EXPLANATION OF WORKLOAD STATISTICS

The data in this statistical report reflect the workload of the adult probation and parole districts. The information sources for the 1982 annual statistical report are the *Probation and Parole Caseload/Workload Report*, the *Probation Statistical Report*, and a manually done *Monthly Statistical Report* for discretionary parolees, mandatory parolees and pardonees under supervision. Two computer printouts are also reproduced — the *Probation Length of Stay Report*, and the *Probation Case Closing Report*. In addition, for the first time, information on the Probation Supervision fee is provided.

It is not appropriate to draw comparisons between the individual districts. The services provided by the probation/parole districts are impacted by the needs of their locality. The workload cannot be considered comparable between the localities because of the divergent demands of the individual communities. The variation in workload is affected by the level and type of request received from the court, the geography and size of the district, and by the level of supervision required by the individual clight.



Adults Under Community Supervision, Fiscal Year Ended June 1982

The data in this report were submitted to the central office of the Division of Adult Services by each district office in Virginia. The map on page 4 shows the 38 adult probation and parole districts and the administrative regions in which they are located.

PROBATION CASELOADS

Probationers are received for supervision from courts of record (Circuit Courts) or courts not of record (General District Courts). Of the total clients received during fiscal year 1982 there were 5,941 from Circuit Courts and 1,335 from District Courts. At the end of the fiscal year there were 11,695 probationers remaining under supervision from Circuit Courts and 1,318 from District Courts. At the end of last fiscal year there were 11,345 probationers under supervision from courts of record and 1,334 from courts not of record. This is a 3.1% increase in the number of clients under supervision from Circuit Courts and a 1.2% decrease in clients from District Courts. There was an overall increase from 12,679 to 13,013 of 2.6% or 334 probationers under supervision from fiscal year 1981 to fiscal year 1982. The rate of probation increased from 339 to 341 per 100,000 population.*

PAROLE/PARDON CASELOADS

There were 4,078 active cases of parolees and pardonees under supervision in June, 1981. During fiscal year 1982, there were 4,737 parolees and pardonees received and 3,836 removed from the supervision of the Division of Adult Services. At the end of the fiscal year there were a total of 4,977 parolees and pardonees under supervision. This represents a 22.0% increase in the number of parolees and pardonees under supervision at the end of the fiscal year. From the end of fiscal year 1981 to fiscal year 1982 the rate of parole/pardon increased from 109 to 131 per 100,000 population.*

CLIENT FLOW

Among the 7,276 probationers received for supervision during the fiscal year, 6,144 or 84.4% were new cases from court. This represents a 0.7% increase over the 6,099 new cases from court received in fiscal year 1981. During fiscal year 1982 there were also 763 probationers or 10.5% received from other states, 219 or 3.0% restored to supervision and 763 or 10.5% Virginia cases returned from other states.

Of the 6,662 probationers removed from probation supervision during the fiscal year, 2,125 or 31.9% were removed due to the expiration of their term of probation. This represents a 14.6% increase over the 1,855 probationers removed by expiration of probation in fiscal year 1981. In addition, 2,139 probationers or 32.1% were removed from supervision by order of the court. Warrants were issued for 601 or 9.0% percent of the probationers who were discharged, 769 or 11.5% were probationers who had their probation revoked, and 626 or 9.4% were out-of-state probation cases that were terminated.

The majority of parolees/pardonees who were received came directly from Virginia institutions (4,024 or 84.9%). In addition, 360 of the clients were transferred from other districts and 5.0% were received from other states. Among those removed from supervision, 2,071 or 54.0% were discharged from parole, 933 or 24.3% were issued warrants and 366 or 9.5% were transferred to other districts. In addition, among parolees removed from supervision, 5.0% were out-of-state cases terminated and 5.1% were Virginia cases transferred to other states.

*The probation and parole rates are calculated using the projected 20 year and older Virginia population. The projections were provided by the Virginia Department of Planning and Budget.

