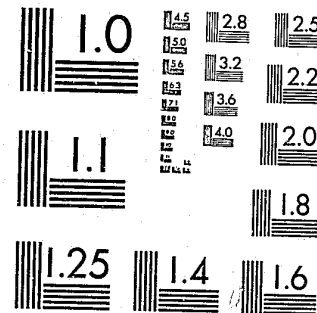


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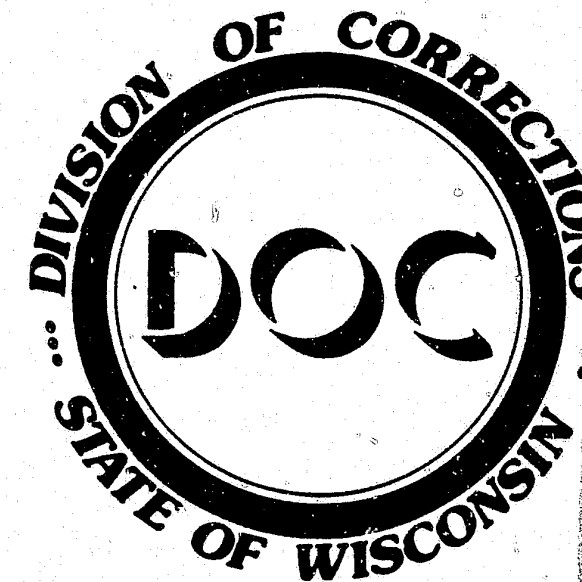

Juveniles Released From
Division of Corrections Juvenile Institutions
in Calendar Year 1982

H I G H L I G H T S

- * A total of 651 youths were released from Wisconsin's juvenile correctional institutions during calendar year 1982 as compared with 719 during 1981. This is a decrease of 9.5 percent as contrasted with 1981 when releases decreased 19 percent from 1980 levels. The decrease in numbers of juveniles released from institution supervision is directly relatable to the decrease in admissions to juvenile institutions first noted in 1979 following adaption of Wisconsin's revised Children's Code in November, 1978. The revised code provides that children should be treated in the least restrictive setting possible with emphasis on treatment in the community. Therefore, a child cannot be sent to a Division of Corrections juvenile institution unless (1) they have been adjudged delinquent of an act which would be punishable by a sentence of at least six months if committed by an adult and (2) they are found to be a danger to the public or themselves and in need of restrictive, custodial care and treatment.
- * A breakdown of the 594 boys released during calendar year 1982 by type of release indicates 374 first releases to aftercare, 60 re-releases to aftercare, 117 direct discharges, and 43 discharges by court order. The 57 girls released during the same time period included 40 first releases to aftercare, 4 re-releases to aftercare, 10 direct discharges, and 3 discharges by court order. Information as to the county and region to which these juveniles were released is presented by sex and type of release in Table 3.
- * Tables 4 through 14 present data about boys first and re-released to aftercare by region to which released. One boy first released to aftercare and 1 re-release to aftercare have been excluded from these tables because they went to live in placements outside Wisconsin. Information about boys directly discharged or discharged by court order can be found in Appendix Table A. Four boys who received direct discharges are excluded from this table; 2 because they went to out-of-state placements and 2 for whom placement was unknown.
- * Data for all girls released during 1982 has been combined due to the smallness of numbers and is displayed in Appendix Table B. One girl who received a direct discharge has been excluded because the county to which she was released was unknown.
- * The Milwaukee Region (Milwaukee County) and the Southeastern Region (Kenosha, Ozaukee, Racine, Walworth, Washington, and Waukesha Counties) were reported as the areas of the state to which slightly more than one-half (51.8 percent) of the boys and girls released during 1982 returned. (Table 3)
- * The average (median) length of institutional stay for boys first-released to aftercare supervision increased from 7.9 months in 1981 to 8.3 months in 1982 while that of re-released boys decreased from 8.7 months to 8.3 months during the same time period. (Table 4)

- * Boys who were reported as first releases to aftercare in 1982 had an average (median) age of 16.9 years as contrasted with 1981 when the average (median) age for this group was 16.7 years. The average (median) age for boys re-released to aftercare decreased from 17.2 years in 1981 to 17.0 years in 1982.
(Table 5)
- * Almost three-fourths (74.3 percent) of the boys first released to aftercare had lived with at least one parent prior to institutionalization. At release however, less than two-fifths (37.3 percent) returned to the parental home. One-third of the boys re-released to aftercare lived with at least one parent prior to being institutionalized; however, slightly more than one-half (52.6 percent) went to that type of living situation following re-release to aftercare.

- * The median age for all girls released during 1982 was 16.9 years, while the average (median) length of stay was 6.9 months. (Appendix B)
- * Selected characteristics for juveniles first and re-released to aftercare during the years 1978-1982 are reported in Appendices C-F.
