Is the activity a <u>systematic investigation</u> designed to develop or contribute to <u>generalizable knowledge</u>?

Is the activity being conducted <u>only</u> to comply with GPRA or OJP requirements for performance measures (and <u>not</u> for the purpose of developing or contributing to <u>generalizable</u> <u>knowledge</u>)?
