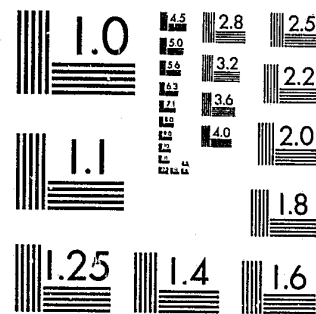


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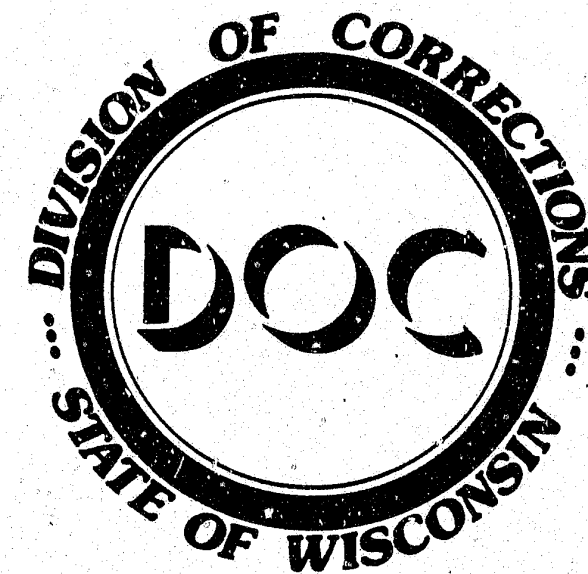

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Residents in Wisconsin
Adult Correctional Facilities
on June 30, 1982
With Five-Year Trends for 1978-1982

A total of 4,487 persons, 4,311 males and 176 females were confined in Wisconsin's adult correctional facilities on June 30, 1982.^{/1} These figures represent an increase of 11.7 percent over June 30, 1981 levels when a total of 4,016 persons, 3,871 males and 145 females, were reported as being in residence.

Tables 1 and 2 contain information about the admission status (new adult sentence, parole violator, etc.) and the ethnicity of all persons in residence on June 30, 1982. Information relating to offense, length of sentence, age on admission, etc., can be found in Tables 3-10. Sixty-seven persons have been excluded from Tables 3-10. These include 41 males and 5 females temporarily held pending the completion of probation, parole, or mandatory release revocation hearings, 20 males serving alternative to revocation contracts, and 1 male without a Wisconsin sentence. Five-year trend data for males and females in residence on June 30, 1978-1982 can be found in Tables A and B.

^{/1}These figures include residents in institutions, camps, and farms operated by the Bureau of Adult Institutions, residential centers operated by the Bureau of Community Corrections, and the Corrections Drug and Alcohol Treatment Center operated by the Bureau of Program Resources. Residents housed under contract in Minnesota correctional facilities at Stillwater, St. Cloud, and Oak Park Heights are also included.

On June 30, 1982, a total of 4,311 males were resident in Wisconsin's adult correctional facilities; an increase of 11.4 percent over June 30, 1981, when 3,871 were reported and an increase of 32.5 percent over the five-year low of 3,254 residents reported on June 30, 1979. The median length of sentence decreased slightly from a five-year high of 6.1 years in 1980 to 5.8 years in 1982. The proportion of men reported as being non-white decreased from a five-year high of 43.2 percent in 1980 to a low of 41.5 percent in 1982. Milwaukee County commitments declined from a high of 49.2 percent of the population in 1979 to a low of 43.4 percent in 1982.

Classification of persons as to type of offender; i.e., assaultive offender, sex offender, drug offender, combinations of the preceding three, and not assaultive, sex, or drug offender began with populations in residence on December 31, 1979. The proportion of males classified as assaultive offenders only decreased from a 44.0 percent in 1980 to 34.2 percent in 1982. However, during the same time period the proportion of males classified as assaultive and sex offenders rose from 12.4 percent to 18.6 percent and those classified as assaultive, sex, and drug offenders rose from less than 1 percent in 1980 to 3.3 percent in 1982. The proportion of males who were not classified as being assaultive, sex, or drug offenders rose slightly during each of the three years.

The number of females resident in Wisconsin's adult correctional facilities reached a five-year high of 176 on June 30, 1982; an increase of 33 percent over the low of 132 reported on June 30, 1980. The proportion of residents reported as being new admissions decreased to a five-year low of 92.6 in 1982. The median age of females in residence remained at 27.6 years for the second year in a row. Females reported as being non-white made up 47.1 percent of the resident population in 1982, a low for the five-year period. Milwaukee County commitments declined from a high 55.7 percent in 1980 to a low of 38.0 percent in 1982. The median length of sentence decreased from a high of 4.8 years in 1980 to a low of 3.7 years in 1982.

Women classified as having committed crimes that did not involve assaultive, sex, or drug offenses accounted for slightly less than one-half (49.1 percent) of those in residence on June 30, 1982; a slight increase over 1981 levels. The proportion of females classified as drug offenders only rose to a three-year high of 8.2 percent in 1982 as contrasted with a low of 4.9 percent in 1981. Females classified as assaultive offenders only made up 36.8 percent of the resident population on June 30, 1982; a decrease of 2.0 percent over 1981 levels.
