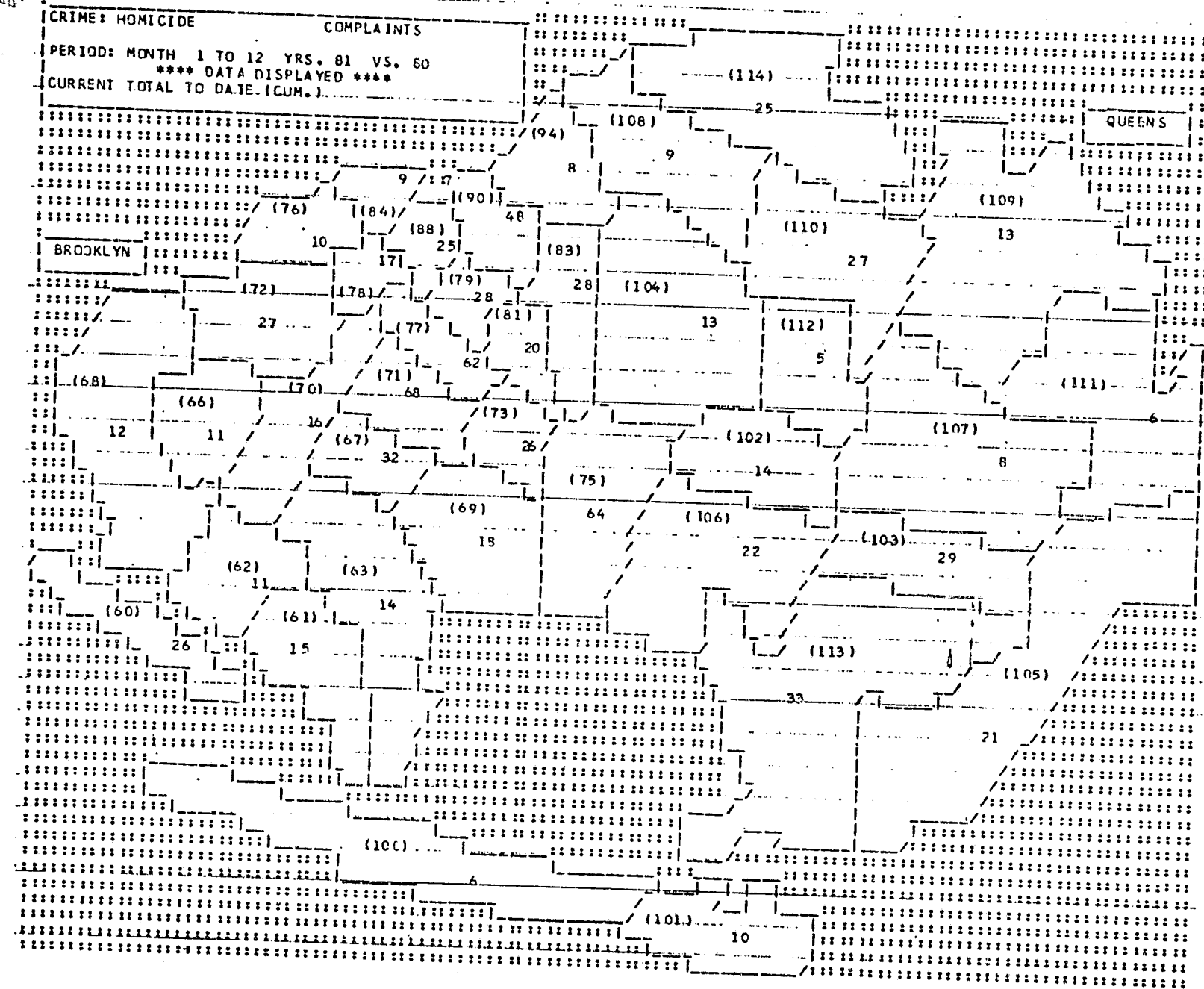