PROBATION LENGTH OF STAY BY OFFENSE

Of the 6,662 probationers removed from probation, 41.0% were recidivists whose average length of stay was 22.6 months. The average length of stay for the 59.0% non-recidivists was 19.6 months or 3.0 months less than for the recidivists. The overall average length of stay for all probationers removed from probation in fiscal year 1982 was 20.9 months. This is a 0.1 month increase over the overall average length of stay of 20.8 months of probationers released in fiscal year 1981.

Of the 6,662 probationers released in fiscal year 1982, 12.1% had been convicted of violent crimes and 86.6% had been convicted of non-violent crimes. For 83 or 1.2% the committing offense was non-specific. The most frequent violent offenses for which probation was given were Assault (460 or 56.9%) and Robbery (201 or 24.9%). The average length of stay for the probationers who committed Assault was 20.7 months; for the probationers who committed Robbery it was 26.8 months.

The most frequent non-violent offenses for which probation was given were Larceny (1,659 or 28.7%), Dangerous Drugs (1,207 or 20.9%), and Burglary (1,028 or 17.8%). For the probationers who committed Larceny, Dangerous Drugs and Burglary offenses the average length of stay was 19.1 months, 20.2 months, and 23.8 months, respectively. For more information concerning the offense and average length of stay for all recidivist and non-recidivist probationers released in fiscal year 1982 see pages 60 and 61.

PROBATION CASE CLOSING

Variation in workload is affected by the level of supervision required by the client. Level 5 can be the most time conjuring level of supervision, depending upon the number of presonal contacts required. Then, in successive order, probationers in Levels 1, 2, or 3 require more personal contacts and time to supervise. It is difficult to rank Level 4 because of the variety in number of contacts that could be required.

Overall, of the 6,662 probation cased closed in fiscal year 1982, 37.9% were on Level 1 Supervision (at least one personal contact every month), 22.5% were on Level 2 (personal contact required at least every other month) and 25.1% were on Level 3 (at least one personal contact every calendar quarter). In Level 4, relaxed supervision, and Level 5, intense supervision, the number of contacts required are established by the Chief or Deputy Chief. Approximately 4.3% of probation cases closed in fiscal year 1982 were on Level 4 and less than 1% were on Level 5.

Of the 6,662 probation cases closed, 4,619 or 69.3% were successful case closings. Approximately 1,562 or 33.8% of these successful case closings were on Level 3 of supervision and 1,400 or 30.3% were on Level 1. In addition, 1,227 or 18.4% were on Level 2.

There were 1,649 (24.8%) unsuccessful case closings. Of these unsuccessful cases, 1,124 or 68.2% were on Level 1 Supervision, 272 or 16.5% were on Level 2, and 108 or 6.5% were on Level 3. In addition, it is known that of these unsuccessful cases, 508 or 30.8% violated probation by committing a new felony, 360 or 21.8% absconded, 315 or 19.1% committed technical violations, 196 or 11.9% committed new misdemeanant offenses and 29 or 1.8% failed to pay a fine, cost or restitution. For 241 probationers or 14.6% the reason for the unsuccessful case closing is not specified. For more information concerning case closings, level of supervision and type of violation, see page 62.

SUPERVISION FEE

Effective July 1, 1981, § 53–19.40, Code of Virginia requires that any person, unless exempted, who is placed on probation, parole and/or work release pay a fifteen dollar (\$15.00) per month supervision fee toward the cost of his/her supervision. This \$15.00 monthly payment obligation commences thirty (30) days from the date of employment and extends throughout the supervision period. Probationers and parolees who make timely payments for a total of sixty (60) months and who have not had their supervision revoked or extended shall have no further obligation for the offense(s) for which they were originally placed on probation or parole.

A total of \$198,285.31 in supervision fees was collected from July, 1981 through June, 1982. In June, 1982 supervision fees were being collected from 2,032 clients.






