BJS Releases New Data on Crimes Against People with Disabilities – The Bureau of Justice Statistics released *Crime Against People with Disabilities, 2008-2010 – Statistical Tables*, presenting estimates of nonfatal violent victimization (rape, sexual assault, robbery, aggravated and simple assault) against persons age 12 or older with disabilities, from 2008 to 2010. <http://www.bjs.gov>.

OJP Announces More Fiscal Year 2011 Grant Awards – The Office of Justice Program's Bureau of Justice Assistance and the National Institute of Justice announced awards exploring the use of data-driven policing approaches.