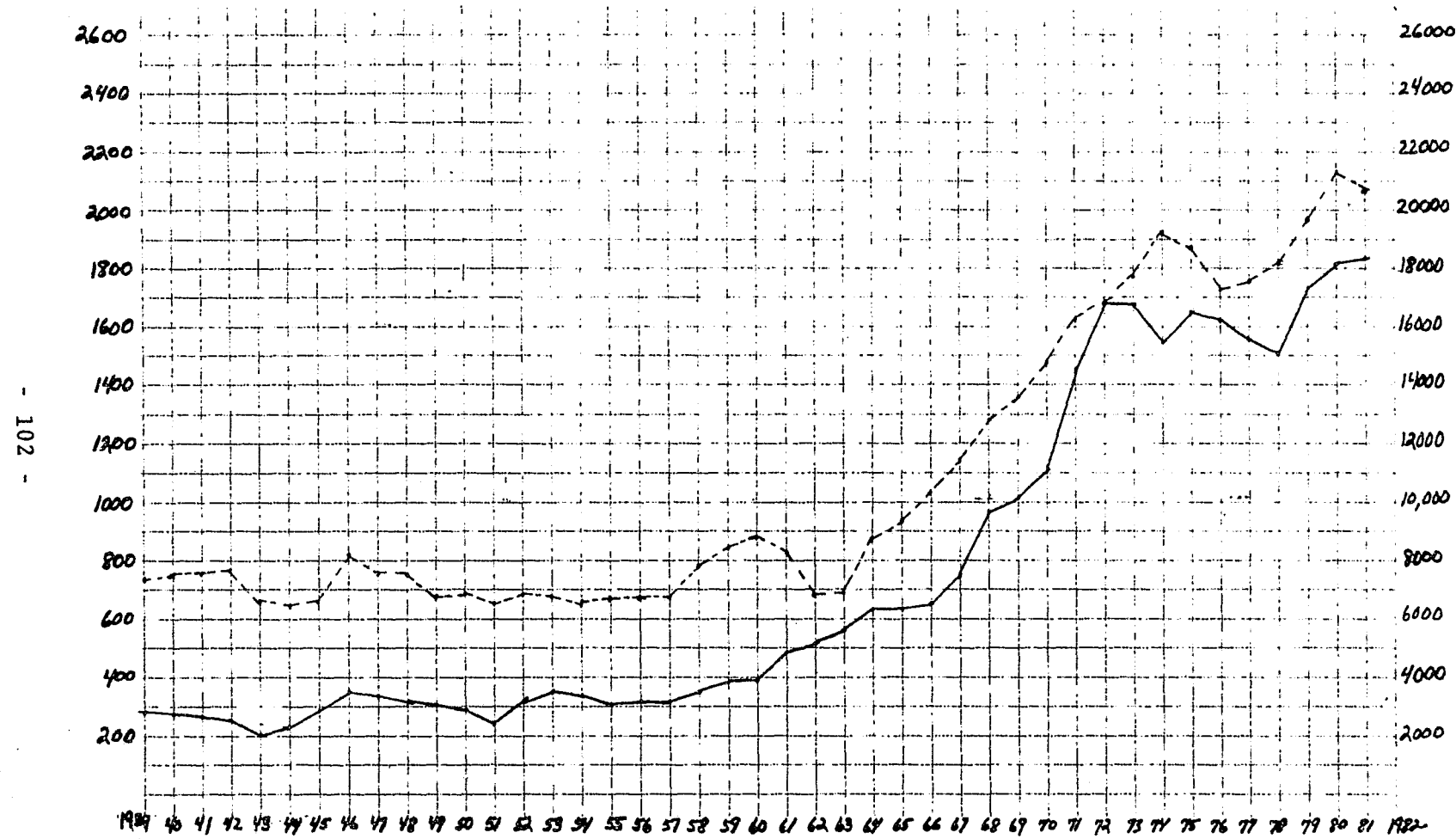

FOR INDICATED