

2. SYSTEM DESCRIPTION

JUVENILE PROBATION ACTIVITY SYSTEM

The Juvenile Probation Activity System is a computerized system designed to receive data on juvenile probation activity collected by the Texas Juvenile Probation Commission (TJPC). From these data, the system creates a master file containing juvenile probation activity and uses the master file to produce various reports, detailed and summarized.

Three times a year the juvenile probation activity is collected by TJPC from each county in the State of Texas. This information is summarized and reported to TJPC on the Official Juvenile Probation Monthly Report (pages 7-10). From this report, TDWR Data Entry creates the necessary 80 character records for input.

Prior to being added to the master file, all data undergo an extensive edit procedure. This procedure is performed to prevent erroneous data from being added to the master file. If errors are encountered during the edit, the data in error are entered on the master file, an error flag is set, and appropriate error diagnostics are printed to inform the user of the problem. The error diagnostics are provided to assist the user in correcting the data on the master file (page 13).

After data have passed the edit procedure and been added to the master file, the reporting phase of the system may be utilized to produce various reports designed for TJPC. There are three basic report formats available to the user. These report formats are:

1. Availability Report

2. Population Report

3. Juvenile Probation Report

The Availability Report covers all counties within the state and details which counties have data available for reporting by month (see pages 16-20).

The Population Report has two formats, an alphabetic listing by county name and a listing ranked in order by juvenile population within the county (see pages 21-23). Included in both formats of the Population Report, is basic information concerning juvenile probation activity (the information contained in Items 1-3 of the Official Probation Report).

The Juvenile Probation Report has five similar reporting formats but differ in the type of information being presented. Following is a list of the various Juvenile Probation Reports and a brief description of each.

1. County Report I - This report is a monthly report by county which prints all the information contained in the Official Juvenile Probation Monthly Report. Only counties which have reported with good data will be printed. The user may request a printout of all 254 counties for a given month or for a selected number of counties for a given month (see pages 14-15). A grand total page will accompany any of these reports.

2. County Report II - This report can be used for reporting by selected months or on a year-to-date basis. All counties can be reported by this format or if desired, only selected counties can be requested. As with County Report I, a grand total page will be produced showing the totals for all categories for all counties being reported unless only one month's data is being requested.


3. The State Report, also in Report I Format, can be requested for one month, several selected months, or on a year-to-date basis and will simply be a grand total for all counties reporting for the months requested.

4. COG Report - Twenty-four COG (Council of Governments) each comprised of several counties within the state, have been established in Texas. The COG Report is identical in format to the county report but it may be requested for one month, several months, or year-to-date. If this report is requested, it will cover all COG's within the state for the time period being requested.

5. The Probation Officers Report is produced in the same manner as the COG Report with the exception that it is reported by Probation Officer rather than the COG.


JUVENILE PROBATION ACTIVITY SYSTEM
