WASHINGTON – Beginning today, the Office of Justice Programs (OJP) will begin using GovDelivery to distribute information, such as news releases, advisories, and data reports. GovDelivery is a web-based communication platform.

Reporters and other representatives of the media who desire to receive OJP press releases should sign up via GovDelivery.

Subscriptions to the OJP GovDelivery distribution list is cost free.