YEARS)

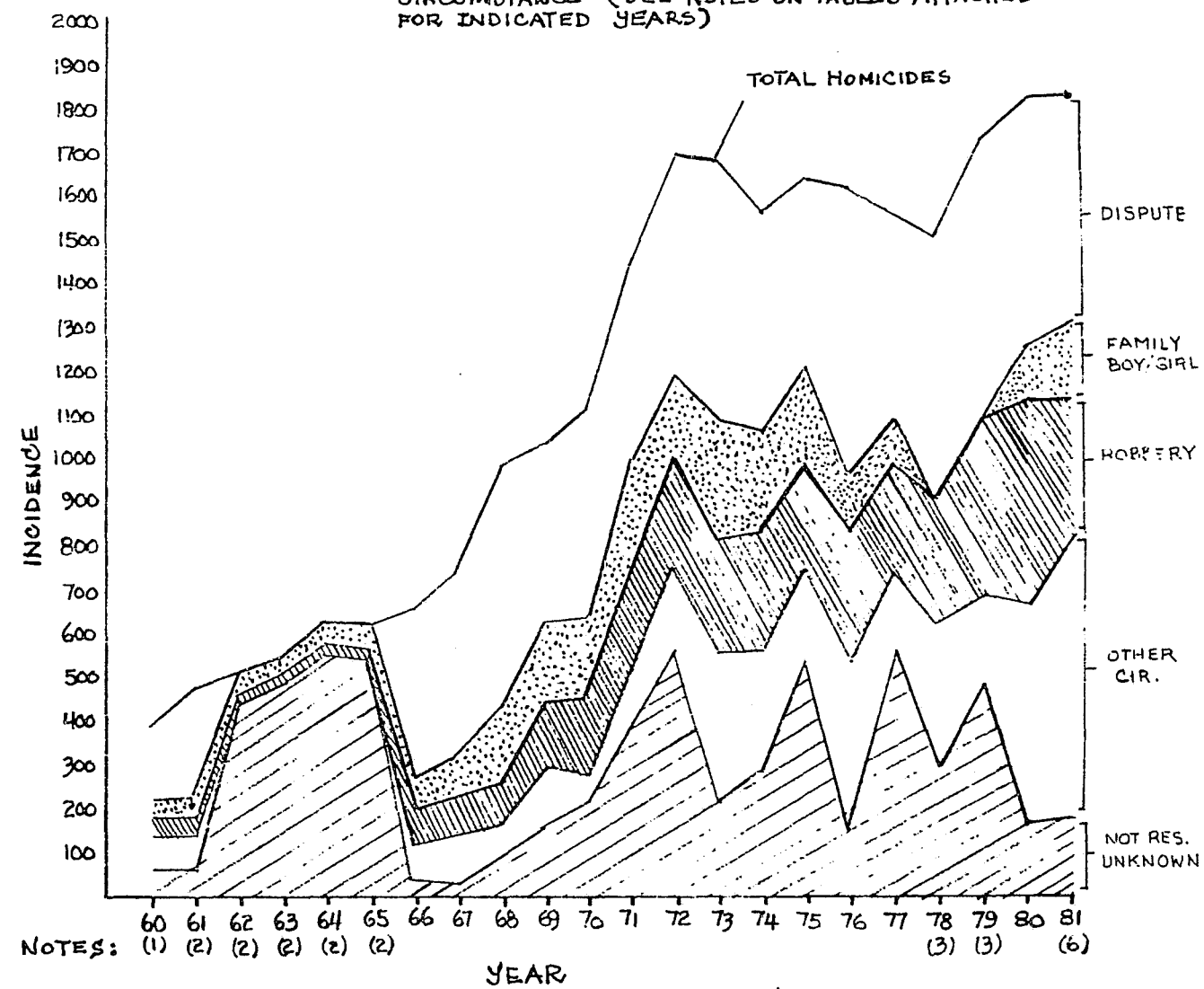

