STUDY DESCRIPTION

The juvenile Detention and Correctional Facility Census of 1973 is the second in a series of surveys of state and local public residential facilities in the juvenile justice system. This census was designed by the Law Enforcement Administration (LEAA) and the data were collected by the Bureau of the Census. The first of these studies sponsored by LEAA was conducted in 1971 and it was designed by the Department of Health, Education, and Welfare (HEW). In prior years, an annual survey of public facilities for adjudicated juveniles was conducted by HEW, and published under the title. Statistics on Public Institutions for Delinquent Children. When the LEAA began sponsorship of the juvenile facility surveys, the definition of the juvenile institutions was broadened to include not only those institutions which were already adjudicated youths, but also those which administer to children awaiting court action.

Results of the LEAA censuses were published in "Children in Custody: Advance Report on the Juvenile Detention and Correctional Facility Census of 1972-1973", and "Children in Custody: Final Report on the Juvenile Detention and Correctional Facility Census of 1973".

The variables included in the present study concerning the fiscal year of 1973 are: type of facility; level of government responsible for administering the agency: number of admissions by type of admission and sex; number of discharges by type of discharge and sex; quarterly resident population by detention status and sex; number of residents adjudicated delinquent or declared in need of supervision, by offense and sex; facility capacity; statistics on age of residents by sex; average length of stay; number of fulland part-time staff; staff vacancies by type of position and payroll status; and facility expenditures.

The census covered residential juvenile detention and correctional facilities meeting the following criteria: 1) operated by state and local governments; 2) in operation at the time the census was initiated (November 1973); 3) had been in operation at least one month prior to the primary census reference date (June 30, 1973); 4) and had a resident population of at least 50% juveniles. Facilities that held youthful offenders in addition to juveniles were also included; however, juvenile detention centers which were part of adult jails were not included in the survey because staff and budget figures for the facilities could not be reported separately. An individual facility which was administratively dependent upon a parent institution was counted as a separate facility if it was located in a separate geographic area. Nonresidential juvenile centers; privately operated facilities; centers exclusively for drug users,

alcoholics, unwed mothers, dependent and neglected children, emotionally disturbed or mentally retarded children; federal correctional facilities; and foster homes were not included in the census.

The 1973 census includes 794 public juvenile institutions. Each facility is classified as one of the following types: 1) detention center; 2) shelter; 3) reception or diagnostic center; 4) training school; 5) ranch; 6) halfway house; 7) group home. Classification of the facilities was based on respondents' perceptions of the facility with which he/she was associated.

DATA COLLECTION & SAMPLE

For 1973, the census sought to cover the period July 1, 1972, through June 30, 1973, with a June 30, 1973 reference date emphasized for population characteristics and personnel information. Population counts were also collected for September 30, 1972; December 31, 1972; and March 31, 1973. Expenditure data were requested for the fiscal year July 1, 1972, through June 30, 1973, where records were available for the period. If records were for some other annual period, such as the calendar year, data were usually reported on that basis.

Data collection was accomplished primarily by mailed questionnaire. The mailing list used in the 1971 census was updated and used as the basis for the 1973 census mailing. Initially, 881 questionnaires were mailed in November 1973. The schedules were sent either to the facilities' controlling agencies or directly to the institution itself. In the case of nonresponding institutions second and third data requests were mailed; and in addition, telephone and telegram contact was used where necessary. An overall response rate of 99% was achieved. For the six facilities that ultimately did not respond in the present survey, information from the 1971 census was utilized.

PROCESSING

In the data file a juvenile facility is the unit of analysis; there are 794 units in the file. Each unit is identified by the following: state, county, and city codes; level of government responsible for the facility; type of controlling agency, and an agency number. These variables were assigned by the Governments Division of the Bureau of the Census. The records in the data file are sorted according to: state number, level of government administering the facility, county number, city number, type of facility, and agency identification number. A unique sequence number has been assigned to each case in the file.

APPENDIX 1: DEFINITION OF TERMS

The following is a glossary of terms, concepts, and categories applied in the <u>Juvenile Detention</u> and <u>Correctional Facility Census of 1973</u>. This glossary was taken from a draft of <u>Children in Custody</u>: <u>Final Report on the Juvenile Detention and Correctional Facility Census of 1973</u>.

Adjudicated delinquent. Detention status of a juvenile who, as the result of a formal and completed judicial proceeding, is adjudged a delinquent, usually for a nonstatus offense — one for which an adult could be prosecuted in a criminal court. Includes some status offenders, especially in states without special status offender statutes. Even in states with such statutes, juveniles with previous offenses can be adjudicated delinquent for status offenses. (Conversely, a judge can declare a juvenile to be a person in need of supervision for a felony or misdemeanor — see Person in need of supervision.)

Administrative staff. Includes such positions as superintendent, director, administrator, assistant superintendent, business manager, purchasing agent, stenographer, bookkeeper, accountant, switchboard operator, clerk, and typist.

Age. Pertains to the age of the youngest and oldest residents (including nonjuveniles). For 1973, these data are as of June 30. For the 1971 census, they pertain to the day the questionnaire was completed. Data for average age were obtained only in the 1973 census and are based on June 30 of that year.

