Building Permit, Escalation, and Design are based on a standard percentage cost (for our area) of the on total construction cost. Construction and renovation costs include the Tribal Court addition of 2,200 gross square feet at \$297.56 a GSF. Also, the site work at 1 carload at \$18,847 is included. Total Construction/renovation cost is \$673,485. Total Construction/Renovation Project Cost is estimated at \$804, 101. Adding furniture and fixtures to complete the project is estimated at \$50,000. Total Project cost then comes to \$854,101. A copy of the Knutson-Construction estimate is attached with the proposal for your cross reference. This provides details of each phase of the construction and renovation included the breakdown of cost. This is only an estimate and we will be utilizing an open-bid announcement and selection process pursuant to our procurement policy and procedures.

Furniture and fixture will include chairs, tables, and file cabinets to be utilized by the justice services staff. Cameras: the new additions will consist of five security cameras strategically placed through the justice center such as the new hallways and new spaces created by the renovation.