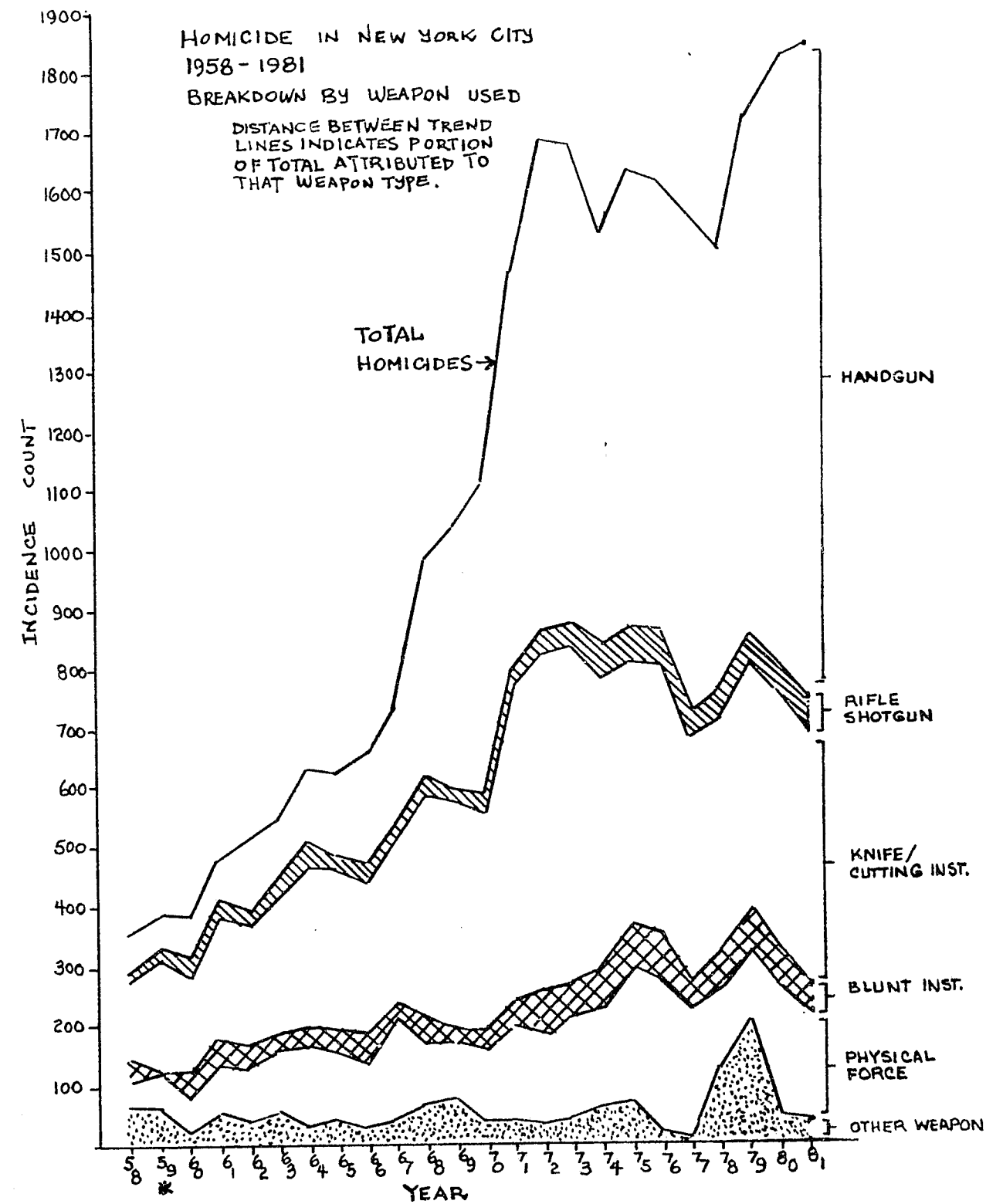