Awaiting transfer to another jurisdiction. Detention status of a juvenile who allegedly has committed a crime in or run away from another jurisdiction and is being held pending return to that jurisdiction. Includes runaways from other correctional facilities. Excludes adjudicated delinquents awaiting placement in a correctional facility.

Capital expenditures. For the 1973 census, includes spending for new buildings, major repairs or improvements, and new equipment costing \$1,000 or more, but excludes single expenditures of less than \$1,000. For the 1971 census, includes spending for new buildings, major repairs or improvements, and new equipment costing \$100 or more.

Child in need of supervision (CHINS). See Person in need of supervision.

Dependent and neglected children. Juveniles over whom a juvenile court assumes jurisdiction because of its finding that the care exercised by parent, guardian, or custodian falls short of a legal standard for proper care. Excludes juveniles held on delinquency charges, adjudicated delinquents, and those declared in need of supervision, even if they also could be considered dependent and neglected.

Design capacity. The number of persons a facility is designed to hold, exclusive of arrangements, if any, to alleviate overcrowding, such as the use of double-deck bunks in a facility designed for single bunks or the temporary use of space as sleeping quarters that was designed for other purposes.

<u>Detention center</u>. A short-term facility that provides temporary care in a physically restricting environment for juveniles in custody pending court disposition and, often, for juveniles who are adjudicated delinquent or are awaiting transfer to another jurisdiction.

<u>Detention status</u>. One of the following statuses under which juveniles are held: adjudicated delinquent, person in need of supervision, held pending court disposition, awaiting transfer to another jurisdiction, voluntary admission, and dependent and neglected children.

Discharged with no further agency supervision. An unconditional departure.

Felony. An offense that if committed by an adult would be considered a felony. Excludes felony-type drug offenses.

<u>First court commitment</u>. A type of admission to training schools and to ranches, forestry camps, and farms involving persons committed by courts for the first time.

Gross salaries and wages. A component of operating expenditures. For the 1973 census, excludes employer contributions to employee benefits. For the 1971 census, includes the value of compensation for meals, lodging, and uniforms for staff personnel.

Group home. See Halfway house and group home.

Halfway house and group home. A long-term facility in which residents are allowed extensive contact with the community, such as attending school or working on a job.

Held pending court disposition. Detention status of a juvenile who has not had any hearing or who has had only a preliminary screening, detention, or similar hearing and is awaiting further court action.

Juvenile. In most states, a person under age 18. With respect to juveniles in custody, a person subject to juvenile court proceedings because a statutorily defined event is alleged to have occurred while his/her age was below the statutorily specified limit of original jurisdiction of a juvenile court.

Juvenile in need of supervision (JINS). See Person in need of supervision.

Long-term facility. A correctional, as opposed to a detention, facility. Includes training schools, ranches, forestry camps, and farms; and halfway houses and group nomes.

Minor in need of supervision (MINS). See Person in need of supervision.

<u>Misdemeanor</u>. An offense that if committed by an adult would be considered a misdemeanor. Excludes misdemeanor-type drug offenses.

<u>Nonjuvenile</u>. With respect to persons in custody, one within the original jurisdiction of a criminal rather than a juvenile court because his/her age at the time of an alleged crime was above the statutorily specified limit.

Nonpayroll staff. Full-time or part-time staff not on the payroll of the reporting facility. Includes staff members of a parent agency or service who are assigned to the juvenile facility, personnel paid under contractual agreements or federal grants, college interns, and, in 1973 but not in 1971, community volunteers.

Operational, maintenance, and other staff. In addition to housekeeping staff, includes all others not classifiable as administrative, personal custody, or treatment and educational staff.

Operating expenditures. Gross salaries and wages, plus other operating expenditures.

Other operating expenditures. A component of operating expenditures. For the 1973 census, covers expenditures for food, supplies, and contractual services. For the 1971 census, also includes the fair market value of free commodities or services provided by any public or charitable organization.

Payroll staff. Full-time and part-time staff on the payroll of the reporting facility.

<u>Personal custody staff</u>. Includes such positions as house parent, group supervisor, group worker, cottage parent, and matron.

Person in need of supervision (PINS). Detention status of a juvenile declared by a juvenile court to be in need of supervision. Encompasses those known variously as child in need of supervision (CHINS), juvenile in need of supervision (JINS), and minor in need of supervision (MINS), as well as those designated as unruly, unmanageable, or incorrigible under special statutes for status offenders. All PINS are not status offenders, and all status offenders are not PINS. Even in states with status offender statutes, juveniles with previous offenses can be adjudicated delinquent for status offenses. Conversely, a judge can declare a juvenile to be a person in need of supervision for a felony or misdemeanor.

Placed in an aftercare or parole program. A conditional departure.

Ranch, forestry camp, and farm. A long-term residential facility for persons whose behavior does not necessitate the strict confinement of a training school, often allowing them greater contact with the community.

Recommitment. A type of admission to training schools and to ranches, forestry camps, and farms involving persons who commit a new offense and are recommitted by court order, even if these persons are in an aftercare or parole status.

Reception or diagnostic center. A short-term facility that screens persons committed by courts and assigns them to appropriate correctional facilities.

Resident. A person, juvenile or nonjuvenile, held in a juvenile detention or correctional facility.

Return from aftercare or parole. A type of admission to training schools or to ranches, forestry camps, and farms involving a person returned to confinement for violations of the conditions for aftercare or parole. Excludes those returned for new offenses.

Shelter. A short-term facility that provides temporary care similar to that of a detention center, but in a physically unrestricting environment.

Short-term facility. A detention, as opposed to a correction facility. Includes detention centers, shelters, and reception or diagnostic centers.

Status offense. An act or conduct that is declared by statute to be an offense (but only when committed or engaged in by a juvenile) and that can be adjudicated only by a juvenile court. Typical status offenses are violation of curfew, running away from home, truancy, possession of alcoholic beverages, and leading an immoral life. Both adjudicated delinquents and juveniles declared to be persons in need of supervision can be status offenders.

Training school. A long-term specialized type of facility that provides strict confinement for its residents.

Treatment and educational staff. Includes such positions as psychiatrist, psychologist, chaplain, academic principal or teacher, vocational director or teacher, social worker, librarian, aftercare or parole worker, recreational worker, physician, registered nurse, practical nurse, medical aide, classification officer, and counselor.

Voluntary admission. A type of admission in which a juvenile voluntarily commits himself/herself to a facility without being adjudged by a court to be delinquent or in need of supervision. The juvenile may be referred to the facility for treatment by parents, court, school, or social agency.

Youthful offender. A person, adjudicated in criminal court, who may be above the statutory age limit for juveniles but below a specified upper age limit, for whom special correctional commitments and special recording-sealing procedures are made available by statute. The special correctional commitment may be to a juvenile facility, to a special section of an adult facility, or to a separate facility for the confinement of persons between the age limits specified in the particular statute. Such provisions exist in federal law and in the laws of several states.

Reporting Inconsistencies

The criterion that a facility had to have a resident population of which juveniles accounted for at least 50% did not apply to facilities that held youthful offenders in addition to juveniles. One additional exception was the New Jersey state training school discussed below.

California state facilities that held youthful offenders in addition to juveniles based their 1972 and 1973 admission, releases, and population figures on juveniles only. This differs from reporting practices in 1971, when admissions, releases, and population data included youthful offenders. On June 30, 1973, the youthful offenders in California facilities totaled 1,869.

One New Jersey state training school included in the census was undergoing a conversion from a basically juvenile facility to an adult correctional institution. For this facility, admission and release data do not include the adult population detained in addition to juveniles. These variables are Reference Numbers 28 through 51. However, the population data, Reference Numbers 56 through 111, do include nonjuveniles. Nonjuveniles were counted as males adjudicated delinquent. On June 30, 1973, the adults totaled 420, and juveniles, 179. At the time of the 1971 census, 405 of the 624 residents of this facility were juveniles. There were six facilities that did not supply information in 1973, and for which data were taken from questionnaires returned in 1971. The six facilities include one detention center in Arizona with an estimated population of 11, two detention centers in Florida with estimated populations of 12 and 7, one detention center in Michigan with an estimated population of 5, one training school in Mississippi with an estimated population of 277, and one detention center in Ohio with an estimated population of 15. Use and Comparison of 1971, 1972, and 1973 Data

Before comparing any of the three years for which data are available, the user should be aware of several general restrictions.

The 1972 data must be used with caution because they were collected in late 1973 as part of the 1973 census. This arrangement meant that facilities in existence in 1972 but not in late 1973 could not be represented in the data. In addition, some respondents could not provide actual data or reasonable estimates. LEAA considers the 1972 data to be minimum counts and chose not to compare them with data from any other years.

The categories of admissions, releases, and population data for 1971 and 1973 are not exactly the same, so that some judgment is necessary in comparing these years. For the final report of the 1973 census, an estimating procedure was used to inflate the 1973 admission and release data and make them comparable with the 1971 data.

The 1971 detention status category "adjudicated delinquent" includes persons in need of supervision and voluntary admissions. These categories are reported separately in the 1973 data and must be summed before comparing with the 1971 data.

The same kind of problem occurs in the staffing data. In 1973, payroll staff was reported separately from non-payroll staff and both terms were defined on the questionnaire form. In 1971, the questionnaire requested counts of "employees" but in fact the data include both "employees" on the payroll and other staff not on the payroll. In 1973, non-payroll staff included community volunteers, who were not counted in 1971.

In 1971, definitions of full-time and part-time were stated in the questionnaire; they were not stated in the 1973 questionnaire. Also, there is no certainty that the data were reported as requested in 1971. Because of these reporting discrepancies, LEAA has chosen to compare only full-time staff.

To compare 1971 full-time staff with the 1973 data, the 1973 payroll and non-payroll staff must be summed. Also, the 1971 data classified staff into specific job titles. The 1973 data include more general categories. For these data, the 1971 data must be summed in order to permit comparisons with the 1973 data.
